WHEREAS, to accommodate the Modernization Projects ("Projects") at the Property, Southern California Edison ("SCE") requires an easement to install electrical upgrades, including to upgrade the new utility service installation ("Easement"); and

WHEREAS, SCE's Easement would enable it to install, construct, operate, and maintain a 12,000 kilovolt electrical supply system and associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, District staff has independently and in conjunction with SCE considered and determined that the proposed Easement area is not needed for classroom buildings because the infrastructure will be located and installed underground and will not interfere with future development needs for the Property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code sections 17556 et seq., the District may dedicate an Easement to SCE, for public utility purposes, upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree; and

WHEREAS, in order to convey the proposed Easement, pursuant to Education Code sections 17556 et seq., the first step is to pass this Resolution of Intention to convey by two-thirds vote of the entire Governing Board of Education of the Santa Ana Unified School District ("Board"), then notice a public hearing, hold a public hearing; and adopt a resolution conveying the proposed Easement at a subsequent Board meeting; and

WHEREAS, given that the existing electrical utilities are impeding the construction of the Projects, and upgrading the Easement will help accommodate completion of the Projects, and that the Easement areas are not needed for classroom buildings as the electrical upgrade infrastructure will be located underground, and will not interfere with future development of the Property, staff recommends that the Board adopt the Resolution of Intention and authorize the District to prepare a notice of public hearing and hold a public hearing to consider granting the Easement for public utility purposes; and

WHEREAS, an easement agreement setting forth the terms of the Easement between the District and SCE shall be brought for approval at the Board meeting where the resolution conveying the proposed Easement is considered.
