SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent began by thanking Miguel Martinez, Manager of Building Services and his crew for quickly responding to Greenville Fundamental Elementary School following a vandalism incident that occurred last week. The campus sustained significant damage to twelve classrooms. Mr. Martinez and his team promptly responded, dedicating themselves to restoring the campus swiftly, ensuring it was ready for the return of our students. He also expressed his gratitude to the entire staff at Greenville for their efforts in minimizing disruptions to student instruction, ensuring a smooth and continued learning experience. Next, he acknowledged the work done last week by our Executive Cabinet and their teams as part of the California School Boards Association Policy Development Workshop. He also thanked his office team (Rosie, Karina and Adriana) for all the work that they did behind the scenes to prepare for these three days and to ensure that things went smoothly. The monumental goal of this work is to review and revise outdated district policies. CSBA provided expertise in selecting policies, regulations, bylaws, and exhibits to reflect the District's goals and mandates. The team successfully completed 50% of the draft policy updates during the 3-day workshop. The aim is to finalize all draft updates by November 9, 2023, and to present a first reading at the January 2024 Board meeting. Superintendent Almendarez mentioned that in the coming month, the district will initiate a new series of student listening sessions, aimed at gathering insights to shape the District's Graduate Profile. The aim is to gauge how well profile characteristics are being developed across various educational levels. Facilitated roundtable discussions will offer us insights into student engagement and skill development across various graduate profile characteristics. Fifty students from three schools, spanning from TK to 12th grade, will participate in these sessions. A stratified random process has been used to select participating students, ensuring representation of all student voices. Staff and community listening sessions will follow in the coming months.

BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez addressed the school wellness policies, asked that they be reviewed, and to inform the Board when they will be revised. He wished everyone a Happy Halloween.

Ms. Brazer Aceves shared that she is excited to serve on the Ad Hoc Committee for Early Education to work together on community schools and thanked her colleagues. She also shared that she attended Lincoln Elementary School's Hispanic Heritage Month celebration. She thanked Principal Katayama and Assistant Principal Reyes for their guided tour of their cultural walk through the school. Ms. Brazer Aceves highlighted their displays of different countries and thanked staff and students. Ms. Brazer Aceves shared that she was able to attend the MacArthur School Counseling Advisory meeting and congratulated the team for their hard work. She also shared that she was able to participate in the restorative practice training and thanked Mr. Richey and his team. She added that she attended as an OCDE staff member and that it was great to be part of it. She strongly encouraged staff to participate. Ms. Brazer Aceves asked for follow up on non-citizen voting to support what the community is asking and added that she spoke at the City meeting.

Mr. Bustos requested more information on the vending machines issue with respect to where the funds go to. He shared that he had the opportunity to visit Monroe and Pio Pico Elementary Schools last Friday. He thanked the administration for creating a culture in which parents feel safe and comfortable enough to have conversations about what their needs are. He added that he is excited to attend fall festivities throughout the week and shared that he will be at Edison, Mitchell, Franklin, and Taft Elementary Schools. Mr. Bustos addressed a Santa Ana City Councilmember's comment regarding the School Board meetings, provided individual feedback, and shared that he is very proud to sit on this Board with his fellow Board Members and the Superintendent.

Dr. Alvarez expressed how proud he is to be on this Board and acknowledged their accomplishments. He requested that there be follow up with the MIT parent regarding the bathroom issue. He mentioned the Veterans Day Holiday coming up and wants to ensure that the District is recognizing all veterans that are employed with SAUSD. Lastly, he gave a shout out to Josh Goddard, Director of Nutrition Services, who recently received a 2023 Leadership and Innovation Award from the Center for Ecoliteracy.

Ms. Torres addressed the public comments made during public presentations and expressed that her heart was with those who have lost family and encouraged everyone to protect their mental health. She thanked District staff members that were working on the policy review as many of the policies needed updating due to the pandemic and lack of staff, especially special education staff. She added that some positions are hard to fill and asked the community to encourage people to apply for jobs. Ms. Torres also attended the Hispanic Heritage Month event at Lincoln Elementary School, the pumpkin carving event at Santiago Elementary School, the Farm to School event at Carver Elementary School, and that she is attending the Longevity Awards at Villa

Fundamental Intermediate School tomorrow. She highlighted the Board requests as follows: mental health presentation including social workers, Board consensus on health fair with Supervisor Sarmiento, revision of the wellness policy(s) in the B2B and what the plan is, Follow up on non-citizen voting as well as agendize the statement of support to next Board meeting, invite legal counsel for questions regarding non-citizen voting for Board member elections, B2B on vending machines, and bathrooms at MIT.

CONTRACT OF EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of October, 2023, the BOARD of EDUCATION of the Santa Ana Unified School District appointed TED WALSTROM, as ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT, FACILITIES AND GOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS ("ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT" or "MR. WALSTROM"); and

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF EDUCATION and the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT mutually desire to enter into this initial contract of employment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The term of employment shall be from the date of approval by the BOARD OF EDUCATION to and including June 30, 2026. Subject to continuous satisfactory performance, the BOARD OF EDUCATION may extend the term of this Contract of Employment an additional year.
- 2. During the term of employment, MR. WALSTROM shall satisfactorily perform duties pertaining to the position of ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT, as provided by the job description and as prescribed by the Superintendent.
- 3. Effective his first day of employment, and for the 2023-2024 school year, the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT shall pay ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT on grade 134, Step 2 (\$203,508 annually). Effective the 2024-2025 school year, the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT will be granted one (1) step advancement on the appropriate range of the Extended Management Schedule each July 1 contingent upon continuous satisfactory service within the District, until the maximum of a salary range is reached, and in accordance with AR 4351. Monthly installments shall be payable according to the classified payroll calendar, prorated for any partial service.
- 4. The salary specified in paragraph 3 above may be adjusted in the manner provided in Education Code section 35032. The stated salary may be increased at any time subject to the agreement of the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT and the BOARD OF EDUCATION, with such increase becoming effective from the date of authorization by the BOARD OF EDUCATION.
- 5. The SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT shall pay the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's membership dues in the Association of California

School Administrators (ACSA), the California Association of School Business Officials (CASBO), or a similar professional organization.

- 6. The SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT shall pay the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's membership dues in one Santa Ana-based service organization.
- 7. The ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT may earn and accrue up to 21 days of paid vacation per school year based on his days of service, as calculated by the payroll department of the District. If vacation is not used during the school year in which it was earned and accrued, such unused, earned and accrued vacation shall be carried over to the following school year. However, the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT may not earn or accrue more than 42 unused vacation days. Once this maximum is reached, ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT will cease to earn and accrue any additional vacation until earned and accrued vacation has been used and the number of unused earned and accrued paid vacation days is below the maximum amount.

In the event of termination of employment of the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT, either during the term of this Contract of Employment or at the expiration of the term of this Contract of Employment, he shall be entitled to compensation for any unused, earned and accrued vacation at the salary rate in effect at the termination or expiration of this Contract of Employment.

- 8. ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall earn one day of sick leave per month.
- 9. Consistent with Board Policy 3350, ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred performing authorized services for the District.
- 10. The services rendered by the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall be evaluated annually by the SUPERINTENDENT or designee during the term of this Contract of Employment, at which time the BOARD OF EDUCATION and the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT may mutually agree to extend the duration of this Contract of Employment. If the duration of this Contract of Employment is extended, the services rendered by the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall be annually evaluated

during the extended term of this Contract of Employment. The annual evaluation shall be completed on or about July 30.

11. The ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall be eligible for paid District medical, dental, vision, and life insurance as provided to other Cabinet members. In the event the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT elects not to participate in the District medical, dental, and vision benefit plans, he may elect to receive the annual cash value equal to the District contribution for medical (two-party tier rate), dental, and vision plans offered for which he is eligible. This option may continue in retirement through age 65 pursuant to applicable Board Policy and Administrative regulations. This compensation, if elected, shall be reviewed and changed each benefit year of the term of this Contract of Employment to reflect the then-current District contributions for the benefit plan year as the cost of the benefits adjust in the new benefit plan year.

These health and welfare benefits are subject to change or modification, and may be increased, reduced, or taken away, at the sole discretion of the BOARD OF EDUCATION, during the term of this Contract of Employment, so long as all other members of the Superintendent's Cabinet are subject to the same changes and/or modifications.

Upon termination or expiration of this Contract of Employment concurrently with retirement under the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS), the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall have the option to continue receiving then-current medical, dental, and vision pursuant to AR 4117.15.

Employment at its sole discretion upon 90 days' written notice to the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT. If the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's employment is terminated pursuant to this subsection, and the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT is not in breach of this Contract of Employment, the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT may receive an amount not to exceed the monthly salary of the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT, multiplied by the number of months left on the unexpired term of this Contract of Employment or 12 months, whichever is less, as provided in Government Code section 53260. Except as provided in paragraph 11 hereof, any continuation of ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's health and welfare benefits following such termination may not exceed the number of months remaining on the unexpired term of this

Contract of Employment, up to a maximum of 12 months, or until ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT finds other employment, whichever occurs first.

- Acceptance of the payment described in paragraph 12 of this Contract of 13. Employment fully and forever releases the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, its employees, officers, and agents, the BOARD OF EDUCATION, and each member of the BOARD OF EDUCATION from all claims, demands, causes of action, charges and grievances, of whatever kind or nature, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, which ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT now owns or holds or has at any time before this date owned or held against any of them, including, but not limited to, all claims, charges, demands and causes of action (a) which arise out of or are in any way connected with ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's employment or the termination of employment; (b) which are related to or concern discrimination under local, state or federal law (including but not limited to, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act), wrongful termination in violation of public policy, retaliation, intentional and negligent infliction of emotional distress, defamation and other torts; or (c) which arise out of or are in any way connected with any loss, damage or injury whatsoever resulting from any act committed or omission made prior to the date of this Contract of Employment.
- 14. This Contract of Employment may be terminated for cause at any time during the school year in accordance with Board Policy and/or statutory provisions that apply to any classified employee. For purposes of this Contract of Employment, "cause" includes any material breach of this Contract of Employment, any failure of the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT to perform the duties prescribed for the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT by the Superintendent or the BOARD OF EDUCATION, or any of the grounds enumerated in Administrative Regulation 4218. The BOARD OF EDUCATION shall not terminate this Contract of Employment under this subsection until a written statement of the grounds for termination has first been given to the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT by the Superintendent. The ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall then be entitled to an informal conference with the BOARD OF EDUCATION, in closed session, at which time the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall be given a reasonable opportunity to address the specific concerns and issues of the BOARD OF EDUCATION and the Superintendent. The ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall have

the right, at his own expense, to have a representative of his choice at the conference with the BOARD OF EDUCATION. If no resolution of these concerns and issues can be found, the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall be provided with a written statement of the BOARD OF EDUCATION's decision with respect to the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's termination. If this Contract of Employment is terminated pursuant to this subsection, the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT's employment with the District, and any compensation, benefits or allowances provided pursuant to this Contract of Employment, shall terminate with the effective date of the decision of the BOARD OF EDUCATION, and the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall not be entitled to any further compensation thereafter, regardless of the term then remaining under this Contract of Employment.

- 15. The ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT shall return all SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT property and equipment to the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT upon termination of this Contract of Employment.
- 16. The terms of this Contract of Employment are made for the benefit of each person or entity named in paragraph 13 above. It is the intention of the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT that this Contract of Employment shall be effective as a bar against each and every claim, demand, cause of action, charge or grievance described in paragraph 13 above. In furtherance of this intention, the ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT expressly waives any and all rights and benefits conferred upon him by the provisions of section 1542 of the California Civil Code, which states:

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of the executing the release, which if known by him or her must have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor."

This clause would prevent any other action in law or in equity against the District as a result of the Board's determination to terminate the contract without cause and pay the liquidated damages.

Pursuant to Government Code section 53243.2, any funds received by the ASSISTANT

SUPERINTENDENT from the District as a cash settlement resulting from the termination

of this Agreement or successor agreements shall be fully reimbursed to the District if the

ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT is convicted of a crime involving the abuse of his

office or position.

17. If any term or provision of this Contract of Employment is held to be invalid

or unenforceable, the remaining portions of this Contract of Employment shall continue to

be valid and shall be performed, construed and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by

law, and the invalid or unenforceable term shall be deemed amended and limited in

accordance with the intent of the parties, as determined from the face of this Contract of

Employment, to the extent necessary to permit the maximum enforceability or validation of

the term or provision.

18. This Contract of Employment may be amended or modified only pursuant to

a writing signed by both parties, unless otherwise stated in this Contract of Employment.

19. This Contract of Employment constitutes and contains the entire agreement

and understanding between the parties and supersedes and replaces all prior negotiations

and agreements proposed or otherwise, whether written or oral, concerning the subject

matter of this Contract of Employment. This is an integrated document.

20. This Contract of Employment is subject to, is governed by, and shall be

construed under all applicable laws of the State of California, rules and regulations of the

State Board of Education, and rules, regulations and policies of the Board, all of which are

made a part of the terms and conditions of this Contract of Employment as though set forth

herein.

CATEGORY: Board Bylaws

RESPONSIBLE OFFICE(S): Office of the Superintendent

SCOPE:

The Governing Board recognizes the complex legal environment in which school districts operate, the need to provide legal representation for the district, and the importance of reliable, cost-effective, high-quality legal advice and services.

PROCEDURES AND GENERAL INFORMATION:

In order to meet the district's legal needs, the Board may appoint legal counsel and fix and order paid legal counsel's compensation as an employee or as an independent contractor. (Education Code 35041.5)

The Board may enter into independent contractor services agreements with county counsel, law firms, attorneys in private practice, and other public or private legal services entities. (Education Code 35204, 35205; Government Code 26520, 26529)

The Board also supports pursuing collaborative legal efforts with other districts as well as other government agencies as appropriate.

Duties of Legal Counsel

The district's legal counsel may:

- 1. Render legal advice to the Board and the Superintendent or designee
- 2. Serve the Board and the Superintendent or designee in the preparation and conduct of district litigation and administrative proceedings
- 3. Render advice on school bond and tax increase measures and prepare the necessary forms for the voting of these measures
- 4. Perform other administrative duties as assigned by the Board and Superintendent or designee

Retaining Legal Counsel

When the district is seeking legal advice or representation, the Superintendent or designee shall identify prospective attorney(s), firm(s), and/or legal services entity(ies).

The district may, but is not required to, initiate a Request for Proposals to advertise and solicit proposals for legal services. In evaluating the prospective attorney(s), firm(s), and/or entity(ies), the Board and Superintendent may consider the attorney's firms, and/or entity's background, experience, and relevant legal reputation; experience advising and representing school districts in California; fees; and experience of attorneys at the firm who will provide legal services.

Any attorney representing the district shall be admitted to practice law in California. (Education Code 35041.5)

The Board and Superintendent shall periodically evaluate the performance of the firm(s) and/or attorney(s); the efficiency and adequacy of advice; the results obtained for the district; the reasonableness of fees; and responsiveness to and interactions with the Board, administration, and community.

The Board may use such evaluation(s) to determine whether to renew any current agreement(s) for legal services.

The Board may also contract for specialized legal services, as appropriate, when a majority of the Board determines that the unique demands of a particular issue or emergency situation require such representation.

Contacting Legal Counsel

The Board president, or Superintendent or designee, may, at their discretion, confer with district legal counsel subject to any limits or parameters established by the Board. In addition, the Board president, or Superintendent or designee, may contact district legal counsel to provide the Board with legal information or advice when so directed by a majority of the Board.

Individual Board members other than the Board president may not seek advice from district legal counsel on matters of district business unless so authorized by the Superintendent, the Board president or a majority of the Board.
