SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Richard Tauer gave the Superintendent's report. He shared that the District received a letter from the county where they state we are no longer on the list of recipients of the CENSUS Grant after receiving an award letter to our Request for Proposal (RFP). Mr. Tauer added that there will be a OC Board of Supervisors meeting at 9:00 a.m. on December 17, 2019, at which time there may be opportunity to speak about the Census. RESOLUTION NO. 19/20-3323

BOARD OF EDUCATION

SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

Approving Conditional Renewal of the Charter for Orange County School of the Arts Charter School

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 47600 et seq., the Governing Board of the Santa Ana Unified School District ("SAUSD" and/or "District") is required to review and authorize creation and/or renewal of charter schools;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of SAUSD has previously approved the Charter for the Orange County School of the Arts Charter School ("OCSA"), with its current term running through and including June 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, a petition was delivered to the District requesting that the Board renew OCSA's Charter for a five-year term from July 1, 2020, through and including June 30, 2025 ("Renewal Petition");

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Charter Schools Act of 1992, the Renewal Petition was received by the District Governing Board at its meeting on November 19, 2019, thereby commencing the timelines for the Board action to take action regarding the Renewal Petition;

WHEREAS, in compliance with California Education Code Sections 47605 and 47607 and California Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 11966.4, the Governing Board is required to approve or deny the request for a charter renewal within sixty (60) days of the Governing Board's receipt of the renewal petition unless that timeline is extended for an additional thirty (30) days by mutual written agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 47605, a public hearing on the provisions of the Charter was conducted on November 19, 2019, at which time the Governing Board considered the level of support for the Renewal Petition by teachers employed by the District, other employees of the District, and parents;

WHEREAS, in reviewing the Renewal Petition, the Governing Board has been cognizant of the intent of the Legislature that charter schools are and should become an integral part of the California educational system and that establishment of charter schools should be encouraged;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Code Section 47607(a)(3)(A), the Governing Board has considered increases in pupil academic achievement for all groups of pupils served by OCSA as the most important factor in determining whether to grant OCSA's renewal request;

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 11966.4(b)(1), in considering OCSA's Renewal Petition the District Governing Board considered the past performance of OCSA's academics, finances, and operation and future plans for improvement, if any, in evaluating the likelihood of future success;

WHEREAS, District staff, in collaboration with legal counsel, reviewed and analyzed all of the information received with respect to the Renewal Petition, including information related to the operation and potential effects of OCSA;

WHEREAS, District Staff and legal counsel identified deficiencies in the Renewal Petition and current operation of OCSA identified in the Staff Report attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A", and determined that renewal of the Petition may be approved conditioned upon OCSA addressing the findings in the Staff Report, which includes most significantly, specified revisions to its admission procedures, staff qualifications, financial operations, LCAP, balance of student populations, instructional program description, student outcome and progress measures description, and plans to meet the needs of identified student subgroups;

WHEREAS, the terms of the approval of the Renewal Petition require that, on or before June 30, 2020, OCSA agrees to address the findings identified in the Staff Report, and in absence of such agreements, would amount to denial findings;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has fully considered the revised renewal Charter and the recommendation provided by District staff; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Governing Board of SAUSD finds the above-listed recitals to be true and correct and incorporates them herein by this reference.
- 2. That OCSA has met minimum standards for renewal of a charter pursuant to Education Code Section 47607.

- 3. That the Governing Board of the Santa Ana Unified School District, having fully considered and evaluated the Renewal Petition, hereby approves the renewal of OCSA's Charter for a term of five (5) years from July 1, 2020, through and including June 30, 2025, conditioned upon OCSA's agreement to address the findings in the Staff Report attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to this Resolution ("Conditions for Approval");
- 4. That should OCSA fail to satisfy the Conditions of Approval, the Renewal Petition shall be deemed denied as of the date this Resolution was passed, based upon the grounds for denial under Education Code sections 47605(b)(2), (5), and 47607, per the findings in the Staff Report attached hereto as Exhibit "A," which otherwise would constitute the written factual findings required by Education Code section 47605(b) to deny the renewal.

The foregoing Resolution was considered, passed, and adopted by this Board at its special meeting of December 10, 2019.
