Weekly Update From Supt. Jerry Almendarez





Dear SAUSD community,

The District has started the weekly testing of students and staff for COVID-19. Last week, we had two pilot testing events at the District office and at Madison Elementary School. More than 600 students and staff members were tested during these two events.

I want to reassure our community that the cheek swab version of the test, which just takes a few seconds and is the least invasive, is the one we are using for students and staff. The main goal of testing is to help keep our schools as healthy and safe places for learning. But we also want testing to cause as little disruption as possible on our campuses.

As part of this testing effort, parents and guardians must provide consent for their children to participate. The District is asking that parents and guardians complete by Friday, September 17, the online version of the consent form at https://accuratelabtesting.com/ or a hard copy version that is available in schools.

Vaccines for community and staff

State guidelines now allow for any individual age 12 and older to receive a Covid-19 vaccination. The District continues to offer up-to-date information on upcoming community clinics through SAUSD partnerships. Information is available by contacting your student's school or by visiting

The District has now provided about 50,000 vaccines for employees and SAUSD community members through all local partnerships. We are working to secure more vaccination opportunities to ensure all our community members have equitable access.

In the meantime, staff and community members can also secure vaccination appointments as they become available through the Othena app, and through clinics such as those offered through Walmart, Walgreens, CVS, Albertsons, or through their own healthcare provider.
