GODINEZ DRAWING & PAINTING

In this year's art class, students will:

- > Imagine, execute, reflect and refine artwork during the working process (creating).
- Share/display the work (presenting).
- Reflect on the completed work (responding).
- Connect the experience to other contexts of meaning or knowledge (connecting).
- > Develop an understanding of the Elements of Art line, color, texture, shape, form, space, and value.
- Develop an understanding of the Principles of Design rhythm & movement, balance, proportion, variety and emphasis, harmony & unity.
- > Explore the Elements of Art and Principles of Design in drawings and paintings.
- > Learn "right-brain" drawing techniques that will facilitate "seeing" and help make drawing a more natural and less stressful experience.
- > Develop techniques and skills (processes and tools) of drawing and painting to express ideas and feelings.
- Acquire a historical perspective in drawing and painting by recognizing individual and cultural influences, themes and styles, and demonstrating that understanding in drawing and painting projects.
- Learn to make informed aesthetic judgments about works of art, nature, and human-made objects in our environment.
- > Develop **artistic literacy** by understanding and using vocabulary and terms associated with drawing and painting the language of the art discipline.
- > Use and care for tools, equipment, and materials safely and properly.
- Read about art (ARTTALK textbook and other written material) and write in response to related questions and assignments. (For Art 1 and Art 2 only)

GRADING

- Daily Attendance You need to be in class to learn and work. Excessive absences will lower your grade as you will not be able to complete your work.
- Art Projects In class projects will take various lengths of time and must be complete to receive full credit. If work is not finished by the end of the time allotted in class, it will become homework and a due date will be assigned. Points will be taken off daily for late work. (80%)
- In class/Homework/Writing assignments Homework will include both drawing, research, reading and writing. Points will be taken away for late work at Instructor's discretion.

(15%)

- Participation in Critiques and Discussions Sharing ideas and asking questions are integral to the learning process and artistic development.
- **Tests**-Tests may cover both material from the textbook as well as lecture material. (5%)
- Art Research Project/Writing –Towards the end of the spring semester a project will be assigned which will involve research, analysis, drawing, writing, and an oral presentation to the class. Students will be able to select an artist whom they are genuinely interested in studying. This final project will be weighted as an art project.

Grading Scale is as follows but can change depending on the district requirement.

A = 90 - 100% B = 80 - 89% C = 70 - 79% D = 55 - 69% F = 00 - 54% Participation in discussions, as well as overall effort in class, will influence grading. Individual growth over time is most important. Missing assignments (projects, writing assignments and homework) will lower your grade. These things will be taken into consideration, especially if you are in between grades. Doing your best and turning in all assigned work will guarantee success!
