

This year's high school graduation ceremonies will take place June 14th through June 16, 2016 as originally planned for each high school.

There are 6 things that you need to be aware of:

- 1. The City of Santa Ana informed our District that due to construction that is underway, the Santa Ana Bowl will not be available for graduations this June.
- 2. High school graduations will be held at Centennial Park, located at 3000 W. Edinger Ave in Santa Ana, on June 14, 15, and 16, 2016.
- 3. We are planning to accommodate seating similar to Santa Ana Bowl, so that families do not need to rely upon tickets for admission.
- 4. Due to traffic concerns, the following high schools Godinez, Century and Santa Ana graduation ceremony have a new start time of 8:00 p.m. on the original planned date of graduation.
- 5. Parking will be provided in the Centennial Park area through the normal entrances. Additional parking will be available at Carr Intermediate/ Harvey Elementary / Valley High School complex off Raitt Street. As a convenience, shuttle buses will be provided to transport guests to Centennial Park.
- 6. During the entire week of June 14th through 16th, traffic will be heavily congested in the late afternoon in the areas of Edinger, Raitt, Greenville, Fairview, and St. Andrews.
