Board President Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

7. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez addressed LCAP input. SAUSD is committed to ensuring District resources are used to meet the needs of all students. He shared that our Local Control and Accountability Plan, or LCAP, addresses the district's vision for student learning, and demonstrates how the district's budget supports these goals. All parents, students, and staff are invited to share input and suggestions. He invited everyone to contact their school to learn how they can become involved in LCAP input sessions, or take the survey by scanning the QR code provided on the screen now. Additionally, he added that District teams will visit several school sites in coming weeks to have in-person LCAP listening sessions with our students. For student sessions, the team will randomly select groups of participants that represent the overall demographic makeup of the school. More information to come.

Mr. Almendarez shared that over the summer, with the support of the Board of Education and Superintendent, the SAUSD Speech and Debate program applied for the California School Boards Association Golden Bell Award. This award promotes excellence in education and school board governance by recognizing outstanding educational programs. He proudly congratulated the Speech and Debate program as it has been awarded a Golden Bell award in the category of "Closing the Achievement Gap". He added that Speech and Debate was chosen because it encourages English Language Development, improves student self-esteem, gives children a voice, exposes youth to colleges and universities, provides scholarship opportunities, and offers countless more benefits. The Santa Ana Unified School District's Speech and Debate program is in its sixth year and during that time has propelled students into national dominance. Within these few short years, students have won multiple state championships at all three levels, Elementary, Middle, and High School. In total, there are over 1,000 SAUSD students competing in this program activity. He congratulated all our amazing students for their effort and dedication, including those students joining us today.

Mr. Almendarez encouraged everyone who is eligible to vote for the upcoming November 8 general election to vote. This includes all of our youth in the community, especially those who will turn 18 before the election. He shared that in California, the last day to register was October 24. However, California allows voters to conditionally register up until Election Day and submit a provisional ballot. Voters in SAUSD will have the opportunity to vote on Measure H, an initiative involving term limits for members of the board of education. One of the most effective ways to ensure your voice is heard is to cast your ballot. He invited everyone to visit ocvote.com or for more registration information and other resources.

BOARD REPORTS

Mrs. Amezcua shared part of the Nations Report Card that states that test scores are at the lowest. She shared something that was stated by the Secretary of Education, Miguel Cardona and encouraged everyone to read the article. She added that we have not shared our results with the community. She stated that the District has funding to pay for extra tutoring, extra social workers, to address the social emotional, address the drug use, academic needs, and small class size. She encouraged parents to reach out to the District, attend Parent Teacher Association and Parent Teacher Organization meetings to advocate for their children. Mrs. Amezcua announced that the next meeting would be her last meeting after sitting on the Board for eight (8) years. She has worked with Mr. Palacio and others and has done great things like keeping ICE out of our schools, created a diversion program, worked on restorative work, speech and debate program, school climate, ASB, restorative justice, and takes pride and is humbled to have served the community. Through the divergent program, they were able to keep kids out of juvenile hall. She acknowledged Dr. Sonia Llamas, Assistant Superintendent of K-12 School Performance and Culture and to her team for their hard work with that. She also acknowledged Project Kinship and Neutral Ground. She encouraged parents to ask for Project Kinship and Neutral Ground to come to their schools to work with their children, to ask for social workers, mental health workers, counselors, and smaller class sizes. To those who have special needs student she encouraged to know the laws, their rights, the responsibility of the District to provide services, and invited them to reach out to her when she is no longer on the Board. She addressed sexual molestation cases because parents do not want their kids to be victims. Lastly, Mrs. Amezcua shared that she loves serving community and thanked all classified, certificated, school police for letting her serve.

Mr. Palacio thanked Janea Marking, Associate Superintendent, Chief Business Official for her months of service. He complemented her and shared that she is caring, competent, professional, honest and ethical, and wished her well. He also acknowledged Jennifer Flores, Associate Superintendent of Human Resources with the same complements and thanked them both. Mr. Palacio addressed the need to deal with the issues of funding at schools. He shared that the budget has increased by 50% in three years, just received a grant for 24 million dollars, and asked how it was going to be spent. He addressed the need to continue to promote flu and COVID vaccines. Lastly, he addressed the District having the financial capacity to fund programs. He also shared that as of August 5, 2022, this district and others have had the go ahead to show the Smart Balance data. He asked when the District is going to share the test scores and or provide a presentation at the next board meeting.

Dr. Alvarez thanked the community members that provided public comments and assured the public that even though the Board does not respond to public comments, they do follow up on them. He commented on the Godinez music students and the Mariachi students speak and they are feeling neglected, they need new equipment, and

new staffing. He added that it is critical that the District continue with the budget town hall meetings to allow community members and staff to give input on how the money should be spent. He also added to Mr. Palacios comment on test scores and said that it was also about finding solutions. Dr. Alvarez gave a shout out to all the counseling teams in the district. Several of them have been staying late to help students apply for college and university.

Ms. Torres shared that she is looking forward to all the trunk or treat events. With respect to testing, she shared that there is no need to hide data and that testing is a small metric of learning. She commented on the constant testing of math, standardized tests and encouraged people to read on the topic. She stated that we should not be hiding the data as it is only one metric of what the scores are and is a lot bigger than the test. Ms. Torres echoed the sentiment on music programs and recalls a special category for arts when funding was discussed. She asked for clarification on how funds are being allocated.

Dr. Rodriguez also echoed the requests around the music program and asked about the funding structure for music programs, whether it lies at the site level for site-level decision making or if it is district wide. He asked the same question with respect to Speech and Debate. Additionally, he asked why we are treating the Speech and Debate with a centralized budget and not for music. Dr. Rodriguez asked for an analysis of the funding structure to help us figure out how these areas are funded to figure out the status of the current support and to know if there are additional funds needed. He suggested another Board overview of the budget structure, music, and how are we funding them. Dr. Rodriguez shared that three months ago, he was voted as the District representative on the Council of the Great City Schools. He attended a conference via Zoom, this past Saturday, which was being held in Miami, Florida. He added that only 77 districts that are part of the council and they do not allow just anyone to join. It represents the seven largest districts in the country and they have a whole advocacy campaign and strategy for the school districts that have the same demographic as ours. It was a 3-day conference and as he was trying to understand and compare experiences, he realized that we are on the right path. The Secretary of Education was there. Dr. Rodriguez stated that the Graduate Profile this district has embraced is central to a lot of the work that is happening nationally. Our focus is right on track on areas that we have to pay attention to and that we are not second to anyone. Regarding data, we have an incredible data hub that we are using. He commented on the the data that is represented in state scores. He is interested in the growth rates for the year. He feels that we have the right model and need to continue to align and integrate the full force of the mode. The question is if we have the right model. He addressed sustaining that level of funding and asked that we continue to support leadership and teachers.

ADJOURNMENT

Having no further business to come before the Board, President Rodriguez adjourned the meeting at 8:19 p.m.

JOB SUMMARY:

Under general direction of the Executive Director, Risk Management provide leadership to the department's claims staff engaged in the administration of workers' compensation claims; handle a caseload of complex workers' compensation claims; provide direction to staff engaged in all aspects of claim handling including investigations, payment of benefits, litigation, benefit notices and other state-mandated compliance procedures, subrogation and other activities; assure all employees receive rightful workers' compensation benefits.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

- Administer the self-insured, self-administered workers' compensation program; provide compliance with all regulations for self-insurance of workers' compensation claims. **E**
- Supervise assigned technical and clerical staff; assist in selection of staff, and provide training, coaching, and evaluation as needed. **E**
- Assist in the development of strategy, negotiation, and settlement of the more complex workers' compensation claims; evaluate claims management procedures and recommend modifications to maximize productivity and cost effectiveness conduct regular claim reviews of technical staff for compliance and proper claims handling procedures. **E**
- Assist with assigning, evaluating, and supervising the investigation and adjusting of workers' compensation claims by staff and provide recommendations concerning settlement and litigation; reduce district insurance losses under workers' compensation; partner with payroll to verify the accuracy of workers' compensation time off work and pay. **E**
- Appear before the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board for hearings and mandatory settlement conferences. **E**
- Review, research and implement current legislation relating to workers' compensation. **E**
- Coordinate, implement and monitor an early Return to Work Program and the ADA interactive process to ensure it meets employee requests and needs for reasonable accommodations as appropriate. **E**
- Coordinate potential fraud cases with the District Attorney's office. **E**
- Provide consultation and technical assistance to employees and administrators concerning workers' compensation. **E**
- Analyze workers' compensation trends to identify and implement employee trainings designed to minimize adverse impact of work-related injuries on employees and the district. **E**
- Conduct workshops for site administrators, department managers/supervisors regarding workers' compensation and reporting procedures for work-related injuries. **E**
