# Selection Criteria

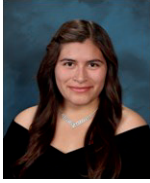
**T**he selection process identifies and ranks students according to their weighted Academic Grade Point Average in grades 9 through 12 earned in semester and year-long courses.
