BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez thanked the Public Schools Foundation for the State of the District, the Superintendent for doing a great job with his presentation, the Cabinet, parents and stakeholders. He shared that it is wonderful having a convening like this and having a forum. He also thanked the Board for establishing an ad hoc committee for community schools and shared that as soon as they articulate more of its purpose and will update the public. Dr. Rodriguez thanked parents for speaking and for advocating for schools and stated that this is a safe space for parents to share their point of view. He requested a B2B on the color guard issue and dual enrollment and to schedule something on dual enrollment. Lastly, he added that Thanksgiving is next week and asked everyone to take the time to reflect on everything that is working in our lives and do the best we can.

Ms. Brazer Aceves reiterated her excitement for everyone who advocated for the noncitizen voting to be added to our City elections. She acknowledged that she is close to her one year as a Board member and recognized the opportunities she has had to connect with parents on advocacy, the progress as a community for more representation, policies and programs. She stated that this moment tonight brought everything together and is very proud. She highlighted agenda item 9.5 as one of our consultants/community partners is Padres Unidos and acknowledged Dr. Mesa Huerta and Ms. Sofie's attendance at tonight's meeting. She added that their work is phenomenal and that they are a strong partner. Ms. Brazer Aceves gave a shout out to other team members and parents who have participated in their parent program, thanked Ms. Solomon for her support. She congratulated the students who were recognized for completing SAUSD's Police Explorer Program. She also congratulated the recipients of the Jet Propulsion Laboratory Scholarship and gave a shout out to Mr. Woods. Additionally she congratulated team members on their administrative appointments and thanked all teachers, staff, and students who allow her to visit. Ms. Brazer Aceves also highlighted her visits to Adams, Jefferson, Greenville Fundamental, Carl Harvey, and Madison Elementary Schools, Segerstrom and Valley High Schools.

She also shared that she joined Superintendent for student listening sessions at Valley High School and congratulated Dr. Olamendi and the Special Education team for their presentation at the Council of Great City Schools conference.

Mr. Bustos acknowledged the Monday November 20 as Transgender Day of Remembrance and to remember and honor the lives we have lost to anti-trans, hate and violence. He gave a shout out to Madison Elementary School for hosting trans visibility week in support of LGBTQ students at elementary level. Mr. Bustos requested a B2B regarding parents ability to attend intermediate sport events. In addition, he requested information regarding student board member and to start having discussions. He thanked color guard students that spoke today and requested more updates on that. He invited everyone to listen to the Amplifying Leadership podcast episode he is featured in can get the link through his Instagram page, hectorforsausd, the link is in his bio and in the District's social media. He addressed the recall election being held tonight which will impact our students and families, he uplifted Mayor Pro Temp. Lopez, and mentioned the City Council Members who support the recall.

Dr. Alvarez gave a shout out to three football teams who went to California Interscholastic Federation (CIF); Segerstrom Fundamental, Santa Ana, and Valley High Schools. He was able to travel with students to the Santa Ana and Valley High School games in Santa Monica where he had conversations with parents. He also gave a shout out to the Santa Ana High School band who have won four competitions and have qualified for the band championship. Dr. Alvarez requested follow up with the students from color guard and to see if there is anything we can do.

Ms. Torres reiterated Board member requests as follows: color guard; VAPA budget site vs, district and instructors being paid; dual enrollment, the story, site based, and district vision based; parent attendance at intermediate sports events; student board member and requested that a separate email for student board member survey be sent out. She thanked the public speakers, acknowledged thanksgiving next week and shared her individual feedback on the history of the horrible violence that took place and was later turned into mythology. She encouraged Indigenous food to consider like corn, potatoes, pumpkin, and squash. Ms. Torres also encouraged everyone to reach out to folks that may be lonely. She thanked all staff as we move towards the winter break, acknowledged the hard jobs that everyone has, and hopes everyone is able to rest. Ms. Torres affirmed Board members and thanked them, acknowledged Mr. Bustos' energy, and closed the meeting with the land acknowledgement she closes her classes with as follows: "I would like to acknowledge that this meeting is held on the traditional and unceded land of the Tongva peoples, acknowledge the Acjachemen peoples who have stewarded the southern and coastal areas which we now refer to as Orange County. I want to pay my respects to elders both past and present as well as the Tongva and Acjachemen youth who have attended our schools and neighboring districts."

WHEREAS, 2 CFR Section 200.320(a)(1)(i) authorizes the "acquisition of supplies or services, the aggregate dollar amount of which does not exceed the micro-purchase threshold," and provides that, "[t]o the maximum extent practicable, 22 the non-Federal entity should distribute micro-purchases equitably among qualified suppliers"; and

25 WHEREAS, 2 CFR Section 200.320(a)(1)(ii) provides that, among other things, a 26 non-Federal entity may award micro-purchases "without soliciting competitive price 27 or rate quotations if the non-Federal entity considers the price to be reasonable 28 based on research, experience, purchase history or other information and documents 29 it files accordingly"; and

31 WHEREAS, 2 CFR Section 200.320(a)(1)(iii) provides that, among other things, 32 a "non-Federal entity is responsible for determining and documenting an appropriate 33 micro-purchase threshold based on internal controls, an evaluation of risk, and its 34 documented procurement procedures," and the "micro-purchase threshold used by the 35 non-Federal entity must be authorized or not prohibited under State, local, or tribal laws or regulations"; and

- (ii) The non-Federal entity conducts an annual internal institutional risk assessment to identify, mitigate, and manage financial risks; or
 - (iii) For public institutions, a higher threshold is consistent with State law.

WHEREAS, as applicable to the District, 48 CFR Section 2.101 currently provides that the federal micro-purchase threshold is: (i) \$10,000 generally; and (ii) \$2,000 for services subject to 40 United States Code, Chapter 31, Subchapter IV (i.e., construction services subject to Davis-Bacon Act which, among other things, relates to rates of wages for laborers and mechanics); and

61 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 20111 of the California Public Contract 62 Code ("PCC"), a public school district currently is required to seek competitive 63 bids for: (i) acquisition of equipment, materials, supplies, services that are not 64 construction services, and repairs (including maintenance) that are not a public 65 project, involving an expenditure of more than \$109,300; and (ii) contracts for 66 public projects involving an expenditure of \$15,000 or more; and

68 WHEREAS, a copy of PCC Section 20111 in effect as of the date of this 69 Resolution is attached as Exhibit "A" to this Resolution, and a copy of the 70 California Department of Education notice of increased bid thresholds applicable as 71 of the date of this Resolution is attached as Exhibit "B" to this Resolution; and

73 WHEREAS, in accordance with PCC Section 22030, the District, effective the 74 12th of February, 2019, has elected to become subject to the California Uniform 75 Construction Cost Accounting Procedures ("CUPCCAA") and are therefore subject to 76 bidding requirements for public projects that are an alternative to the bidding 77 requirements for public projects set forth in PCC Section 20111; and

WHEREAS, to evidence that the District has elected to become subject to CUPCCAA, attached as Exhibit "D" to this Resolution are pages 1, 12, and 27 of the list, published on the California State Controller's Office website (at the following link: https://www.sco.ca.gov/Files-ARD-Local/participating agencies -_general.pdf), of the public agencies that, as of the date of this Resolution, have elected to become subject to CUPCCAA (for efficiency, the full list of 43 pages was 92 not attached to this Resolution); and

94 WHEREAS, in accordance with the foregoing, the District is authorized by 95 California law to award contracts and purchase orders, without need to seek 96 competitive bids or undertake any other competitive process: (i) for equipment, 97 materials, supplies, and services that are not public projects costing less than 98 \$109,300; and (ii) for public projects costing \$60,000 or less; and

100 WHEREAS, in accordance with the third basis for establishing a higher micro-101 purchase threshold set forth in 2 CFR Section 200.320(a)(1)(iv), the District 102 permissibly may self-certify a higher micro-purchase threshold because California law authorizes bid thresholds that are higher than the \$50,000 maximum threshold authorized by 2 CFR Section 200.320(a)(1)(iv); and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Education does hereby find, order, and resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Education hereby finds that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and hereby adopts such recitals as findings of the Board of 111 Education.

Subject to Section 3 herein, the Board of Education hereby 119 authorizes and directs the Superintendent of the District ("Superintendent"), the 120 Assistant Superintendent of Business Services for the District ("Assistant 121 Superintendent"), the Director of Purchasing and Stores for the District 122 ("Director"), and/or their designee, to retain this Resolution (including Exhibits 123 hereto) in the District's records for not less than the period of time applicable 124 pursuant to 2 CFR Section 200.334.

126 Section 4. The Board of Education hereby authorizes and directs the 127 Superintendent, the Assistant Superintendent, the Director, and/or their designee, 128 annually and for so long as applicable, to seek approval from the Board of 129 Education of resolutions by which the Board of Education self-certifies to the 130 higher micro-purchase thresholds for federally-funded contracts and purchase 131 orders.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval and adoption by the Board of Education.
