## Attendance

Part of Santiago School's philosophy is being in school every day and being on time are important for a student's success in school. Please try to schedule doctor, dental, or other appointments outside of the school day..

Regular attendance contributes to:

- high achievement and academic success
- high characteristics of responsible citizenship
- Presentation and discussion of new material occurs during class time and therefore, cannot be easily duplicated at home.
- Research has revealed that students who regularly miss school find it difficult to be successful academically.

## **Reporting an Absence**

Parents are to call the school if their child is absent. If you are unable to call the school, you must send a note explaining the absence. The note must include:

- Child's first and last name
- Date of the absence(s)
- Reason for the absence(s)
- Parent signature
