PRIORITY REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR 2021-2022 FUNDAMENTAL LOTTERY: (TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN - KINDERGARTEN, 6th and 9th GRADE)

Santa Ana Unified School District is pleased to provide you with family registration procedures and informational meetings for incoming Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grade students wishing to attend one of the fundamental schools listed below.

Registration Procedures:

- **Sibling Priority:** Students with siblings currently enrolled at any of the fundamental schools listed below are eligible. **Enrollment process must start by completing Online [SIBLING PRIORITY](#) Form, beginning Thursday, November 5, 2020, through Friday, November 20, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.**
- **Eligibility:** New Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, current 5th and 8th grade students may participate in the lottery.
- **Elementary, Intermediate and High schools:** Our One-Stop Lottery application will assist you in applying to all schools under your consideration via one application. This process can be completed by visiting the fundamental [schools of your consideration website](#) and click on **Student Information Lottery Card for Fundamental School**.
- **Lottery Application Dates:** **Monday, January 11, 2021 - Monday, January 25, 2021.** [Link for Student Information Lottery Card for Fundamental Schools hours will close at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, January 25, 2021.](#) When completing the **Lottery Card**, be ready to enter the **PARENT/GUARDIAN E-MAIL ADDRESS**. This office will use your e-mail to send you an acknowledgement that you have successfully completed your application and where you will receive your child's Lottery Receipt. **No appointments will be available to pick-up Lottery Receipts.**
- **Lottery Results:** Will be posted at each school site, on the school website, and District website on **Thursday, January 28, 2021.**
- **Selected Lottery Number:** A parent/guardian or an adult (18 years or older) must complete enrollment information via **PERMISSION CLICK(*To be Determined) beginning Thursday, January 29, 2021 – February, Thursday 11, 2021.** [Incomplete enrollment information will not be processed.](#)
