## REGULAR AGENDA - PRESENTATION

## EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT AND CALIFORNIA OFFICE TO REFORM EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP

Superintendent Miller opened the conversation with the transition of No Child Left Behind (NCLB) and Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and the California Office to Reform Education (CORE). Dr. Haglund, Deputy Superintendent, Educational Services added that SAUSD is very well suited and positioned for the transition. Dr. Rodriguez, Assistant Superintendent, K-12 Teaching and Learning provided the Board with an update on the focus on college and career readiness, the development of the District's accountability system, increased collaboration, flexibility funding and based on the growth model, everyone will be held accountable. Ms. Pueblos, Assistant Superintendent, K-12 Performance and Culture stated that the District will focus on the individual growth of every student using Rasch Unit Scale (RIT). Administrators will be able to pull data and reports on their students within 24-hours. Further, ESSA is aligned with SAUSD's priorities, well rounded curriculum with a focus on personalized learning. The implementation of ESSA begins in the 2017-18 school year.
