CALL TO ORDER

Board President Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. Dr. Rodriguez announced that one of the items the Board would be discussing under existing litigation was case number 15HF0196.

Other members present were Ms. Torres, Mrs. Amezcua, and Mr. Palacio.

Dr. Rodriguez asked if there was anyone wishing to address the Board related to closed session items.

Superintendent Almendarez recognized the Caring Educators Nourishing All (C.E.N.A.) committee members for their dedication to the students and families of SAUSD.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent provided a COVID update. He was happy to report that our COVID positive rates continue to drop across the district. He reminded families that masking is still required for all indoor activities for all students and all staff at every school, district office, or other district site. The California Department of Public Health has indicated new guidance could be provided as soon as next week regarding masking in public schools. The SAUSD health and safety teams will evaluate all new state and local guidance and the District will work with our schools and inform our families involving any changes to our health and safety protocols. He added that free daily testing clinics for any community member are still being offered and invited everyone to visit www.sausd.us and SAUSD social media sites for the latest times, dates and locations. Mr. Almendarez announced that the District is holding the first in a series of three public meetings for families of students in special education programs tomorrow, Wednesday, February 25, 2022 from 5:00-7:30 p.m. at Saddleback High School. These meetings are in addition to the monthly Community Advisory Committee meetings. The goal for these three meetings is for families to have additional opportunities to provide input as we continue to develop priorities for our special education programs and are open to all parents. Superintendent Almendarez recognized Andrea Foster, the District Nurse, for representing SAUSD last week in a statewide "Principal Practices for Safe Schools" training webinar, hosted by the California Department of Public Health, UCLA, and UC San Francisco. Ms. Foster explained to participants from across California how SAUSD works to keep our schools safe with our weekly testing efforts, contact tracing protocols, and other practices. Ms. Foster and her team of dedicated nurses and LVNs have been on the front lines protecting our students and staff during this pandemic. He offered his sincere gratitude to all SAUSD staff for their ongoing support in promoting health and safety during these unprecedented times. Mr. Almendarez also announced the Boca de Oro Festival of Literary, Visual, Performing Arts & Culture which returns in-person for its sixth year on Saturday, March 5, 2022 in Downtown Santa Ana. The event includes SAUSD student artists in live performances as well as arts, crafts and other interactive workshops. This year's theme is "Together We Rise," honoring the spirit of healing, recovery, rebirth and reconnection through the arts amid the pandemic. Mr. Palacio requested a copy of the Solis Report and in addition he requested the Annual Title 9 report for the last seven years that deals with sexual harassment.

Dr. Alvarez thanked public speakers. He shared that the national weather service issued a cold weather warning. Dr. Alvarez announced that speech and debate harbor tournament took place last weekend. Students participated in the Harbor Tournament. He congratulated all students. Middle College and SAHS, congratulated them. Two

things this week Thursday – Saturday, Into the Heights, Also Godinez is putting on Grease. He asked for more information on sports equity and asked that the District take a look at sports and the pay for coaches.

Ms. Torres addressed an email on filing a complaint and no follow up. She was on an email together with the Superintendent regarding a uniform complaint that has not been followed up on. Ms. Torres requested information on a program for Classified staff to obtain credential. A staff member reached out and stated they fell through the cracks. They went through the program, was an IA, but fell through the cracks of the program. Ms. Torres will follow up with Superintendent on this case and asked that we keep track of these employees. She also addressed the use of masks and encouraged everyone to be very reflective of it.

Dr. Rodriguez shared data on the number of students out last week due to being positive or being quarantine. He encouraged everyone not to let their guard down. Dr. Rodriguez asked for follow up on the Solis Report which has been produced and requested it be sent to Board in B2B; Annual Title 9 for the last seven years; Update on the LMT issue at the next meeting; Sports equity, Dr. Alvarez had conversation with Jim, who stated he would send Board correspondence regarding sports equity; Request for an update on Coaches pay as we go through the budget process; and Request to place the Management/Supervisory salary schedule on the next agenda.

There being no further business to come before the Board, President Rodriguez adjourned the meeting at 10:32 p.m.
