 - Two parent training & involvement programs: <u>Padres en Acción</u> and <u>Padres Unidos</u> (new)
 - Facilitating daily 30 minute research-based (SIPPS, PALS, Rewards, Six-Minute Solution, etc.) intervention blocks for grades 1-3 Intensive & borderline strategic students in the classroom with the classroom teacher while core & strategic students go to the computer lab and work on Lexia, SmartyAnts, or MyOn Reader
- 2) What is your site doing this year that is considered new to improve student achievement?
 - Added a second parent program, Padres Unidos, including a community worker
 - Purchased SmartyAnts, an online program to enhance students' learning in the area of preliteracy skills, phonics, decoding, and fluency
- 3) What is your site doing more of this year to improve student achievement?
 - Providing more parent training and involvement through the Padres Unidos program
 - Continuing to provide the parent program, <u>Padres en Acción</u>, that focuses on nutrition, exercise, and physical activities for students during recess
 - Expanding our PBIS program with a greater emphasis on college readiness and character development
 - Purchasing more Chromebooks so that 3rd 5th graders have 1:1 access to technology; K-2 will have more Computer Lab access for <u>ST Math</u>, <u>SmartyAnts</u>, <u>Lexia</u>, <u>MyOn Reader</u>, etc.
- 4) What is your site doing *less of* this year to improve student achievement?
 - Following and reading from old content standards-based TE's
 - Using the existing SAXON Math program, as it doesn't relate to the new CCSS
- 5) What is your site doing this year that is *innovative* to improve student achievement?
 - Purchased <u>MyOn Reader</u>, an online program that provides students access to more books via the internet at school and home
 - Establishing an e-book reading center with tables, chairs, and Chromebooks where students will access <u>MyOn Reader</u> and read e-books of interest
