- Communicate by voice or signing instruction and discussions for students who are deaf and hard of hearing when necessary. **E**
- Assist students with teacher's instructional materials program. **E**
- Assist students in practicing communication skills. **E**
- Assist with learning activities as planned with teachers; instruct and direct student activities to implement follow-up programs set up by teacher. **E**
- Work with students individually or in small groups by tutoring, reinforcing or following-up on the lessons and assignments. **E**
- Assist in testing, scoring tests and in the evaluation of instruction and student's progress and problems. **E**
- May follow teacher's lesson plans; may assist teacher in preparation of plans or develop own lesson plans based on teacher's direction and explanation of the student's need. **E**
- Prepare materials and equipment and operate instructional equipment. **E**
- Perform other clerical duties such as maintaining inventories, maintaining routine records such as attendance, grades and test scores. **E**
- Maintain classroom or learning facility in a clean and organized manner. **E**



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



RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO GRANT EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITY PURPOSES
TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON FOR SADDLEBACK HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District (“District”) is the owner of certain real property located at 2802 S. Flower in Santa Ana, CA, known as Saddleback High School, Santa Ana, California 92707 (“Property”); and

WHEREAS, to accommodate the Modernization Projects (“Projects”) at the Property, Southern California Edison (“SCE”) requires an easement to install electrical upgrades, including to upgrade the new utility service installation (“Easement”); and

WHEREAS, SCE’s Easement would enable it to install, construct, operate, and maintain a 12,000 kilovolt electrical supply system and associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, District staff has independently and in conjunction with SCE considered and determined that the proposed Easement area is not needed for classroom buildings because the infrastructure will be located and installed underground and will not interfere with future development needs for the Property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code sections 17556 et seq., the District may dedicate an Easement to SCE, for public utility purposes, upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree; and

WHEREAS, in order to convey the proposed Easement, pursuant to Education Code sections 17556 et seq., the first step is to pass this Resolution of Intention to convey by two-thirds vote of the entire Governing Board of Education of the Santa Ana Unified School District (“Board”), then notice a public hearing, hold a public hearing; and adopt a resolution conveying the proposed Easement at a subsequent Board meeting; and

WHEREAS, given that the existing electrical utilities are impeding the construction of the Projects, and upgrading the Easement will help accommodate completion of the Projects, and that the Easement areas are not needed for classroom buildings as the electrical upgrade infrastructure will be located underground, and will not interfere with future development of the Property, staff recommends that the Board adopt the Resolution of Intention and authorize the District to prepare a notice of public hearing and hold a public hearing to consider granting the Easement for public utility purposes; and

WHEREAS, an easement agreement setting forth the terms of the Easement between the District and SCE shall be brought for approval at the Board meeting where the resolution conveying the proposed Easement is considered.

49 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, for good and sufficient cause based on the entire
50 record of proceedings, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education ("Board") hereby finds
