School: **Lincoln Elementary School**

- 1) What is your site doing *differently* this year from last year to improve student achievement?
 - Use MAP's growth projection data and the Learning Continuum to develop academic learning goals to differentiate and individualize instruction.

- 2) What is your site doing this year that is considered *new* to improve student achievement?
 - Have teachers meet with each individual student to discuss their academic growth and together develop tailored learning goals.
 - Utilize the district allotted 60 hours tutoring program to provide students additional tutoring time before and after school, on Saturdays and during intersession.
 - Implement the Mentor Program as per PBIS framework to target students with academic, behavior and attitude problems.
 - Collaborate with the FORD Corporation to engage targeted students in designing automobiles of the future.
 - Fourth and fifth grade students will pilot an online digital math program, GO MATH.
 - Purchase and implement PlayWorks, a program that engages students in fun, safe and cooperative play, while building leadership skills.

- 3) What is your site doing *more of* this year to improve student achievement?
 - Build parent technology skills by continuing to provide Computer Classes for parents three times per week.
 - Continue the Learning2gether reading program for 2nd and 4th/ 5th grade students. Staff and students will be surveyed using Strength Training to determine their learning style.
 - Continue in-depth analysis of student CELDT performance on each tested domain to target "Reading" during ELD instruction.
 - Utilize units of study to continue emphasizing linguistic patterns and collaborative conversations.
 - School-wide focus on student use of academic language and answering questions in complete sentences.
 - Continue to provide additional parent trainings (Project2Inspire, Raising Highly Capable Children, Parent to Parent, and Disciplina Positiva).
 - Continue field trips for all grade levels, including the STARBASE Academy field trips for 5th graders to promote STEM.

- 4) What is your site doing *less of* this year to improve student achievement?
 - Decrease in suspensions due to increased positive interventions for student behavior.

- 5) What is your site doing this year that is *innovative* to improve student achievement?
 - Chrome books will be assigned to each 4th/5th grade student in order to engage in project based learning which will be presented during the monthly general parent meetings.
 - Development of an onsite technology committee to assist teachers in the implementation of digital learning.
 - Parents will tour classrooms at the end of every general parent meeting.
