SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez announced School Administrators Week October nine to the fifteen (9-15). He thanked all of our SAUSD school administrators for their support of student learning and well-being. He encouraged everyone to reach out to one school administrator this week and thank them for all they do. He also acknowledged Indigenous Peoples Day, which was Monday, October 9. For centuries, American Indians and other native populations across our nation have built vibrant and diverse cultures. SAUSD is proud to honor the invaluable contributions and resilience of our Indigenous peoples, especially those who help make up our diverse school district. He encouraged everyone to

celebrate and recognize the many Indigenous communities and cultures that make up our great country. Superintendent shared that we held our first Budget town hall meeting last week. He thanked the parents, community members, and staff who attended. We were at capacity during the morning session at McFadden Institute of Technology, and again had strong participation at the evening session at Century High. This shows that our community has vested interest learning more about how we fund our schools and programs. He added that so far, we have received more than one hundred questions through our online survey and through these meetings themselves. Our team will work to answer these questions and share them out in the coming weeks. The next town hall meetings will take place on December 19. BOARD REPORTS

Ms. Brazer Aceves thanked school administrators for their work, long work hours, and support. She gave a special thanks to Principal Richardson at Davis Elementary School and Ms. Marcelo for touring the school with her and showing her the different programs. She had the opportunity to see teachers doing their reading program, met nutrition staff, custodial staff, and Engage 360 staff. Ms. Brazer Aceves also had the opportunity to stop by Valley High School and thanked Principal Berger for the tour. She got to see the auto and culinary arts buildings and she thanked Sal Garcia for showing her the automotive program. She also got to meet staff from Project Kinship and how they interacted with students during lunch. Lastly, she gave a shout out to staff at the second annual college and career fair, the counseling team, the maintenance and operations team; FACE workers, and the thousands of families and students. Ms. Brazer Aceves also thanked Karen from Circulos for being her guide for the night.

Mr. Bustos asked the Superintendent for a B2B report on how the responses to questions posed at the budget town hall will be answered and provided to the community. He thanked the public speakers and their supporters for coming out.

Dr. Alvarez thanked the public speakers and shared that Board members take notes, and refer them to the Superintendent. He shared that he had the opportunity to attend the budget town hall at Century High School which was well attended. He thanked all those who attended and shared that we will continue to hold town halls.

Ms. Torres commented on Superintendent pulling item 9.1 Approval of Formation of Ad Hoc Committee for Early Education and Appoint Two Board Members, from tonight's action calendar. She explained that the original request was for a Community Schools Ad Hoc Committee with Board representatives, however, it has now turned into an Early Education ad hoc committee with community schools embedded in it. Ms. Torres asked Board members if there was any opposition to the change. There was no opposition and Ms. Torres added that it will be agendaized for the next Board meeting. Ms. Torres requested dual enrollment numbers including what sites are offering them, which courses are being offered, and who is offering the course on a B2B this Friday. She also requested the restroom policy at MIT as it is not the first time Ms. Gonzalez has brought this up and added that we need to make sure students are able to use the restroom. Ms. Torres highlighted previous requests for presentations on Career Technical Education, Mental Health, and certificated staff that support trainings with an explanation of what those roles are. She thanked everyone for attending the college and career fair and the staff that were there. She closed the meeting in honor of Indigenous Peoples Day. She acknowledged that we are on Tongva and Acjachemen lands. The Tongva and Acjachemen have stewarded what we now refer to as Orange County, paid her respects to the elders both past and present, as well as the Tongva and Acjachemen youth who have attended our schools and neighboring districts.

WHEREAS, Leadership Matters for California's public education system and the more than six million students it serves; and

WHEREAS, school administrators are passionate, lifelong learners who believe in the value of quality public education; and

WHEREAS, the title "school administrator" is a broad term used to define many education leadership posts: superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals, special education and adult education leaders, curriculum and assessment leaders, school business officials, classified educational leaders, and other school district employees who are considered administrators; and

WHEREAS, providing quality service for student success is paramount for the profession; and

WHEREAS, California once ranked first in the nation for per-pupil spending now ranks among the last; and

WHEREAS, voters have proven that public education matters by approving local and statewide school funding measures; and

WHEREAS, most school administrators began their careers as teachers. The average administrator has served in public education for more than a decade. Most of California's superintendents have served in education for more than 20 years. Such experience is beneficial in their work to effectively and efficiently lead public education and improve student achievement; and

WHEREAS, public schools operate with lean management systems. Across the nation, public schools employ fewer managers and supervisors than most public and private sector industries including transportation, food service, manufacturing, utilities, construction, publishing, and public administration; and

WHEREAS, school leaders depend on a network of support from school communities – fellow administrators, teachers, parents, students, businesses, community members, board trustees, colleges and universities, community and faith-based organizations, elected officials and district and county staff and resources – to promote ongoing student achievement and school success; and

WHEREAS, in addition to highly qualified and effective classroom teachers, research shows great schools are led by great principals, and great districts are led by great superintendents. These site leaders are supported by extensive administrative networks throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has declared the second full week of October as the “Week of the School Administrator” in Education Code 44015.1; and

WHEREAS, the future of California’s public education system depends upon the quality of its leadership;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education, that all school leaders in the Santa Ana Unified School District be commended for the contributions they make to ensure successful student achievement.
