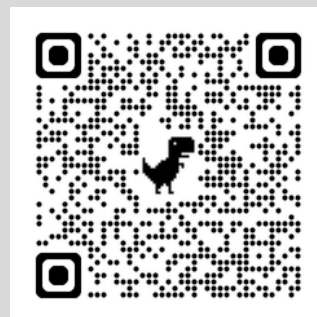
What is the PM Program at LGA?

- An opportunity to take one APEX class at a time to earn 5 credits.
- An opportunity to earn additional credits outside of your regular school day.

Requirements:

- Consistent progress in APEX class.
- Regular communication with PM teacher.
- Attempted completion of the following:
 - Practices
 - Dry Labs
 - Discussions
- Proctored items (in person or Google Meet/Zoom with camera on):
 - Pretests (can be skipped)
 - Final Exams
