SANTA ANA BOARD OF EDUCATION

February 9, 2016





BOARD OF EDUCATION

SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

Body Worn Camera Program

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District (hereinafter District) is a public school district enrolling over 56,000 kindergarten through twelfth grade students, with an educational program of exceptional quality due to the professionalism and dedication of its employees;

WHEREAS, the District has a valued relationship with all the communities surrounding its various schools within the District;

WHEREAS, the District, in order to maintain the quality of education, requires and promotes a safe learning environment at all its school sites and surrounding communities;

WHEREAS, the District has one of the few school police departments in the State of California;

WHEREAS, the District's Police Department employs 25 officers who were recruited by the Santa Ana Unified School District, are full-time employees of the District, and are California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified;

WHEREAS, the District has determined that in order to provide a safe and secure learning environment for its students, employees and its police officers, the District is considering a body worn camera program for its police officers which will have both video and audio capabilities;

WHEREAS, the District is not aware of any such program in the K-12 school environment in the State of California;

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code section 20111 requires that a public school district competitively bid contracts exceeding \$87,800 and to award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder;

39 **WHEREAS**, the estimated initial cost for the body worn camera program with
40 full video and audio capabilities is estimated to be between \$250,000 to \$500,000;

42 **WHEREAS**, District staff has determined that an alternative procurement
43 process would be a more viable solution based upon the highly technical nature of a
44 body worn video and audio camera system, and the need to have the most advanced
45 technology behind the program;
46

47 **WHEREAS**, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 provides the District an
48 alternative procurement process, which will allow the District to consider the
49 unique and highly specialized nature of technology in the acquisition of the body
50 worn video and audio camera system for its police officers;
51

52 **WHEREAS**, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 emphasizes the fact that due to
53 the highly specialized and unique nature of technology, telecommunications, related
54 equipment, software, and services, and because products and materials of that
55 nature are undergoing rapid technological changes and in order to allow for the
56 introduction of new technological changes, it is in the public's best interest to
57 allow a school district to consider, in addition to price, factors such as
58 performance reliability, standardization, life-cycle costs, delivery timetables,
59 support logistics, the broadest possible range of competing products and materials
60 available, manufacturer warranties, and similar factors in the award of contracts
61 for such technology;
62

63 **WHEREAS**, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 requires that the District make
64 findings supporting this alternative procurement process before the process begins;
65

66 **WHEREAS**, the alternative procurement process authorized by Public Contract
67 Code section 20118.2 requires seven steps in order to justify an award of a
68 contract, all of which the District will follow in order to provide the best
69 possible solution for the District; and
70

71 **WHEREAS**, this alternative procurement process requires the following: (1) the
72 preparation of a request for proposal by the school district which is submitted to
73 an adequate number of qualified sources, as determined by the school district, to
74 permit reasonable competition consistent with the nature and requirement of the
75 procurement; (2) the publication of a notice of the request for proposal at least
76 twice in a newspaper of general circulation at least ten (10) days before the date

77 for receipt of the proposals; (3) every effort by the school district to generate
78 the maximum feasible number of proposals from qualified sources and a finding to
79 that effect before proceeding to negotiate if only a single response to the request
80 for proposal is received; (4) the request for proposal shall identify all
81 significant evaluation factors, including price and their relative importance;
82 (5) reasonable procedures provided by the school district for the technical
83 evaluation of the proposals received, the identification of qualified sources, and
84 the selection for the award of the contract; (6) the award of a contract shall be
85 made to the qualified source whose proposal meets the evaluation standards and will
86 be most advantageous to the school district with price and all other factors
87 considered; and (7) if an award is not made to the source whose proposal contains
88 the lowest price, the school district shall make a finding setting forth the basis
89 for the award of any contract;

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91 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**
92 **FINDS, DECLARES, RESOLVES AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

94 1. The Board of Education hereby finds that the recitals set forth
95 above are true and correct.
- 96
97 2. The Board of Education hereby finds that it intends to proceed under
98 Public Contract Code section 20118.2 in order to award a contract
99 for a body worn video/audio camera program for its police officers.
- 100
101 3. The Board of Education finds that the safety and security on the
102 District's school sites is of paramount importance necessitating
103 such a program.
- 104
105 4. The Board of Education finds that the deployment of body worn video
106 and audio cameras is a commitment to its police officers to ensure
107 (a) accurate documentation of official duty-related activity of its
108 officers in the field; (b) safety of its officers; and (c) positive
109 relations with the District employees, students and communities
110 surrounding the school sites.
- 111
112 5. The Board of Education finds that the deployment of body worn video
113 and audio cameras is a commitment to its employees, students and the
114 communities surrounding the school sites to ensure

115 (a) accountability of its police officers for their actions;
116 (b) proper evaluation of school incidents; and (c) better monitoring
117 of the school environment.

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119 6. The Board of Education finds that transparency, accountability and
120 community trust in the District's police officers is imperative, and
121 the need for the most advanced technology is required to support the
122 body worn video/audio camera program.

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124 7. The Board of Education finds that the body worn video/audio camera
125 program will accomplish the following: a strong partnership between
126 the District's police officers and its certificated and classified
127 employees to enhance a positive school environment; assist the
128 police officers to collaboratively work with the employees and
129 students at the school sites to deal with problems before they
130 occur; prevent excessive use-of-force incidents; and assist in crime
131 and juvenile delinquency prevention, crisis intervention and
132 mediation of disputes.

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134 8. The Board of Education finds that a body worn video and audio camera
135 program will involve the following: (a) the deployment of
136 lightweight cameras worn on the front of an officer's uniform,
137 typically on the chest or on the belt depending on body type, while
138 on duty in the field; (b) cameras with both video and audio
139 capabilities utilizing only the most advanced technology in the law
140 enforcement industry; (c) a mobile device used to review and tag
141 video in the field; (d) an evidence transfer manager or docking
142 station to upload the video and perform various technical functions
143 such as synching the date and time and protecting the integrity and
144 confidentiality of the data; (e) continual updating of camera
145 hardware and software with the latest technology; (f) retention of
146 all the video and audio data requiring unlimited storage of all the
147 video and audio data on District servers at the District office;
148 (g) a data management solution used to access and review video along
149 with audio as well as share video and audio evidence with local
150 authorities; (h) additional staffing to adequately manage the data;
151 (i) full maintenance support; (j) training and consulting services
152 for its officers and employees involved in the management of all the

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data generated pursuant to the program; and (k) a long-term program to ensure its success in the District that will involve the development of clear and comprehensive objectives, policies and procedures.

9. The Board of Education hereby appoints the Superintendent as the District's administrator for the body worn video and audio camera program in order to ensure that the process utilized to select a successful contractor for this program follows the guidelines and directions set forth herein.

10. The Board of Education also authorizes the Superintendent to execute any documents required and to take whatever additional actions are necessary to ensure that the District's goals, objectives, policies and procedures in relation to this program are adhered to as directed by the Board of Education of the District.


