Regular Board Meeting
Santa Ana Board of Education

Tuesday, October 12, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

Board President Rodriguez opened up the meeting at 5:03 p.m.

Other members present were Ms. Torres, Dr. Alvarez, and Mr. Palacio.

CLOSED SESSION PRESENTATIONS

Dr. Rodriguez asked if there was anyone wishing to address the Board related to closed session items.

There was no one wishing to address the Board.

RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION

The Regular Board meeting recessed at 5:03 p.m. to consider negotiations, personnel matters, existing litigation, and real property negotiations.

Ms. Amezcua joined the meeting at 5:08 p.m.

RECONVENE REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Board meeting reconvened at 6:44 p.m.

Executive Cabinet members in attendance were Superintendent Almendarez, Dr. Perez, Mr. Magnuson, Ms. Barquin, Dr. Llamas, Ms. Roque, and Mr. Williams.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Dr. Rodriguez led the Pledge of Allegiance.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez provided an update on payroll. He stated that prior to the September 30 payroll, 17 revolving checks were issued to employees identified as not being in the September payroll system by the cutoff date. These checks represent the number of certificated staff that are believed to be the tail end of those who are present and working, but not fully in the system. More than 400 new certificated employees are now in the system to be paid on the regular cycle for the next payroll period. Staff continues to work to ensure proper salaries are in place, based on a review of transcripts and verification of work experience for all certificated new hires. He added that administrators have been notified that future recruitment and all hiring will immediately return to the Human Resources team. He thanked all the staff in human resources, payroll, and other departments for working hard towards a resolution of this process. Mr. Almendarez announced that the Board will receive an update tonight on the District's ongoing COVID-19 protocols, including the roll-out of District-wide testing. He stated that COVID-19 positivity numbers continue to decline and encouraged everyone to get vaccinated. Superintendent Almendarez also asked parents to please complete the testing consent form for their child if they have not already done so. Vaccinations and regular testing are among the strongest weapons we currently have to battle this pandemic.

Mr. Almendarez invited the community to a series of public hearings that are part of a plan by the Board and the District to study the establishment "By-trustee areas and elections". Next Monday is the second public hearing at Santa Ana High school. Other meetings will be held at Godinez, Century and Segerstrom High schools. Public input is a critical part of this effort and added that the trustee area boundaries should reflect the needs and interests of the community. He invited everyone to visit www.SAUSD.us for exact times, dates and streaming options for these

public hearings. Superintendent Almendarez announced that October 10-16 is California School Administrator Week. He thanked all SAUSD school administrators for working tirelessly to help reopen schools this school year for in-person instruction. Administrators have also played an essential role in the roll-out of testing at all schools. He encouraged everyone to reach out to one school administrator this week to thank them for all they do.




