Dear SAUSD Community,

We've had to push pause on our Learning Labs this week following the stay-at-home orders from the Governor. The state had allowed us to continue operating these Labs because as they involved very small groups of students per campus, and strict health and safety guidelines were being met. But out of an abundance of caution, we wanted to suspend them until after the Winter Break.

In January, we hope to bring back some of our students to these Labs, as they offer a safe and supportive environment for them to connect to their classrooms. Eventually, we hope to have learning labs at every campus. But we're going to wait to see if we can reduce our COVID-19 positivity rates across our community.
