CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m.

Other members present were Ms. Amezcua, Dr. Alvarez, and Mr. Palacio.

The Regular Board meeting recessed to closed session at 5:10 p.m.

The Regular Board meeting reconvened at 7:00 p.m.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez stated that COVID rates in various zip codes and in various locations, numbers are going up slightly. He said the numbers aren't taking us out of the purple category yet, and so we will continue to monitor. He also stated that there are a lot of challenges as a district in relationship to what is happening in the District of Santa Ana but also in surrounding cities. He reassured the public that the dates that have been identified to return, are strictly tentative dates. They are meant to help us prepare at the time for a downward trend, but they are always fluid. He said that the District is taking the data on a week by week basis, hoping to get out of the purple and into the red category, which would allow us to open up, but as a result in increase of positive COVID rates, we are unable to do that. He added that we remain in the color purple which indicates that there is still high community transmission rates. He stated that the health experts are letting us know that it's not time to make that transition to hybrid just yet but will continue to monitor that. Superintendent shared that the intent is to bring county health care officials to a Board meeting to share

what this data means to our district. Superintendent shared that we will continue to monitor and keep the community updated as soon as we get the information from the county.


ADJOURNMENT



SUBJECT: Education for Homeless Children, McKinney-Vento Act

CATEGORY: Instruction

RESPONSIBLE OFFICE(S): Educational Services

SCOPE:

The Governing Board recognizes its obligations to ensure that homeless children have access to the same free and appropriate public education provided to other children within the District. The following updated policy reflects the intent of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 USC 11431-11435), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (P.L. 114-95), that each homeless student should have equal access to the same free, appropriate public education and services as other students. 42 USC 11432 mandates that districts adopt, review, and revise policies to remove barriers to the identification, enrollment, and retention of homeless children and youth, ensure that homeless students are not segregated or stigmatized on the basis of their status as homeless, and provide for professional development for appropriate staff, as provided in the following policy.

POLICY:

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that placement decisions for a homeless student(s) are based on the student's best interest, as defined in law and administrative regulation, and shall inform parents/guardians of children entering a district school at any grade level about admission requirements. The school personnel and the school principal shall provide guidance to determine final placement and shall assist them with enrollment procedures.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the enrollment of a homeless student(s) is not delayed because of outstanding fees or fines owed to the student(s) last school or for his/her inability to produce previous academic, medical, or other records normally required for enrollment. The District shall provide homeless students with an access to education and other services necessary for homeless students to meet the same challenging performance standards as other students.

When enrolling in any district school, including a school in their attendance area, Student(s) whose parents(s)/guardian(s) reside within district boundaries shall be subject to the timelines established by the Board for open enrollment. Student(s) whose parent(s)/guardian(s) do not reside within the district or who are not otherwise eligible for enrollment in the district may apply for inter-district attendance in accordance



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with the timelines specified in applicable Board policies and administrative regulations. The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that placement decisions for homeless students are based on a student's best interest as defined in law and administrative regulations.

Each homeless student shall be provided services that are comparable to services offered to other students in the school, including, but not limited to, transportation, educational programs for which the student meets the eligibility criteria (such as federal Title I services or similar state or local programs, programs for students with disabilities, and educational programs for English learners), career and technical education programs, programs for gifted and talented students, and school nutrition programs. (42 USC 11432)

When there are at least 15 homeless students in the district or a district school, the district's Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) shall include goals and specific actions to improve student achievement and other outcomes of homeless students. (Education Code 52052, 52060)

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RESPONSIBLE OFFICE(S): Educational Services

The Superintendent or designee shall designate an appropriate staff person to serve as a liaison for homeless children and youths. The district liaison shall fulfill the duties specified in 42 USC 11432 to assist in identifying and supporting homeless students to succeed in school.

In order to identify district students who are homeless, the Superintendent or designee may give a housing questionnaire to all parents/guardians during school registration, make referral forms readily available, include the district liaison's contact information on the district and school web sites, provide materials in a language easily understood by families and students, provide school staff with professional development on the definition and signs of homelessness, and contact appropriate local agencies to coordinate referrals for homeless children and youth, and unaccompanied youth.

Information about a homeless student's living situation shall be considered part of a student's educational record, subject to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, and shall not be deemed to be directory information as defined in 20 USC 1232g. (42 USC 11432)

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that placement decisions for homeless students are based on the student's best interest as defined in law and administrative regulation.

Homeless students shall not be segregated into a separate school or program based on their status as homeless and shall not be stigmatized in any way. However, the Superintendent or designee may separate homeless students on school grounds as necessary for short periods of time for health and safety emergencies or to provide temporary, special, and supplementary services to meet the unique needs of homeless students. (42 USC 11432, 11433)

The Superintendent or designee shall coordinate with other agencies and entities to ensure that homeless children and youth are promptly identified, ensure that homeless students have access to and are in reasonable proximity to available education and related support services, and raise the awareness of school



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personnel and service providers of the effects of short-term stays in a shelter and other challenges associated with homelessness. Toward these ends, the Superintendent or designee shall collaborate with local social service agencies, other agencies, or entities providing services to homeless children and youth, and, if applicable, transitional housing facilities. In addition, the Superintendent or designee shall coordinate transportation, transfer of school records, and other inter-district activities with other local educational agencies. As necessary, the Superintendent or designee shall coordinate, within the district and with other involved local educational agencies, services for homeless students and services for students with disabilities. (42 USC 11432)

District liaisons and other appropriate staff shall participate in professional development and other technical assistance activities to assist them in identifying and meeting the needs of homeless students and to provide training on the definitions of terms related to homelessness. (42 USC 11432)

At least annually, the Superintendent or designee shall report to the Board on outcomes for homeless students, which may include, but are not limited to, school attendance, student achievement test results, promotion and retention rates by grade level, graduation rates, suspension/expulsion rates, and other outcomes related to any goals and specific actions identified in the LCAP. Based on the evaluation data, the district shall revise its strategies, as needed, to better support the education of homeless students.

DESIRED OUTCOME:

The Superintendent or designee shall facilitate students' access to the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance program by publicizing the district's policy and related complaint procedures to a student, a parent(s)/guardian(s), and employees. The Superintendent or designee shall provide training and information on the scope and use of the policy and complaint procedures and take other measures designed to increase the school community's understanding of the requirements of the McKinney-Vento Act.

The Superintendent or designee shall regularly review the implementation of the District's McKinney-Vento assistance policies and practices and, as necessary, shall take action to remove any identified barrier to student access to or participation in the educational program. He/she shall report his/her findings and recommended changes to the Board after each review.

This board policy outlines the rights of children and youth experiencing homelessness. The district is responsible for ensuring the identification, enrollment, attendance, and removal of barriers to academic



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success for a student. For guidelines and procedures at all schools, centers, and offices including, but not limited to, early education centers; preschools; elementary, middle, and high schools; magnet schools and centers, educational options schools; adult schools, continuation schools; special education schools; and charter schools chartered under the district reference AR 6173(a) for school responsibilities and further details.
