7. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez took a moment to recognize our SAUSD Board of Education's devotion to making sure our students have all the resources they need for success. Our Board is often tasked with ensuring accountability while also supporting and advocating for our children in our public schools. The Superintendent stated that each of our five elected board members, whether they have served our District for years, or are new to their role, is driven by their commitment to education. School boards have a tremendous impact not just in our communities, but in our democracy overall. Superintendent thanked our Board Members for all that they do as leaders of our community. Superintendent shared that in February, SAUSD will launch the annual "We Care" campaign. The purpose of this important initiative is to bring awareness to mental health in our schools and community. As educators, we are often at the forefront of helping identify, treat, and provide support for our youth dealing with mental health issues. Over the next month, SAUSD will share resources and opportunities to support the mental health of all our children. This will culminate with a "We Care" resource fair on February 16th at Saddleback High School. Superintendent asked that the community follow SAUSD on social media and visit www.sausd.us for updates and more information as we launch our "We Care" 2024 campaign. The Superintendent shared that we are witnessing a concerning rise in thefts and vandalism at our school sites in SAUSD and across the region. Dr. Rodriguez highlighted the resolution of a strike at Cal State Long Beach involving the faculty union, emphasizing the importance of communication with administration, and the confidence in the administration's ability to address issues. He addressed the public speaker's comment on the differential treatment of substitutes and requested follow up. He thanked Lupe Lopez and Ginger Lopez for their comments and

expressed his appreciation for their meaningful work. Dr. Rodriguez also addressed the presidential campaign and urged support to engage the community deliberately. Focus is placed on registering high school seniors to vote, promoting an ethnic studies conference, and embedding it in the curriculum.

Ms. Brazer Aceves echoed Dr. Rodriguez' comments and shared her appreciation for what was said, how it ties into wellness and mental health. She thanked our certificated and classified employees of the month. She expressed her excitement on seeing Ms. Shwartz being recognized today and had how she had the opportunity to read to her class last year. Thinks of We care campaign all year. Ms. Brazer Aceves highlighted her participation in Classified Employee of the Year surprise visits. She thanked Mr. Godinez, Rosie Alatorre, Joel Cruz for the opportunity to be part of the restorative practice site visits at Valley, Santa Ana, and Saddleback High Schools and sent a special shout to the staff and administration. She highlighted the gift from High School Inc. and looks forward to learning more about the program, the field trips for college tours, and lastly, she announced an event co-hosted by Libro Movil this coming Saturday, featuring Ernesto Cisneros from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. with coffee sponsored by Cafecito.

Mr. Bustos wished everyone a Happy New Year, expressing his excitement for the upcoming year. He thanked the Cabinet, Board, and the team for emphasizing their commitment to serving students and families. He congratulated seniors for submitting college applications, and acknowledged their anticipation of acceptance letters and accompanying nerves. He also highlighted students that are excited about going into the workforce, those who are preparing through our CTE program, and the support being provided to them by our counselors and coordinators.

Dr. Alvarez highlighted the awesome Native American community event that took place this past Saturday and is looking forward to the next one. He gave a shout out to the two Santa Ana High School students who made the honor choir and are traveling to Sacramento.

Ms. Torres shared about her attendance at the Equity is Love conference last week and was pleased to see principals there. She was part of a community schools panel discussing ongoing efforts and continuous refinement in creating an inclusive environment. She also shared that she attended the American Native event where she encountered family. She echoed the call to protect students from campaign rhetoric, emphasizing the need to ensure student safety, value, and affirmation. Suggested we revisit resolutions or statements to reaffirm our stances. She also requested follow up on voter registration. Lastly, she urged everyone to wash their hands to avoid getting sick.





Proclamation Declaring February 21, 2024 as We Care Day

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education unanimously passes this resolution acknowledging mental health awareness and prevention as vital in our schools and community to address the increase in childhood and adolescent mental health concerns, such as anxiety, depression, suicidal ideation, and trauma; and

WHEREAS, people of all ages experience trauma, which has a long-lasting impact on children and adolescents that is exacerbated by the lack of access to mental health services and coping skills to manage the impact of traumatic events in their young lives; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a profound impact on the mental health and wellness of all ages, particularly children and adolescents, it highlights the need for reducing stigma and shame surrounding mental illness to encourage students to seek and obtain help; and

WHEREAS, 1 in 6 youth in the U.S. aged 6-17 experience a mental health disorder each year, campaigning for mental health, wellness, and prevention initiatives, and efforts can create safe and trusting school and community environments to improve students' self-efficacy, connectedness, and increase seek-helping behaviors; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District understands the importance of providing a safe and inclusive school climate and culture by promoting relevant and appropriate mental health and wellness resources for ALL students, such as creating and establishing the "We Care, Get Help" Campaign. The "We Care, Get Help" Campaign is a districtwide Suicide Prevention and Mental Health awareness movement developed to send messages of care and hope, increase student's comfort

in seeking assistance, adequately equip staff to respond to crisis situations, and increase awareness of mental health warning signs; and

WHEREAS, the school district acknowledges that mental health and suicide prevention initiatives, efforts, and campaigns can effectively implement the policies outlined by the California Education Code Section 215, which mandates that the Governing Board of any local educational agency that serves pupils in grades seven to twelve, inclusive, adopt a policy on pupil suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention. "We Care, Get Help" Campaign aims to address the three key areas and initiate prevention efforts with students as young as 5 years old and implement mental health, wellness, and suicide preventions efforts in each of the K-12 school sites; and

WHEREAS, among other supports, the District places an emphasis on awareness and prevention efforts by increasing the number of students being connected with mental health services. It has approved a memorandum of understanding with several community agencies to ensure that students and families in the District have access to local mental health resources and education. The District has developed partnerships such as: OC Health Care Agency, Western Youth Services, National Alliance on Mental Illness, American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, and Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services to support district-wide resources; and

WHEREAS, among other supports, the District has also increased credentialed and licensed personnel, such as school counselors, school social workers, and mental health providers, to ensure that students have access to appropriate school mental health resources; to ensure support is available when students are challenged by a mental health crisis. The Santa Ana Unified School District is committed to providing a safe and supportive environment that teaches and promotes suicide prevention, mental health, and emotional wellness for ALL students; and

WHEREAS, schools play a critical role in ensuring that LGBTQ students have access to supportive spaces and the mental health care they need, and have a right to be in a place that is safe, supportive, and not harmful to their mental or physical health; and

WHEREAS, Kinder Future LLC has been providing targeted support to gender and

sexual minority (GSM) youth and outreach to LGBTQI+ students and their families since 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District (SAUSD) has developed a strategic partnership with the LGBTQ Center OC and has engaged in monthly LGBTQ Support Planning meetings with the OC LGBTQ Center, based in Santa Ana; and

WHEREAS, the SAUSD Support Services has been working to create inclusive school climates where gender and sexual minority students feel welcomed, including the "Safe Zone" campaign initiated in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Support Services is supporting the planning of the annual LGBTQ Youth Convening, a county-wide conference for LGBTQI+ youth, families, and professionals, which will be hosted at Segerstrom High School in May 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Trustees of the Santa Ana Unified School District recognizes February 21, 2024 as the districtwide We Care Day to collectively raise awareness about mental health and suicide prevention as an unified front within the Santa Ana Unified School District and its community partners.


