## SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez thanked staff for going above and beyond these last few weeks in helping keep schools stay open and safe places for learning. Many staff members have filled in multiple roles in addition to their regular duties. Others have continued to support students remotely as they faced their own health issues. A photo from Lincoln Elementary's Facebook page was displayed that shows Mrs. Elaine Vique, who continued to teach her kindergarten class virtually while she was in quarantine. There are countless other examples like Mrs. Vique, of staff who have shown relentless dedication. He announced that based on the latest data, he is encouraged that SAUSD is trending in the right direction in terms of improved attendance rates, and decreased COVID-19 positivity cases in schools. He added that health experts have indicated we could be reaching a turning point in this latest surge caused by the omicron variant but cautioned that it is not a time to let our guard down. Weekly testing continues at all sites for students and staff and community testing across the district for parents and overall community. He also invited the public to visit [www.sausd.us](http://www.sausd.us) or to follow the district's social media channels for the latest testing opportunities and other resources. Mr. Almendarez shared that the COVID-19 Dashboard has been updated with the latest information as of this afternoon and that the numbers reflected are for the previous 14 days. He stated that the dashboard was temporarily removed so that staff could evaluate, update, and confirm the reported data for accuracy. Returning from winter break, SAUSD saw an increase in COVID-19 cases among students and staff. He added that this increase in positive cases is not related to school-based transmission, but rather the overall increase in infection across the region. Mr. Almendarez provided a short update on the rollout of the ethnic studies program. Currently the District is focusing on foundational trainings for administrators, counselors, and Ethnic Studies teachers. Soon the District will begin to promote with incoming freshman information about the different course options available for them next fall. Everyone is excited for what is ahead and because the Ethnic Studies program will be aligned with the Graduate Profile. A one-minute video was shared. Superintendent announced that a Special Education meeting was held in December with a group of about 40 parents of students in special education programs. He thanked those parents for attending and for providing valuable input to better help identify the priorities going forward for special education services and looks forward to continuing to meet with the special education parent community. Superintendent Almendarez also thanked the City of Santa Ana and everyone involved Saturday in the unveiling of the beautification project at the corner of Willits and Sullivan streets across from Lincoln Elementary. This event was a collaboration between the school district, the city, and neighborhood association. Families from both Lincoln and Monte Vista schools were involved in discussions for this project. The sculpture depicts an iconic and sacred image of the Aztec and Nahuatl peoples. He encouraged everyone to see this sculpture in person when they have an opportunity.

Superintendent addressed the renaming of Romero Cruz Academy. The District is currently working at the request of the family of Lydia Romero Cruz to add 'Lydia' to the official name of the school. The District is following all Board Policies and Administrative Regulations moving forward with this initiative. More information on the progress of this effort will be provided as it becomes available. Finally, Mr. Almendarez thanked Mr. Greg Magnuson as his service to the district ends. Mr. Magnuson has provided crucial support over the past few months to various departments across this district, including human resources and business services. Mr. Magnuson's leadership and invaluable experience has helped guide the district through a challenging time. He wished Mr. Magnuson the very best as he resumes his retirement.

## PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Board President Rodriguez read the following statement with respect to the public speaker that called in at the January 11th Board meeting and to clarify the process of comments shared by the public:

The board respects the right of members of the public to speak to the board regarding matters on the agenda and other matters within the jurisdiction of the board. However, it is important for members of the public to understand that derogatory comments against district employees, or others, made in a board meeting can be actionable as defamation under certain circumstances. In addition, derogatory comments made at a board meeting, which are repeated outside the context of a board meeting, also may be actionable as defamation. In addition, the board wishes to make clear that it is bound by the limitations set forth in Government Code section 54957, which states that when specific complaints or charges are to be made against a district employee, such employee has the right to have such complaints heard in closed session and to be given prior notice that such complaints will be heard by the board. Therefore, members of the public who wish to lodge complaints against district employees are reminded that the board cannot properly consider such complaints without giving prior notice to the named employee. The board also would like to remind anyone who wishes to lodge a complaint against a district employee that there is an existing adopted board policy in effect specifically for this purpose. This policy contains a comprehensive

procedure for reviewing and investigating public complaints, which includes a right of appeal to the board. This process provides a much more thorough opportunity for the complainant and the employee to be heard and the merits of the complaint to be properly investigated. Anyone who wishes to receive a copy of this policy may contact the superintendent's office.

BOARD REPORTS

Mrs. Amezcua requested a confirmation on B2B that the girls bathrooms are set up with free female products. She also requested to change the name Romero Cruz Academy to include the name Lydia soon and to make sure someone reaches out to the Romero family. Mrs. Amezcua emphasized the importance of true and accurate information especially when dealing with the media. She addressed the article published by the Voice of OC.

Mr. Palacio asked that someone talk to the Romero family. He addressed the shut down of the COVID-19 Dashboard and requested that there needs to be communication with the community and staff when there is important information. Mr. Palacio requested information on the Adult Transition Program agreement with Santa Ana College and the agreement with the Remington site. He addressed the supplemental sick leave and requested additional information in regards to FMLA.

Dr. Alvarez shared that last Sunday, he attended the Santa Ana High School WASC accreditation along with Superintendent Almendarez and Dr. Susie Lopez-Guerra. He thanked the administration, teachers, and parents for their preparation. He addressed the Adult Transition Program and asked how we can formalize the agreement with Santa Ana College. Dr. Alvarez also asked that the District to take a look at the substitute concerns. He shared that vaccinations are being distributed at the District and Valley High School as well as testing. He encouraged everyone not to let their guard down and to continue following safety protocols.

Ms. Torres echoed the concerns with the re-naming of Lydia Romero Cruz and addressed the article by Voice of OC. Ms. Torres also addressed the COVID Dashboard and asked for additional information on the data being provided to the community. The community deserves to see the information on the dashboard. Ms. Torres thanked all staff at sites and District for hanging in there as well as staff that has had to take time off. She echoed the concerns on substitute pay and substitute requirements. She reiterated that there is a uniform complaint process. if you witness something inappropriate, fill out the forms. It is important that it is on record. Ms. Torres asked staff to re-post somewhere and highlight it on the website. She thanked the District for testing at sites and community and encouraged everyone to continue getting tested. Ms. Torres provided an update on the joint committee with City and is waiting for it to be put on the agenda by the City Council. She shared that the subcommittee does not share decision making power. Lastly, she commented on the rent control that was passed. She encouraged the district to take a role to provide information to the community. It was suggested in the Superintendent's Advisory Committee and was dismissed. She asked that those suggestions be taken seriously.

Dr. Rodriguez reiterated the items that need to be followed up on as follows: Superintendent to convene a team meeting with Mr. Palacio and Dr. Rodriguez related to contracts, insurance, and producing a matrix; Schedule an initial conversation on substitutes at next closed session meeting; Superintendent's office to initiate process and support for Student Board Member/s and bring back to the Board based on the timeline proposed; Mr. Palacio asked for follow up Family Medical Leave of Absence and cases of staff with COVID in terms of policy and how we are responding to staff members who have experienced deleterious effects from COVID in B2B; Request from Mr. Palacio to ensure that information on the complaint process is posted clearly on the District website; Updated information on the COVID dashboard; Dr. Alvarez requested an update on the Adult Transition Program, one on ones with Board and B2B; Dr. Rodriguez asked for a list of all request at the end of Board meetings to know which ones have already been addressed and which ones are still pending list in B2B. Dr. Rodriguez addressed the CA Ed. Code, Title I, Division 1, Part 1, Article 2.7 LGBTQ+ Pupil Resources. He requested a B2B update on where the District is at with those resources. He commented on the COVID crisis. The District is trying its best. He thanked teachers, classified staff, and also to District staff for coming together attentive to the needs, Andrea Foster and Sara Nazir who coordinate a team, Dr. Susie for the community health and community partners. Dr. Rodriguez addressed the public speakers who spoke.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Board President adjourned the meeting at 10:06 p.m.

## Proclamation Declaring Wednesday, February 16, 2022 as “We Care Day”

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education unanimously passes this resolution acknowledging mental health awareness and prevention as vital in our schools and community to address the increase in childhood and adolescent mental health concerns, such as anxiety, depression, suicidal ideation, and trauma;

WHEREAS, people of all ages experience trauma, which has a long-lasting impact on children and adolescents' that is exacerbated by the lack of access to mental health services and coping skills to manage the impact of traumatic events in their young lives;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a profound impact on the mental health and wellness of all ages, particularly children and adolescents, it highlights the need for reducing stigma and shame surrounding mental illness to encourage students to seek and obtain help;

WHEREAS, 1 in 6 youth in the U.S. aged 6-17 experience a mental health disorder each year, campaigning for mental health, wellness, and prevention initiatives, and efforts can create safe and trusting school and community environments to improve students' self-efficacy, connectedness, and increase seek-helping behaviors;

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District understands the importance of providing a safe and inclusive school climate and culture by promoting relevant and appropriate mental health and wellness resources for ALL students, such as creating and establishing the “We Care, Get Help” Campaign. The “We Care, Get Help” Campaign is a districtwide Suicide Prevention and Mental Health awareness movement developed to send



1 messages of care and hope, increase student's comfort in seeking assistance, adequately equip staff to respond to  
2 crisis situations, and increase awareness of mental health warning signs;

3 WHEREAS, the school district acknowledges that mental health and suicide prevention initiatives,  
4 efforts, and campaigns can effectively implement the policies outlined by the California Education Code Section  
5 215, which mandates that the Governing Board of any local educational agency that serves pupils in grades seven  
6 to twelve, inclusive, adopt a policy on pupil suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention. "We Care, Get  
7 Help" Campaign aims to address the three key areas and initiate prevention efforts with students as young as 5  
8 years old and implement mental health, wellness, and suicide preventions efforts in each of the K-12 school sites.

9 WHEREAS, among other supports, the District places an emphasis on awareness and prevention efforts  
10 by increasing the number of students being connected with mental health services. It has approved a memorandum  
11 of understanding with several community agencies to ensure that students and families in the District have access  
12 to local mental health resources and education. The District has developed a memorandum of understanding with  
13 community agencies such as: OC Health Care Agency, Western Youth Services, National Alliance on Mental  
14 Illness, American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, and Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services to support district-  
15 wide resources; and

16 WHEREAS, among other supports, the District has also increased credentialed and licensed personnel,  
17 such as school counselors and school social workers, to ensure that students have access to appropriate school  
18 mental health resources; to ensure support is available when students are challenged by a mental health crisis.  
19 The Santa Ana Unified School District is committed to providing a safe and supportive environment that teaches  
20 and promotes suicide prevention, mental health, and emotional wellness for ALL students.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Trustees of the Santa Ana Unified School  
22 District recognizes February 16, 2022 as the districtwide "We Care Day" to collectively raise awareness about  
23 mental health and suicide prevention as an unified front within the Santa Ana Unified School District and its  
24 community partners.
