SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez announced that our Learning Labs launched at Madison Elementary, McFadden Intermediate, and Valley High schools Monday. Each site has reported that these labs have run smoothly so far. He thanked each principal and all our staff that helped open these Labs. Many of the students and staff members were excited to be back on campus. The participating parents were also appreciative of this resource. We look forward to launching Learning Labs at other sites in coming weeks. He also stated that Santa Ana Unified School District has joined Los Angeles Unified, Fresno, Long Beach, Oakland, Sacramento, and San Diego in committing to developing a common and high standard for safely reopening schools. These districts represent a combined 1 million students in California. Superintendents from each district signed a letter recently asking Governor Newsom, the state Legislature and local and county governments to join in this effort by supporting a collective action and additional funding to bring students, teachers and staff back to schools in the way that is as safe as possible

and sustainable for the long-term. Mr. Almendarez shared that COVID-19 positivity rates are again climbing at an alarming rate at the local and national level. He reminded our community that as we enter the flu season and families begin planning for the holidays to continue to practice safety measures, including mask wearing, social distancing, and avoiding large gatherings if possible. Also, our community partners continue to offer free testing for our community each week, so I encourage everyone to of this resource. These rates have to come down in order for all our students to have the opportunity to return to in-person instruction. Superintendent Almendarez invited the Board and community members to join him and other local superintendents at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, Nov. 12 in the Fourth District PTA's Advocacy Forum where discussion will take place on ongoing challenges presented to public schools in Orange County by the current pandemic. 

WHEREAS, the District is the lead agency for the preparation and consideration of environmental documents for the Project, as defined in the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended ("CEQA") and the State of California Guidelines for the Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act ("State Guidelines"); and

WHEREAS, the Irvine/Newport Development Area (INDA) Pre-Kindergarten charter school is requesting project approval from the Santa Ana Unified School District ("District").

WHEREAS, the project site is a 1.03-acre parcel at 2495 Campus Drive, Irvine (County of Orange Assessor's Parcel Number [APN] 445-021-15) that is developed with a 17,635-square-foot two-story office building and parking lot.

WHEREAS, the project site is part Irvine Business Complex (IBC) and included in the environmental impact report (State Clearinghouse No. 2007011024) for the Irvine Business Complex (IBC) Vision Plan and Mixed Uses Overlay Zoning Code (Original Project).

WHEREAS, the EIR was certified by the Irvine City Council on July 13, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Original Project did not have changes to the project site; and

WHEREAS, since certification of the EIR, minor revisions have been proposed to the project site to accommodate the charter school; and

WHEREAS, the INDA charter school would accommodate 225 pre-K–6 students and approximately 25 administrators, teachers, and staff in about 21,000 square feet of expanded, remodeled, modernized, and upgraded office building space, and other site changes for playground, and parking and circulation (Modified Project).

WHEREAS, based upon the analysis included in the Addendum to the EIR related to the Modified Project, together with the Modified Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, the District has determined that the Project will not result in new significant impacts or substantial increases in the severity of previously identified significant impacts and no supplemental or subsequent environmental review is required; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum to the EIR addresses the environmental effects associated with the changes in land use, substantially the same significant impacts identified in the 2010 Certified EIR remain and no new significant impacts will result and no substantial increase in severity of impacts will result from those previously identified in the EIR; and

51 WHEREAS, the District intends to use 2010 Certified EIR and the Addendum to the EIR prepared
52 in connection with said Modified Project, together with the Modified Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting
53 Program, as the environmental documentation required by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines for each
54 of the above-referenced Discretionary Action to the extent authorized by law; and

56 WHEREAS, copies of all of the documents constituting the CEQA proceedings set forth herein,
57 including, but not limited to, 2010 Certified EIR, Addendum to the EIR, the Modified Mitigation
58 Monitoring and Reporting Program, and all supporting material, are on file with the Santa Ana Unified
59 School District, 1601 E. Chestnut Avenue, Santa Ana, CA 92701 and, as referenced throughout, are
60 incorporated herein as if set forth in full; and

62 WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17213 and/or Public Resources Code Section
63 21151.8(a)(1), and based upon information included in the EIR Addendum for the INDA Charter School
64 site the Board hereby determines that the school site:

- 65 a. Is not the site of a current or former hazardous waste disposal or solid waste disposal site, and
- 66 b. Is not a hazardous substance release site identified by the Department of Toxic Substances Control
67 in a current list adopted pursuant to Section 25356 for removal or remedial action pursuant to Chapter 6.8
68 of Division 20 of the Health and Safety Code, and
- 69 c. Is not a site that contains one or more pipelines, situated underground or aboveground, that carries
70 hazardous substances, extremely hazardous substances, or hazardous wastes, unless the pipeline is a natural
71 gas line which is used only to supply natural gas to that school or neighborhood or other nearby schools,
72 and
- 73 d. Is not within 500 feet of the edge of the closest traffic lane of a freeway or other busy traffic corridor
74 as defined in Education Code Section 17213(d)(9) and Public Resources Code Section 21151.8(c)(9).
75

76 WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17213(b), (c), and (d) and/or Public Resources
77 Code Section 21151.8(a)(2) and (3), the South Coast Air Quality Management District was notified in
78 writing and consulted by the Santa Ana Unified School District acting as lead agency with regard to
79 identifying both permitted and non-permitted facilities within one quarter mile of the proposed school site
80 which might be reasonably anticipated to emit hazardous emissions or handle hazardous or extremely
81 hazardous materials, substances, or waste.
82

83 WHEREAS, 2010 Certified EIR and the Addendum to the EIR, together with the Modified
84 Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, has been presented to the Santa Ana Unified School District
85 Board of Education for review and consideration prior to the final approval of, and commitment to, said
86 Project.
87

88 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of
89 Education, pursuant to the provisions of CEQA, that the District, as lead agency for the Modified Project,
90 finds and declares, based upon its independent review and consideration of the Addendum to the EIR
91 prepared in connection with the Modified Project, together with the Modified Mitigation Monitoring and
92 Reporting Program, and the requirements of CEQA, including Section 21166 of the California Public
93 Resources Code and Section 15164 of the CEQA Guidelines, and the evidence received at the public
94 hearing, that 2010 Certified EIR and the Addendum to the EIR, together with the Modified Mitigation
95 Monitoring and Reporting Program, are adequate to serve as the required environmental documentation for
96 said Modified Project and satisfy all of the requirements of CEQA, and that no further environmental
97 documentation need be prepared for said Modified Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board hereby finds that the above-mentioned consultation (and any other survey work done) identified none of the facilities or other significant pollution sources, as specified in Education Code Section 17213 and Public Resources Code Section 21151.8, within one quarter mile of the proposed school site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board hereby adopts the Addendum to the EIR.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board hereby adopts the Modified Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board hereby finally approves the Modified Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education, that staff is hereby directed to file a notice of determination with the County of Orange within five working days of the adoption of this Resolution.

PROCLAMATION IN SUPPORT OF ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE

WHEREAS, Government Code section 65040.12 defines environmental justice as “the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of people of all races, cultures, incomes, and national origins with respect to the development, adoption, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies, including the meaningful consideration of recommendations from populations and communities most impacted by pollution into environmental and land use decisions;

WHEREAS, environmental justice involves the availability of a healthy environment for all people;

WHEREAS, an environmental justice community is a community where residents are disproportionately burdened by pollution and other environmental factors due to historic inequities in environmental decision-making;

WHEREAS, the state identifies 17 environmental justice communities in the City of Santa Ana;

WHEREAS, approximately 87 percent of Santa Ana Unified School District students come from low-income families, over 98 percent of students in SAUSD are students of color and together 45 percent of SAUSD students are English learners;

WHEREAS, many of the students and families in our community live in close proximity to industrial facilities and are exposed to high levels of air quality emissions and other pollutants which can result in negative health effects and socio-economic burdens;

WHEREAS, proximity to polluting facilities results in difficulties providing high-quality education and reduces the ability for our youth to achieve, contributing to a cycle of disadvantage for youth in environmental justice communities;

WHEREAS, SAUSD students face a higher risk of asthma, learning difficulties, missed school days, and other harmful effects to their well-being due to these conditions;

WHEREAS, close proximity to polluting facilities lowers the property value of homes in our community, which leads to fewer resources for our schools;

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Ana is in the process of updating its General Plan, which sets guidelines for land use and other community decisions until 2045 and shall reflect community priorities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Be it resolved that the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education firmly supports the principles of environmental justice and the meaningful inclusion of environmental justice communities in decisions about our community's future;
2. Be it further resolved that Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education advocates for incorporation of environmental justice robustly into the City of Santa Ana's General Plan;
3. Be it further resolved that Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education urges the City to account for the COVID-19 pandemic in its efforts to engage with our community as it develops a General Plan that will impact SAUSD families and students;
4. Be it further resolved that Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education supports the adoption of a General Plan Update that adequately solicits input from all members of our community; and
5. The Santa Ana Unified School District is committed to advocating on behalf of our students and families for environmental justice so Santa Ana youth will be able to play, learn, and grow in a healthy environment, now and in the future.




