# SAUSD The Future Begins Here

## Dear SAUSD community,

I wanted to highlight that based on legislation that passed last year, it's now a requirement for every graduating senior in California to submit an application for college financial aid — or take steps to opt out.

Grants and low-interest loans have long been available at the federal and state levels as a way to make college more accessible and affordable. But experts say California still ranks around 30th in the nation in application rates, leaving roughly \$550 million on the table each year.

Assembly Bill 469, signed into law in October, is intended to maximize the number of students who apply for and receive funding for higher education. It specifically requires school districts to make sure all 12th-graders complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid, a California Dream Act Application, or a district-provided opt-out form beginning in 2022-23. SAUSD will soon provide more information.
