Regular Board Meeting Held Telephonically
Santa Ana Board of Education

Tuesday, January 26, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.

Other members participating were Ms. Torres, Dr. Alvarez, Ms. Amezcua, and Mr. Palacio.

CLOSED SESSION PRESENTATIONS

Dr. Rodriguez asked if there was anyone wishing to address the Board related to closed session items.

There was no one wishing to address the Board related to closed session items.

RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION

The Regular Board meeting recessed to closed session at 5:01 p.m. to consider existing litigation, personnel matters, labor negotiations, and real property negotiations.

RECONVENE REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Board meeting reconvened at 6:22 p.m.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez informed the community that the District has started working with student leaders at every high school in the district to plan for the upcoming graduation season. The goal is to have some sort of in-person celebration that follows all safety protocols for students, staff and families. This could include a thrive-thru ceremony, or similar variation, as long as health conditions permit at the time. Seniors have already sacrificed so much over the past year, so they deserve all the recognition we can provide to celebrate their achievements. He added that the community would be updated as these plans are further developed.

Mr. Almendarez also gave a vaccine update. He stated that District staff is in regular communication with the Orange County Health Care Agency to make sure we're prepared for the roll out of vaccines for education workers. Some district nurses and Santa Ana School Police officers have received the vaccine as they are in the Tier 1A group that includes first responders. Teachers and other staff who work directly with our community could start being vaccinated in February. He stated that he is looking forward to receiving his vaccine when it is his turn in line, and he encouraged everyone to get vaccinated as soon as they are eligible. Superintendent Almendarez also shared that our Covid-19 positivity rates are starting to slowly fall, which is a sign of the work we're doing together to protect our community but that the numbers still remain high overall. He

asked the community to continue following all safety guidelines, including mask wearing, practicing social distancing, avoiding unnecessary gatherings, and following proper hygiene standards.

Superintendent Almendarez also acknowledge staff who has worked tirelessly to reopen our learning labs this week at 12 campuses. These Labs offer a critical resource to support some of our students facing the greatest obstacles. He stated that all administrators, certificated and classified staff who worked to prepare these schools as safe and supportive learning spaces for our children deserve a special thanks. He added that in the next few weeks he hopes to phase in other campuses across the district, so we can reach a wider range of students. Mr. Almendarez announced that January is National School Board Recognition Month. He recognized and thanked the Board of Education. He added that he has gotten to know each of our five Board members over the past year and that without a doubt each one of them is dedicated to supporting our students, our schools and our communities. He added that they hold the District responsible, ask tough questions, and sometimes they have to make decisions that might not make everyone happy, but they do it because of the oath they have taken to provide a critical accountability link between the schools and the community.

**BOARD OF EDUCATION

**TO MAKE CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS AND FINDINGS PURSUANT TO
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 4217.10, ET SEQ. AND FOR AUTHORIZATION
TO ENTER INTO MULTIPLE POWER PURCHASING AGREEMENTS WITH
SOLARSTORAGE FUND D, LLC AND LICENSE AGREEMENTS WITH
SUNPOWER CORPORATION SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS, SolarStorage Fund D, LLC (“SolarStorage”) conducted an evaluation of certain District facilities in need of cost efficient advanced solar energy storage, as identified in **Attachment A** attached hereto (individually a “Facility”, or collectively “Facilities”), identified Energy Conservation Measures (as herein defined) for the District at each Facility as identified in **Attachment A** attached hereto, and prepared an analysis demonstrating savings that the District could realize with the installation of the Energy Conservation Measures at the Facilities attached hereto in **Attachment A** (“SolarStorage Analysis”); and

WHEREAS, SolarStorage represented to the District that SolarStorage can and will design, pay a third party contractor to construct, and maintain certain “conservation measures” as defined in Government Code section 4217.11 in the form of advanced solar energy storage equipment at the Facilities (collectively, “Energy Conservation Measures”); and

WHEREAS, SolarStorage has analyzed the energy needs at the Facilities and has concluded, as supported by the SolarStorage Analysis, that the installation and construction of the Energy Conservation Measures at the Facilities will result in an anticipated reduction in energy consumption or demand that will result in net cost savings to the District in the amount of \$1,757,890 (“Cost Savings”); and

WHEREAS, SolarStorage has represented to the District that SolarStorage can design, cause a third-party contractor to construct, and maintain those Energy Conservation Measures at the Facilities; and

WHEREAS, based upon the SolarStorage Analysis attached in **Attachment A**, and presentation by District staff, the cost to the District for SolarStorage to design, construct, and maintain the Energy Conservation Measures at each Facility will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of thermal, electrical, or other energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of the Energy Conservation Measures; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 4217.12(a) authorizes a public agency to enter into an energy services contract if the determination is made at a regularly scheduled public hearing, public notice of which is given at least two weeks in advance, and if the governing body finds that the anticipated cost to the public agency for thermal or electrical energy or conservation services provided by the energy conservation facility under the contract will be less than the anticipated

marginal cost to the public agency of thermal, electrical, or other energy that would have been consumed by the public agency in the absence of those purchases, is anticipated to be offset by below-market energy purchases or other benefits provided under the energy service contract; and

WHEREAS, on this date, pursuant to Government Code section 4217.10 *et seq.*, this Governing Board held a public hearing with respect to the District entering into battery services agreements with SolarStorage to design, pay a third party contractor to construct, and maintain Energy Conservation Measures at each Facility (“BSA”). A copy of the form of BSA is attached hereto as **Attachment B** and incorporated herein by reference (“Energy Service Contract”). The BSA includes a form of EPC Contractor License Contract attached as **Exhibit 2** thereto (“License Agreement”) that permits Sunpower Corporation Systems (“**Sunpower**”) to enter the Facilities and construct the Energy Conservation Measures pursuant to the terms and conditions therein; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has determined that the anticipated cost to the District for thermal or electrical energy or conservation services pursuant to the BSA for each Facility as applicable and identified in **Attachment A** to design, construct, and maintain the Energy Conservation Measures will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of thermal, electrical, or other energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of those Energy Conservation Measures; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to enter into a BSA attached hereto as **Attachment B** for each Facility based on the Energy Conservation Measures identified for each Facility in **Attachment A** to design, construct, and maintain the Energy Conservation Measures (collectively, “BSAs”), and desires to retain SolarStorage to design, pay a third party contractor to construct, and maintain the Energy Conservation Measures pursuant to the terms and conditions of the BSAs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for good and sufficient cause based on the entire record of proceedings, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education (“Board”) hereby resolves, determines, and finds the following:

- A. That the District held a public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Governing Board.
- B. Based upon reports of staff, reviewed by the Governing Board in connection herewith, and pursuant to Government Code section 4217.12, the anticipated cost to the District for the Energy Conservation Measures provided pursuant to the BSAs to design, provide, install and construct the Energy Conservation Measures at each Facility will be less than the anticipated marginal costs to the District of thermal, electrical or other energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of such purchases.
- C. It is in the best interests of the District to enter into a BSA attached hereto as **Attachment B** for each Facility based on the Energy Conservation Measures identified for each Facility in **Attachment A**, subject to minor revisions approved by staff and legal counsel that do not alter or reduce the best interests approved in this Resolution.

- D. That the License Agreement is approved for each Facility as identified in **Attachment A**.
- E. That the District's Superintendent or designee is authorized to enter into a BSA attached hereto as **Attachment B** and the License Agreement for each Facility based on the Energy Conservation Measures identified for each Facility in **Attachment A**, subject to minor revisions approved by staff and legal counsel that do not alter or reduce the best interests approved in this Resolution, and to take all steps and perform all actions necessary to execute and implement that Contract and to take any actions deemed necessary to best protect the interests of the District..



TO MAKE A DETERMINATION THAT THE ADVANCED ENERGY STORAGE PROJECT AT FOUR PUBLIC SCHOOL CAMPUSES ARE EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT, DECIDE TO CARRY OUT THE PROJECT, AND DIRECT THE FILING OF A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District (“District”) has developed four (4) separate advanced energy storage projects (“Project”), each one consisting of the construction and installation of solar energy storage equipment at four (4) separate existing District school campuses to provide supplemental green energy in the form of solar energy storage; and

WHEREAS, the Project consists of the construction and installation of a main switchboard, Tesla powerpack, and other associated equipment at the four District school sites listed below. Additionally, the Tesla powerpack will be enclosed within a privacy fence; and

WHEREAS, Taft Elementary School is located at 500 Keller Ave., Santa Ana, CA 92707. The advanced energy storage system and associated equipment will be located just south of the main campus building and the system will be approximately [325] square feet; and

WHEREAS, Segerstrom High School is located at 2301 W. MacArthur Blvd., Santa Ana, CA 92704. The advanced energy storage system and associated equipment will be located east of the campus, to the north east of the football stadium. The system will be approximately [650] square feet; and

WHEREAS, Century High School is located at 1401 S. Grand Ave., Santa Ana, CA 92705. The advanced energy storage system and associated equipment will be located to the west of the softball field. The system will be approximately [650] square feet; and

WHEREAS, Santa Ana High School, 520 W. Walnut St., Santa Ana, CA 92701. The advanced energy storage system and associated equipment will be located on the northwestern portion of the campus. The system will be approximately [650] square feet; and

WHEREAS, before the District may decide to carry out the Project, it must comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) for the Project. District staff have determined that the Project meets the definitions of the Class 3 and Class 11 Categorical Exemptions; and

WHEREAS, the Class 3 Categorical Exemption, set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15303, exempts a project that consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures and installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and

WHEREAS, the Class 11 Categorical Exemption, set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15311, exempts a project that consists of construction or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Project consists of the construction and installation of advanced solar battery energy storage systems that comprise a limited number of new relatively small structures and accessory structures on existing public school campuses, which are institutional and in an urban, built-up environment; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed the Project, considered whether the Project may have unusual circumstances, and determined that none exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for good and sufficient cause based on the entire record of proceedings, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education (“Board”) hereby resolves, determines, and finds the following:

- A. That the Project meets the definition of the Class 3 Categorical Exemption (CEQA Guidelines, § 15303), because the Project consists of the construction and operation of a solar/photovoltaic system containing a limited number of new small facilities or structures on an existing administration or school sites.
- B. That the Project meets the definition of the Class 11 Categorical Exemption (CEQA Guidelines, § 15311), because the Project consists of the construction of minor structures accessory to existing institutional facilities.
- C. That there is no indication of unusual circumstances that would cause a potentially significant environmental impact related to the Projects.
- D. That the Project is exempt from the requirements of CEQA.
- E. That that the applicable requirements of CEQA have been fulfilled for the Project.
- F. That the Superintendent or the Superintendent’s designee is authorized and directed to file the attached Notice of Exemption for the Project with the Orange County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse within five (5) days of the adoption of this Resolution.





**BOARD OF EDUCATION

DECLARING THE FUTILITY OF PUBLIC BIDDING FOR CERTAIN
ADDITIONAL WORK DUE TO UNFORESEEN CONDITIONS ON THE CARVER
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL MODERNIZATION PROJECT AND
APPROVING TWO CHANGE ORDERS FOR THAT WORK**

WHEREAS, on or about October 11, 2019, the Santa Ana Unified School District (“District”) publicly advertised an Invitation to Bid for modernization work on the District’s Carver Elementary School project (“Project”), with the modernization work broken down into nine (9) separate bid packages by scope of work; and

WHEREAS, Gilbert & Stearns (“G & S”) was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder on Bid Package # 09 for the electrical and low voltage scope of work on the Project; and

WHEREAS, AJ Fistes Corporation (“AJF”) was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder on Bid Package # 06 for the painting scope of work on the Project; and

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2020, the District Board of Education (“Board”) awarded a contract to G & S for bid package #09 in the amount of Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$778,000); and

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2020, the Board awarded Bid Package # 06 to AJF for the painting scope of work on the Project in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$227,400); and

WHEREAS, during their respective scopes of work on the Project both, G & S and AJF encountered unknown and differing site conditions on the Project, including, missing 2-hour fire rated attic walls that were found to be non-existing from the original construction of the school, the extent of which could not be reasonably determined until construction was underway, as well as other conditions necessary to render the Project compliant with Division of State Architect requirements and the overall modernization objectives of the Project, the consequence of which has increased the scope of work originally contemplated for the Project for G & S and AJF as follows:

G & S – Provide 2-hour Fire Separation Walls, fire alarm work, electrical work and exterior lighting work	\$107,572.00
AJF – Provide 2-hour Fire Separation Walls	\$37,664.00
Total	\$145,236.00

These unforeseen conditions and the costs arising from those unforeseen conditions are described in the Change Orders attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit B**. These conditions

were materially different than those indicated in the construction documents and plans for the Project (“Differing Conditions”); and

WHEREAS, One Hundred Forty Five Thousand Two Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Dollars pertains to costs for additional necessary work related to the Differing Conditions; and

WHEREAS, the District’s construction manager, Tilden-Coil Constructors, and District staff have determined that the pricing for the change order work necessitated by the Differing Conditions is reasonable and appropriate; and

WHEREAS, publicly soliciting new contractors to perform the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions would have resulted in waste and delay, which would be at the expense of the District; and

WHEREAS, new contractors performing just the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions would have the burden of acquainting themselves with the issues that have arisen on this Project, including but not limited to the Differing Conditions and their variance from the District’s plans and specifications for the Project, which would be at the District’s expense; and

WHEREAS, bringing in new contractors to perform the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions would create coordination and interference problems with the work being performed by G & S and AJF, which would be at the District’s expense; and

WHEREAS, if the District were to bid the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions, the prices of those bids would likely be more than the prices quoted by G & S and AJF because G & S and AJF were already mobilized on the Project; and

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code section 22032(a) states that a school district who has elected to be subject to the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act is required to informally or formally bid any public works project with a contract value over \$60,000; and

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code section 20118.4 states that a school district may, “authorize the contractor to proceed with performance of the change or alteration [to a contract] without the formality of securing bids, if the cost so agreed upon does not exceed the greater of: (a) The amount specified in Section 20111; or (b) Ten percent of the original contract price”; and

WHEREAS, California law provides that, “Where competitive proposals work an incongruity and are unavailing as affecting the final result or where they do not produce any advantage . . . the statute requiring competitive bidding does not apply” (*Hiller v. City of Los Angeles* (1961) 197 Cal.App.2d 685, 694), and that public entities need not comply with competitive bidding processes where to do so would be impractical or futile and would not serve the purposes of competitive bidding. (*Los Angeles Dredging Company v. City of Long Beach* (1930) 2 Cal. 348; *Graydon v. Pasadena Redevelopment Agency* (1980) 104 Cal.App.3d 631.); and

WHEREAS, bidding the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions will not affect the final result to the District except to further increase the cost of the Project; and

WHEREAS, bidding the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions would not produce an advantage to the District; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Education of the Santa Ana Unified School District hereby resolves, determines, and finds the following:

1. That the foregoing recitals are true.
2. For the reasons stated above, public bidding of the Differing Conditions work on the Project would not produce an advantage to the District and would produce a net burden and distinct disadvantages to the District.
3. Based on the foregoing, it would be incongruous, futile, and unavailing to publicly bid the additional work made necessary as a result of the Differing Conditions.
4. That the Board hereby approves the attached Change Orders in **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit B** to perform the work necessitated by the Differing Conditions, without further advertising for or inviting of bids.
5. That the District's Superintendent or his designee is authorized to take all steps and perform all actions necessary to execute and implement the attached Change Orders.





8 **THE STRONGEST TERMS, THE ACTS OF ARMED VIOLENCE, DOMESTIC**
9 **TERRORISM, AND INSURRECTION AT THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL ON**
10 **JANUARY 6, 2021**

12 WHEREAS, on January 6, 2021, a joint session of Congress convened at the United
13 States Capitol to certify the results of the 2020 presidential election declaring, as the winners,
14 Joseph R. Biden, Jr., President of the United States, and Kamala Harris as Vice-President; and
15

16 WHEREAS, that same morning, the sitting President of the United States, Donald J.
17 Trump, addressed his supporters at a nearby rally, characterizing the outcome of the election as
18 an "egregious assault on our democracy" and urging his supporters to march on the Capitol in
19 protest of what Trump falsely claimed was a stolen election; and
20

21 WHEREAS, hundreds of armed individuals stormed the Capitol complex shortly after
22 Trump's speech, forcibly entering the building, breaking windows and doors, draping a Trump
23 flag over the Capitol balcony, halting the process of the vote certification for several hours, and
24 forcing dozens of members of Congress, journalists, and other officials to take cover, flee the
25 building, and don gas masks; and
26

27 WHEREAS, shots were fired in the melee, and at least five individuals, including a U.S.
28 Capitol Police Officer, died as a result of the riot and violence; and
29

30 WHEREAS, these terrorists, many who were white supremacists and neo-nazis, intended
31 to inflict harm to life, limb, and property with the dual purpose of engaging in insurrection and
32 an attempted coup against the U.S. Government, all incited by Trump; and
33

34 WHEREAS, subsequent film footage shows members of Congress and staff were in
35 grave danger; and
36

37 WHEREAS, these violent acts did indeed damage federal property and destroyed multiple
38 federal offices at the Capitol; and
39

40 WHEREAS, electronic devices and documents with critical government data left
41 unattended as staff evacuated at breakneck pace were accessed and taken from offices, and
42 possibly compromising national security; and
43

44 WHEREAS, the United States flag was desecrated and replaced with Trump and Confederate
45 flags, and explosive devices that were live munitions were later found in and around the Capitol
46 Building and safely detonated; and
47

48 WHEREAS, these actions constitute domestic terrorism; and

49 WHEREAS, Americans and their families watched in horror while these shocking events
50 unfolded at the Capitol; and

53 WHEREAS, many Americans have wondered why law enforcement agencies did not better
54 anticipate and prepare to defend our lawmakers and our institutions; and

56 WHEREAS, several hours after the attempted coup by these domestic terrorists, the Capitol
57 building was cleared and secured, with lawmakers returning to complete their duty to certify the
58 results of the election; and
59

60 WHEREAS, in a video statement later removed from social media, Trump again declared that
61 the election had been "stolen" and told his supporters to "go home" and, in further support of the
62 insurrectionists, uttered the words "I love you"; and
63

64 WHEREAS, in a statement on Twitter later removed, Trump wrote: "These are the things and
65 events that happen when a sacred landslide election victory is so unceremoniously & viciously
66 stripped away from great patriots who have been badly & unfairly treated for so long" and "Go home
67 with love & in peace. Remember this day forever!"; and
68

69 WHEREAS, the violence, destruction, and loss of life at the United States Capitol Building,
70 one of the world's most iconic symbols of democracy, was clearly one of the worst and saddest days
71 in the history of American Democracy; and
72

73 WHEREAS, there has been widespread and bipartisan condemnation of the violence at the
74 United States Capitol on January 6, 2021, resulting in calls for the President's removal from office;
75 and
76

77 WHEREAS, on January 13, 2021, the United States House of Representatives approved an
78 Article of Impeachment, charging Trump with inciting insurrection; and
79

80 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Ana Unified School District's
81 Governing Board that it hereby declares and resolves as follows:

- 83 A. The Governing Board vehemently condemns the violence and desecration occurring at the
84 United States Capitol on January 6, 2021.

- 86 B. Condemns the individuals that incited the domestic terrorist attack and stands with all our
87 duly elected lawmakers who continue to protect and defend the Constitution of the United
88 States against all enemies foreign and domestic.
89
- 90 C. Declares that the actions of the individuals who violently breached and vandalized the
91 United States Capitol Building are deplorable and that those individuals responsible for
92 such violent acts should be held criminally responsible for their actions.
93
- 94 D. Condemns the violent actors who used the cover of legitimate protest to sow chaos and
95 destruction and threaten lives at one of the most sacred buildings where elected officials
96 carry out the business of the people of the United States of America.
97
- 98 E. Declares that the reprehensible actions at the United States Capitol were an

99 unacceptable threat to democracy and that such threats and damage to our
100 democratic institutions at any level can never be tolerated.

- 102 F. Urges the Senate to convict Trump of the allegations contained in the Article of
103 Impeachment.
- 104
- 105 G. Urges that Americans continue to exercise their First Amendment rights to
106 legitimately and peacefully protest and do so without injuries to people or
107 property.
- 108
- 109 H. Calls for a peaceful transition of power, which is among the hallmarks of
110 American Democracy.
- 111
- 112 I. Calls for the Administration of the District to emphasize in curriculum the ideals of
113 democracy, the right of peaceful protest, the importance of free and fair elections, and the
114 duty of every citizen to thoughtfully exercise the rights bestowed on us by the
115 Constitution.

117 This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Governing
118 Board, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest to and certify the vote adopting this Resolution.


