


## When spring came, it was a time of joy.




#### One day, a kind Indian came to the Pilgrim's village.




## He liked the Pilgrims and wanted to help them.




#### Soon, more Indians came.

#### One of the Indians was called Squanto. He was their special friend.




The Indians and Pilgrims agreed to live in peace.




## They would be ready for the coming winter.




When summer ended, the Pilgrims wanted to have a feast.




They had plenty of food and many new friends. They wanted to give thanks.



"Join us," they said to the Indians. "Join us in a big feast of thanksgiving."




## "It will be a very special holiday.
