Course Description: This

course teaches essential

skills for employment in a hospital environment. Content topics include: Health Care Systems, Hospital Departments, Skilled work environment, Ethics and Medical Terminology. Students will be required to participate in part I the classroom skills training and part II the internship at the community hospital site in order to receive their certificate. Training will involve preparing students to work with patients within various departments in the hospital. Students will receive a certificate upon successful completion of the course.

Career Opportunities in the Hospital: Once students receive their Hospital Occupations Certificate they may be qualified for hospital jobs ie; Admit Clerk. Health-Info. clerk, Birth cert. clerk, Telecom-Operator, Admit I- Rep., Unit Secretary, Orderly, ER Tech., Patient Services Rep., Environmental Services Worker, Food Services. *Jobs starting pay from \$12.00 to \$18.00 per hour

Students must have: Physical examination, drug screen, tuberculin test/lung (X-ray if applicable, (cost provided by CTE). Uniform, hospital regulation shoes, flu shot & any up to date immunizations, (extra cost required by student). These are Requirements by hospital administration for placement in hospital Internship.

Prerequisites: Medical Core I/II B grade or C grade with teachers approval, Sports Medicine, Bio Medical Technology Courses and or Science related courses approved by Instructor.
