Location: Santa Ana H. S., Rm 8205

Articulated: SAC/CYP 10 credits

Grade: 9-12

Student will be exposed to the basic three sections of the Criminal Justice System (Law Enforcement, Courts, and Corrections) and the careers within each. Students will learn about the sequential flow of the court system, the Constitutional framework, and restraints on the system.

Art of Graphic Design UC "f" Approved

Location: Century H.S., Rm 319

10 credits Grade: 9-12

Students will be given the tools and steps to organize their ideas and thought process. They will learn the steps to research a topic and communicate their process with others. Students will create an art piece from their research and organization making choices and will reflect on their piece, their choices, the meaning, the process and what was learned.

Auto Maintenance & Light Repair I

UC "g" Approved M – F

Location: Valley H.S., Rm 6-12

Articulated: SAC/CYP/GWC

Grade: 9-12

This course is a beginning automotive technician course that introduces students to automobile service and repair, shop safety, engine repair, automatic transmissions and transaxles, manual drive train and axels, suspension and steering, brakes, electrical and electronic systems, heating and air conditioning, and engine performance.

Essential Hardware Coastline College (Dual Enrollment) Location: Online

The A+ Essentials Hardware course teaches necessary competencies for an entry-level IT professional. Topics include Personal Computer Components, Operating Systems, Networks, and Security. Lecture and hands-on experience in structured labs are included. The A+ Essentials Hardware course maps to CompTIA's A+ Essentials Hardware exam. Graded or Pass/No Pass option. Transfer Credit: CSU.



Esports Internship & Social Media M – F

Location: Valley H.S., Rm 13-2

Students will create and run a successful esports social media campaign with goals and metrics using popular social media platforms and design software/tools. Students will identify roles in the esports ecosystem as they work with the different departments of a larger esports organization. Students will learn how an esports tournament (brackets) is structures and how to live stream.

Building Trades Readiness Program

Location: Century H.S., Rm 329

This foundational course will introduce students to the skills and concepts of the building and construction trades. Students will be provided the opportunity to apply these newly learned technical skills and math skills through a hands-on curriculum (called MC3 or Multi-Craft Core Curriculum) that meets pre-apprenticeship requirements for the National Building Trades Council. Students will make real world connections as they gain diversity awareness, read blueprints, use applied mathematics, and create student-centered projects using green construction practices. During this course Students will receive First Aide/CPR and OSHA 10 Safety certifications.

This is an introduction to the field of medicine. Students will research the history and trends of healthcare, careers, and medical terminology relevant in the healthcare system.
