Tuesday, January 11, 2022

CALL TO ORDER

Board President Rodriguez opened up the meeting at 5:05 p.m.

Other members present were Ms. Torres, Dr. Alvarez, and Mr. Palacio. Mrs. Amezcua was not present.

CLOSED SESSION PRESENTATIONS

Dr. Rodriguez asked if there was anyone wishing to address the Board related to closed session items.

There was no one wishing to address the Board.

Dr. Rodriguez read the following statement: With respect to Item 2.4, the facts and circumstances resulting in significant exposure to litigation are: (1) the District entered into a contract with Data Systems International, Inc. for software and software maintenance services; (2) the District believes that the contract previously expired, and the District no longer uses the software; (3) Data Systems International believes that it is entitled to additional payments from the District; and (4) the District has disputed that it is responsible for such costs.

## SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez provided an update on the Native American Grant. The District has registered to apply for the grant with the state. The District has received 506 forms. Parents were called December 20 - 21, 2021. There are 133 Native Americans recorded in AERIES. As a result, there are 25 parents that are interested in forming a Native American Advisory Committee. Superintendent wished everyone a Happy New Year and added that he is confident that by working together, we can continue to make progress in the year ahead towards our goal of preparing all students to compete in a global workforce. Mr. Almendarez thanked all staff, families and overall community for their support and tireless work this past week as we returned to school following the winter break. He stated that there has been some incredible challenges facing schools across the nation with this omicron variant and that SAUSD has seen a large spike in illnesses of staff members, students, and families, but continue to persevere despite the obstacles. Superintendent Almendarez assured the community that the safety of all students and staff remains top priority and to achieve these goals the District is proactively taking several measures. A one-minute video highlighting efforts was played. He added that weekly COVID-19 testing continues for all students and staff which allows for mitigation of transmission at schools. He shared that as of Monday, January 10, the COVID positivity rate for testing in schools was at 2.1%. This is well below the county and state averages of 21% and 22% respectively. This indicates that the vast majority of students and staff at school sites are healthy, and those who feel ill are staying home. He announced that free testing clinics for all Santa Ana community members are being held. Maintaining safe schools is only possible if the overall community is healthy. He encouraged anyone who needs testing to take advantage of this resource and invited everyone to visit [www.sausd.us](http://www.sausd.us) or follow SAUSD on social media for the latest on these free community clinics. Mr. Almendarez announced that January is California School Board Recognition Month and recognized SAUSD Board members. He shared that in this time of unprecedented challenges, the Board has worked to support student learning and mental wellness across all schools. He acknowledged the dedication each of the five elected Board members have demonstrated in supporting children and staff and on behalf of the entire District, he offered his most sincere thank you.

## PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Public speakers addressed, COVID staffing, COVID protocols, COVID quarantine policy, displacement of Special Education mild/moderate teacher, DSDP, Sant Ana Com-Link, Head Start, and Special Education. Emails to the Office of the Superintendent also addressed increased COVID cases, increasing hours for Library Media Techs, summer school, internet infrastructure, displacement of SPED teacher.

#### BOARD REPORTS

Mr. Palacio welcomed everyone back from the holiday. He is looking forward to this year and to start addressing the issues of how students are performing academically.

Dr. Alvarez encouraged everyone to get vaccinated and encouraged people that are sick to stay home. He thanked everyone who is taking care of testing. He expressed concern in regards to having access to enough tests. Last Friday, there was about 75 people in line and wants to ensure testing is accessible to community members. Dr. Alvarez requested to get an update on the joint use agreements with City and to know which ones have expired in

B2B. He also requested that the District look into the lighting at different sites. There is a lack of lighting in front of Santa Ana High School.

Ms. Torres thanked staff for the presentation and the public speakers. She shared that she sends emails received with concerns to the Superintendent and apologized if she is not replying to all emails. She addressed her concerns over staffing shortages and asked how staff is handling the after school programs in terms of COVID rates, identification of students, and contact tracing. Ms. Torres announced that she and Dr. Alvarez have been invited to a few sub committees with the City and are working with them on the joint committee counsel and will keep everyone posted. She also addressed her concerns with Roosevelt and the fact that they don't have doors and how that may be affecting rates at the school site. Ms. Torres also commented on the displacement of the special education teacher.


Dr. Rodriguez acknowledged the work of the District with respect to the grant for California Native American families. He looks forward to a conversation that highlights this work and could potentially be part of the CSBA Conference. He also thanked the public for raising critical questions, observations, and experiences, especially comments on how they are experiencing COVID on the ground. Dr. Rodriguez shared a COVID numbers update. At the end of week 21 (January 7, 2022, 1,240 students were out. He shared that some people have contacted him to suggest remote learning, however, in week 3 of the school year there were 1,376 students out and the District did not go to remote learning. He added that if numbers change, protocols will be activated. He reminded everyone that on March 13, 2020, the Board delegated authority to the Superintendent to make decisions. There is a mechanism used for tracking what is happening in the classroom, site level and the district. A Classroom can go online because of the number of kids that are positive or quarantined and school sites have a 10% guideline of student positivity rates that the Superintendent will use as a threshold to make decisions. Dr. Rodriguez thanked Dr. Nazir and Andrea Foster who are anchoring a whole team on the protocols. There are two important values that are being juggled which are public health and education through in-person instruction. He asked that the Superintendent inform parents now if there is a trend. Dr. Rodriguez asked that staff continue to track absences and encouraged everyone to work together.



CONFIRMING THE DESIGNATION OF DIRECTORS FOR THE

**WHEREAS**, in or around December of 1989, the Santa Ana Unified School District ("District") caused the "Santa Ana Unified School District Public Facilities Corporation" ("Corporation") to be established as a California nonprofit public benefit corporation; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 12, 1989, the Corporation adopted certain "Bylaws of Santa Ana Unified School District Public Facilities Corporation" ("Bylaws"), which provide for, among other things, the Corporation to be governed by a board of directors ("Corporation Board"); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.03 of the Bylaws provides that the members of the Board of Education of the Santa Ana Unified School District ("Board of Education") shall designate the persons who shall serve on the Corporation Board (each such person a "Director"), and that no person shall be eligible to serve as a Director unless initially approved by resolution of the Board of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.03 of the Bylaws also provides that a designated person shall serve as Director for the same term as the Board of Education member who designated that particular person (or until a successor has been designated and has accepted the Director position), and that a Board of Education member who designated a person to be a Director may, with or without cause, remove that person from the Director position; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.05 of the Bylaws provides that, on the second Tuesday of January of each year (or, if that is a holiday, the next following business day), the Corporation Board shall hold an annual organizational meeting for purposes of, among other things, selecting the officers of the Corporation Board ("Annual Organizational Meeting"); and

**WHEREAS**, certain persons who are or were serving as Directors, or as Directors holding particular offices with the Corporation, will no longer be acting in those specific roles and, therefore, the Board of Education must designate persons who will serve as Directors on the Corporation Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has selected a person to fill the position with the District of Associate Superintendent\Chief Business Official, and the District desires to clarify that the person in that position is one of the District officers who will serve as a Director on the Corporation Board; and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the requirement in Section 3.03 of the Bylaws for adoption of a resolution, the District desires that the Board of Education adopt this Resolution to confirm and clarify the designations, by titles or positions, of the persons who will serve as Directors on the Corporation Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the District desires that the Board of Education's designation of Directors pursuant to this Resolution apply on an *ex officio* basis to whomever may, from time to time, hold the titles or be in the positions identified herein, such that it will not be necessary for the Board of Education to adopt additional resolutions designating Directors of the Corporation Board unless and until the Board of Education desires to alter such *ex officio* designations; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Education hereby determines, orders, and resolves as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board of Education hereby approves the designation, by title or position, of the following persons as Directors who will serve on the Corporation Board: (i) the person who is the President of the Board of Education ("President"); (ii) the person who is the Vice President of the Board of Education ("Vice President"); (iii) the person who is the District's Superintendent of Schools ("Superintendent"); (iv) the person who is the District's Associate Superintendent/Chief Business Official ("Associate Superintendent"); and (v) the person who is the District's Assistant Superintendent of Facilities and Governmental Relations.


**Section 2.** The Board of Education hereby determines and orders that the designations of Directors set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution shall be deemed and construed to constitute perennial and recurring designations, applicable to whomever may from time to time hold the titles or fill the positions identified in Section 1 of this Resolution or their functional equivalents, and, therefore, it shall not be necessary for the Board of Education to annually or otherwise designate Directors unless and until the Board of Education desires to alter the designations set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution.

**Section 3.** Because the persons who will serve as Directors on the Corporation Board, as set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution, have been designated by majority vote of the Board of Education, and not by members of the Board of Education acting individually, the Board of Education, by majority vote and without need for cause, may remove from the Director position any person who holds that position as a result of the designation in Section 1 of this Resolution.


**Section 4.** The Board of Education hereby authorizes and directs the Superintendent, the Associate Superintendent, and/or their respective designees, to take any and all such actions as reasonably may be necessary to implement the intent and effect of this Resolution, including, without limitation, the filing from time to time as necessary, with the California Secretary of State, of updated Statements of Information in accordance with California Corporations Code Section 6210 or, as applicable, successor laws.

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 66006(b)(2) requires that the Board of Education of the District ("Board") review the information made available to the public, including the report entitled "Annual and Five-Year Reportable Developer Fees Report for Fiscal Year 2020-2021" ("Report") at the next regularly scheduled public meeting, at least fifteen (15) days after the Report was made available to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Report contains the requisite information and proposed findings concerning the collection and expenditure of Reportable Fees pursuant to Government Code Sections 66006 and 66001; and







WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the District adopted Resolution No.21/22-3426 on September 14, 2021, to place before the electors residing within the District's boundaries a ballot measure calling for term limits for members of the Governing Board, limiting board members to 3 terms; Lifetime

WHEREAS, the action by the Governing Board to submit such a proposal to the electors shall be subject to procedures set out in Election Code Section 9500 and sections that follow; and

WHEREAS, by law, a proposal to limit the number of terms a member of a governing board may serve shall apply prospectively only and shall not become operative unless submitted to the electors of a district at the November 8, 2022, election and a majority of votes cast are in favor of such a proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That, the matter of term limits shall be submitted to the electors of the school district at the regularly scheduled election on November 8, 2022, and that with the adoption of this Resolution, the Superintendent is directed to initiate all necessary steps to effectuate the desires of a majority of the Governing Board to place before the electors the proposition of imposing term limits on members of the Board and limit the number of terms a member of the Board may serve to 3 terms; Lifetime
2. That the Superintendent shall periodically provide information to the Governing Board regarding the execution of the terms of this Resolution and advise as to any other steps that are still contemplated.



**RESPONSIBLE OFFICE(S):** Educational Services, Support Services

### **SCOPE:**

The Governing Board of Santa Ana Unified School District recognizes that suicide is the leading cause of death among youth and should be taken seriously. In order to attempt to reduce suicidal behavior and its impact on all students and families, the Superintendent or designee shall develop strategies and procedures for prevention, intervention, and postvention.

In developing strategies and procedures for use by the district, the Superintendent or designee may involve school health professionals, school counselors, school social workers, school psychologists, administrators, other staff, parents/guardians, students, local health agencies, mental health professionals, law enforcement, and community organizations in planning, implementing, and evaluating the district's strategies and procedures for suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention.

### **POLICY:**

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure procedures are age appropriate and be delivered and discussed in a manner that is sensitive to the needs of students, inclusive, of kindergarten and grades 1-6. (Education Code 215)

Implementation of prevention strategies and intervention procedures shall include, but are not limited to:

1. Promoting a positive school climate enhancing student's feelings of connectedness with school and is characterized by caring staff and harmonious interrelationships among students.

2. Instruction to promote the health, mental, emotional, and social development of students including, but not limited to, the development of problem-solving skills, coping skills, and self-esteem, as well as instruction in recognizing and appropriately responding to warning signs of suicidal intent in others.

3. Students will be educated and encouraged to notify appropriate school personnel or other adults when they are experiencing thoughts of suicide or when they suspect or have knowledge of another student's suicidal ideations or intent. A school employee shall act only within the authorization and scope of his/her credential or license. An employee is not authorized to

diagnose or treat mental illness unless he/she is specifically licensed and employed by Santa Ana Unified School District to do so. (Education Code 215)

4. Staff development on suicide awareness and prevention for **all** district employees who interact with students including teachers of pupils in all of the grades, as described in the accompanying administrative regulation. Training shall be designed to help staff members identify and respond to students at risk of suicide. This includes staff development on risk factors, warnings signs, protective factors, response procedures with emphasis on immediately (same day) referring a student, referrals, and school and community resources regarding suicide prevention and mental health.

5. Education and information to be provided to parents/guardians regarding risk factors and warning signs of suicide, the severity of the suicide problem among youth, the district's suicide prevention curriculum, basic steps for helping suicidal youth, and/or school and community resources that can help youth in crisis.
6. Crisis intervention procedures to ensure student safety and appropriate communications for addressing suicide threats and attempts or in the event that a suicide occurs. Intervention procedures shall ensure proper coordination and consultation with the county mental health plan if a referral is made for mental health or related services on behalf of a pupil who is a Medi-Cal beneficiary.
7. Counseling and other postvention strategies to help students, staff, and families cope with the aftermath of a suicide attempt or a student who has died by suicide.

As appropriate, these strategies and procedures shall specifically address the needs of students who are at high risk of suicide, including but not limited to, students who are bereaved by suicide; students with disabilities, mental illness, or substance use disorders; students who are experiencing homelessness or who are in out-of-home settings such as foster care; and students who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or questioning youth. (Education Code 215)

### **DESIRED OUTCOME:**

The Superintendent or designee shall coordinate a Suicide Prevention Task Force for the district to lead the development of prevention, intervention, and postvention supports. The Suicide Prevention Task Force shall include representatives from all district departments, as well as school administrators, community partners, parents, and students. Further, each school shall identify at least one staff member, preferably an assistant principal or lead school counselor, to serve as liaison to the Suicide Prevention Task Force and coordinate suicide prevention activities, resources, and protocols for their specific school site. The Suicide Prevention Task Force may also serve as an advisory group for mental health services,
