Superintendent Almendarez shared that on February 27, 2020, he had the pleasure of visiting various sites and surprising Educators and Classified School Employees of the Year: Monica Andrade - Century HS Counselor, Sandra Torres - Madison Elementary Office Manager, Gloria Maldonado - Cesar Chavez HS Teacher, Laura Gomez - Martin Elementary Teacher, Kathy Woolard - Adams Elementary Student Support Provider, Leo Aguilar - Godinez HS Plant Custodian, Winona Ocampo - Diamond Elementary Nutrition Services Lead, Jennifer Taylor - Monte Vista TOSA, Teresa Garcia - Mendez Fundamental Teacher, Denise Bailon - Hoover Elementary Site Coordinator, Khan Va - Sierra Preparatory Speech and Language Pathologist. Superintendent also shared about the opportunity he had to attend KinderCaminata 2020 at Santa Ana College, where more than 1,000 kindergartners from eleven (11) school sites learned about college and career options. In addition, Superintendent also attended 2020 School Games Special Olympics. He announced that Monday, March 2nd was the National Read Across America Day and he had the privilege to read to students. FINDINGS OF THE ANNUAL AND FIVE-YEAR REPORTABLE DEVELOPER FEES REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 IN COMPLIANCE WITH GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 66006 AND 66001

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District ("District") has received and expended statutory and/or alternative school facilities fees ("Reportable Fees") for the construction of the District's school facilities in order to accommodate students from new development; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 66006(a), the District has established and maintained a separate capital facilities account for the Reportable Fees ("Reportable Fees Account"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 66006(a), the Reportable Fees have been deposited into the Reportable Fees Account in order to avoid any commingling of the Reportable Fees with other revenues and funds of the District, except for temporary investments, and has expended the Reportable Fees, along with any interest income earned, solely for the purpose(s) for which the Reportable Fees were originally collected; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 66006(b)(1) provides that the District shall make a written report containing certain required information available to the public within one hundred eighty (180) days after the last day of each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 66006(b)(2) requires that the Board of Education of the District ("Board") review the information made available to the public, including the report entitled "Annual and Five-Year Reportable Developer Fees Report for Fiscal Year 2018-2019" ("Report") at the next regularly scheduled public meeting, at least fifteen (15) days after the Report was made available to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Report contains the requisite information and proposed findings concerning the collection and expenditure of Reportable Fees pursuant to Government Code Sections 66006 and 66001; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 66001(d) provides that for the fifth fiscal year following the first deposit into the Reportable Fees Account, and every five years thereafter, the District shall make findings with respect to the portion of the Reportable Fees Account that remains unexpended; and

WHEREAS, the District has complied with all of the foregoing provisions.

Section 5. Pursuant to Government Code Section 66006(b)(1), the Board reviewed the Report at the next regularly scheduled public meeting at least fifteen (15) days after the Report was made available to the public.



**Authorizing the Transfer of Funds from District Self-Insurance Fund (Fund 67 to
General Fund (Fund 01)**

WHEREAS, the Administration is seeking authorization from the Board of Education for the transfer of funds from Self-Insurance Fund (Fund 67) to General Fund (Fund 01); and

WHEREAS, Santa Ana Unified School District is self-insured (also known as self-funded) in workers compensation under the authority of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). As a prudent practice the District maintains sufficient reserves for the "incurred liabilities for the payment of compensation and the performance of the obligations of employers imposed" under the workers compensation code. Based on the District's Actuarial Workers Compensation Report dated June 30, 2019, the estimated outstanding losses for workers compensation is \$14.09 million. Currently District's Self-Insurance Fund (Fund 67) has a projected ending fund balance of approximately \$30 million; and

WHEREAS, the District is facing cost pressures in General Fund from declining enrollment, increases in the District's employer retirement contribution (CalSTRS and CalPERS) and Special Education cost increases. In order to partially offset the cost pressures on a one-time basis, the District is proposing a one-time funds transfer of \$25 Million from Fund 67 to Fund 01 to support District operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of Education hereby authorizes the transfer of \$25 million from Self-Insurance Fund (Fund 67) to General Fund (Fund 01).


