ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

You are eligible to apply if you meet the following criteria:

1. You must be a **female** residing in one of the following cities: Santa Ana, Tustin, Garden Grove, Orange, Villa Park, or in the greater North Tustin area.
2. You must be planning to enroll by September 2016 at a **four-year** college that has NPC sororities on campus.
3. You must complete an application and have it postmarked or hand delivered **no later than April 1, 2016** to the address shown below.

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If you are selected as a finalist, you must be available for a **personal interview** in April or May. (We will work with your schedule to find a convenient time and date).

If you are a recipient of a scholarship, you must present us with **proof of enrollment** at a four-year college that has national sororities by September 30, 2016.
