Vaccines for community and staff

New State guidelines now allow for any individual age 16 and older to receive a Covid-19 vaccination. The District continues to offer each Monday a Pfizer vaccination clinic at Segerstrom High School, 2301 W. MacArthur Blvd., through a partnership with <u>Rite-Aid</u>. Registration information is available by contacting your student's school.

The District has now provided close to 34,000 vaccines for employees and SAUSD community members through all local partnerships. We are working to secure more vaccination opportunities to ensure all our community members have equitable access.

In the meantime, staff and community members can also secure vaccination appointments as they become available through the <u>Othena app</u>, and through clinics such as those offered through <u>Walgreens</u>, <u>CVS</u>, <u>Albertsons</u>, or through their own healthcare provider.
