



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2019-20

The Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation is pleased to provide graduating seniors from all Santa Ana Unified School District high schools with the opportunity to apply for scholarships to support their post-secondary educational goals. We encourage all eligible seniors to consider applying for these scholarships.

If selected, students will be notified in March 2020, and will receive their scholarship at the SAPSF Scholarship Awards Ceremony in April, 2020.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS

Santa Ana College Promise \$4,000

2 scholarships awarded

- This scholarship is awarded specifically to students who will be attending Santa Ana College, and will pursue and complete a 2-year certificate program or transferable pathway to a university of the student's choice.
- To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.5 or above.
- If selected, students must enroll at SAC for a minimum of 12 college credits prior to the first \$1,000 payment and continue each semester as a full-time student carrying 12 units with a GPA of 2.0.

Retired Administrators \$500

5 scholarships awarded

- This scholarship is for students who have achieved academic success, have been involved in community service, and have demonstrated exemplary leadership.
- To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Merit \$1,000

5 scholarships awarded

- This scholarship is designed to recognize students demonstrating outstanding leadership and high academic achievement.
- To qualify, students must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Quick Start \$500

5 scholarships awarded

- This scholarship is awarded to students who have been focused on CTE certificate programs and wish to pursue a professional certificate in preparation for work.
- To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.0 or better and have been enrolled in a CTE program for two consecutive school years.

Santa Ana Business \$1,000

1 scholarship awarded

- This scholarship is awarded to one student who has worked or who has served in an internship while attending high school.
- To qualify, students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Nancy Diaz-Miller \$1,500

2 scholarships awarded

- These scholarships are for students who may have had to overcome life challenges and have been actively involved in their school and/or in the local Santa Ana community.

Scholarship applications must be submitted electronically to the Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation at www.sapsf.org no later than February 14, 2020. Late applications will not be considered.
