BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to seek Board approval of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Orange County Department of Education/Central County Regional Occupational Program (CCROP) to establish a consortium for the purpose of meeting the minimum grant eligibility requirements of the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education (CTE) Improvement Act of 2006, Adult Section 132.

RATIONALE:

Under the Carl D. Perkins Act, a district must have enough Perkins-eligible adult students to qualify for at least a \$50,000 allocation. If the district does not, it must partner with one or more other districts. The MOU sets forth the reclassification of CCROP from an individual entity to a "Perkins Consortium" representing the Santa Ana Unified School District, Garden Grove Unified School District, and Orange Unified School District for the purpose of qualifying for application for Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006, Section 132(a)(3) funding.

Section 132 Adult Perkins funding will be used for program improvement and student support activities of adult CTE/ROP courses in the SAUSD. Board approval of the MOU will ensure that we qualify for a share of available Carl D. Perkins, Section 132 funding by establishing SAUSD as partner in the OCDE/CCROP "Perkins Consortium."
