I am happy to highlight that our COVID-19 positivity rates across SAUSD have continued to remain low even after the Spring Break. Our positivity rates across our zip codes are between 1.5% and 3.5%. See below for the full report. These rates are equal or lower than the county averages.

This indicates that our students, staff, and community members worked to follow the latest safety protocols during the break, and have continued to do so since.

I again want to remind everyone that we continue in this pandemic, and even though our positivity numbers are low currently, it's hard to predict whether another variant will cause another spike. That's why it's important to remind everyone to follow safety measures including frequent handwashing and sanitation of common spaces. Additionally, anyone who is sick or has any symptoms should stay home until they recover.
