SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez provided an updated on the vaccinations for children ages 5 and up. SAUSD continues to monitor the latest information for when COVID-19 vaccines will become available for children ages 5 and up. He shared that earlier today, an FDA advisory panel endorsed the Pfizer vaccine for Children 5 to 11 and that FDA approval is expected soon. Once this happens, the District will work with state and local health agencies to formulate a plan for how to make these vaccines available for children in the SAUSD community. The District continues to encourage vaccinations for all eligible populations, along with regular testing and other safety protocols to help keep our schools and community safe. The District will provide more information as it becomes available. Mr. Almendarez also shared that SAUSD is now hosting a free COVID-19 testing clinic every Saturday. This testing is open to anyone, regardless of whether you are a student, parent, district employee, or resident in Santa Ana or neighboring communities. The testing clinic is here in the District Office, from 8 a.m. to noon., at the east entrance, near our School Police offices. Superintendent announced that there are two remaining public hearings on the proposal to establish Trustee Areas and elections By-Trustee Areas. These remaining meetings are Monday, November 8 at Century High School, and Monday, December 6 at Segerstrom High School. Public input will assist the Board of Education in determining which proposed map best suits the needs of the school district. He encouraged parents, resident, and/or voter who resides within the SAUSD district boundaries to participate in at least one of these remaining meetings and invited everyone visit SAUSD.US website for information on this important process.

Mr. Almendarez announced that SAUSD is currently celebrating Red Ribbon Week across each of our schools. Red Ribbon Week is the largest program of its kind in the nation, encouraging students to pursue healthy, drug-free lives. He shared that part of an educators' role is not just supporting students' academic success, but also their social-emotional needs. He encouraged families to connect with their teachers and schools to learn more about the resources available at campuses to support students' healthy lifestyles and also invited the public to visit [redribbon.org](http://redribbon.org) for additional resources.

#### BOARD REPORTS

Mrs. Amezcua requested a B2B on the construction to Superintendent's Office and to the Boardroom. She asked that the District Grant writer follow up on the Indian Education Grant. Grant person to follow up with Indian Education Grant. Mrs. Amezcua shared that she and Dr. Alvarez attended Friday night's game where seniors were recognized and students got their championship rings. The rings were donated by alumni and labor partners who raised well over twenty thousand dollars. Mrs. Amezcua stated that Deaf Education month was last month and asked that it be added to the calendar and acknowledged next year. She also announced that Godinez High School is having a haunted house on October 28 and 29 at 3:45 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. and asked that it be pushed out to the community. She wished everyone a safe Halloween. In addition, Mrs. Amezcua asked that Superintendent get back to Board on Taft.

Mr. Palacio shared that progress reports were due second week in October. He asked that a report on grades be provided to the Board. He also asked for a report by grade level and school site the number of students behind in credit hours and the total number of credit hours they are behind to know how the Board can help them. He stated that he is looking forward to the Santa Ana High School game on Thursday. Congratulations to Segerstrom and Santa Ana High School.

Dr. Alvarez thanked speakers and asked that staff to reach out to them. He also asked staff to follow up the parent who spoke on the Adult Transition Program. He shared that last Friday, October 22nd he had the opportunity to march from Santa Ana High School to stadium with high school students and from two intermediate schools. He encouraged everyone to be safe and shared that COVID testing and vaccine information could be viewed on our website. He also announced the November 8 Special Board Meeting Trustee Area Voting at Century High School

Ms. Torres thanked everyone for their hard work this school year. She asked everyone to take care of themselves and to be aware and compassionate as we make our way into the winter. She also thanked teachers, certificated staff, classified staff, students, parents, and speakers for speaking in support of title 7. Ms. Torres asked that if a resolution is passed that staff reach out and have real community outreach. She also acknowledged that October is Pilipino Heritage Month. Ms. Torres asked that a reminder on B2B be provided regarding the Resolution on Term Limits and asked Superintendent to double-check with legal counsel.

Dr. Rodriguez provided formalized the Board requests to follow up on. Board asked for follow up on Taft, report on D and F rates by grade and school site, related data request for number of credit hours students are behind on and the number of students who are behind on credit hours. He asked that if the reports are not ready in a week, to please inform Board on when they can expect it. In addition, staff is to follow up on Title 6 ED 506 Grant Form. The District is going to support the process of completing the application. He added that Board is supportive of it and requests that an update be provided at every Board meeting through December, on how the District is implementing it. In addition, an update on the air condition and heating issue at the Adult Transition Program sites is to be provided in the B2B. Dr. Rodriguez reminded everyone that the District Leadership entered into this year recognizing that students needed to have a safe welcoming environment and that the transition be as smooth as possible. Gradually we would start coming back to the educational piece. He also thanked staff and librarians. Dr. Rodriguez asked staff to allow students to heal and part of that is the grading system. He stated that the District will continue with compassionate grading. In closing, he thanked the residents for attending the Special Board meetings for the California Voting Rights Act, especially the members of the Orange County Congregation Community Organization (OCCCO). He encouraged everyone to attend to provide their input. At the next meeting we will be working on developing maps. It is an opportunity for families who send their children to District schools are actually living in wards where they can influence the results of the elections and accountability across the board.
