Santa Ana Board of Education

Tuesday, March 12, 2024

1. CALL TO ORDER

President Torres called the meeting to order at 5:04 p.m.

Other members present were Mr. Bustos and Dr. Rodriguez.

Ms. Brazer Aceves was absent.

Ms. Torres announced the closed session agenda items as follows: Conference with labor negotiators, personnel matters, existing litigation, anticipated litigation, and conference with real property negotiators.

Ms. Torres asked if there was anyone wishing to address the Board related to closed session items. There was no one wishing to address the Board.

2. RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION

The Regular Board meeting recessed to closed session at 5:05 p.m.

Dr. Alvarez joined the meeting at 5:33 p.m.

3. RECONVENE TO REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Board meeting reconvened at 6:01 p.m.

4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Superintendent Almendarez led the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Ms. Torres read out a land acknowledgement statement as follows: I want to recognize that our District and school campuses are located in the Village of Pasbenga. I want to acknowledge that this land we refer to as Orange County, is the unceded and traditional lands of the Gabrieleno Tongva Nation, and the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation. These lands were taken through a process of colonization, physical, and cultural genocide. I want to pay my respect to elders, both past and present, as well as the Tongva and Acjachemen youth who have attended and are currently attending our schools in neighboring districts.

7. BOARD MEMBER RECOGNITION

7.1 Recognition of Dorothy Mulkey for Contributions to Fair Housing Rights in Santa Ana

Ms. Torres invited Dorothy Mulkey up to the podium as she recognized her for her unwavering courage, resiliency, contributions to civil rights, and her role in shaping a more inclusive and equitable society. Her persistence led to a U.S. Supreme Court victory, overturning Proposition 14 and ending redlining across the country. This landmark decision enabled families of color to pursue housing beyond the confines of segregation.

Ms. Torres invited Benjamin Vazquez, a teacher at Santa Ana Valley High School, Mireya Vazquez, a counselor at Century High School, Hugo Vazquez, a special education teacher with the Adult Transition Program, Adriana Vazquez, a school psychologist at Jackson Elementary School, Julia Vazquez, also a special education teacher with the Adult Transition Program at Century High School, Cassandra Castorena, a student support paraprofessional at Garfield Elementary School, to award them with the first ever Heartbeat of Santa Ana Unified School District recognition. This honor shines a light on the individuals who are not just part of our District but are the very essence of what we stand for, a deep enduring connection that weaves together generations of students, families, and educators in a vibrant educational tapestry.

14. BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez expressed gratitude towards staff for their work on Average Daily Attendance (ADA) and their efforts in reducing chronic absenteeism. He shared his admiration for Dorothy Mulkey, highlighted the historical context of her case, and proposed the inclusion of the Mulkey story in the curriculum to highlight the significance of the issues. Dr. Rodriguez also suggested the establishment of a Dorothy Mulkey Day to honor her and her family's legacy in combating racial segregation and discrimination.

Mr. Bustos shared that he had the opportunity to visit sites, thanked teachers, and administrators at Santiago, Edison, Carver, and Lincoln Elementary Schools. He highlighted the visit to Lincoln with Orange County's Poet Laureate Gustavo Hernandez. Mr. Bustos announced that he and Dr. Alvarez attended the Joint School Collaboration City Council Subcommittee Meeting and had a robust conversation about community schools, access to libraries, Graduate Profile, Board Priorities, and early childhood education. Meetings are held every first Monday of every month. He announced that he was elected to be meeting chair and added that he looks forward to bringing further conversations. Mr. Bustos congratulated Cesar Chavez High School for their statewide recognition as a model Continuation High School by the California Department of Education and our State Superintendent Tony Thurmond. He also shared that he had the opportunity to go to Heroes Elementary School for their production of Frozen, highlighted student, staff, and the Santa Ana Arts department efforts. Mr. Bustos encouraged everyone to attend the SPED hiring fair, and asked for help in spreading the word to ensure students have what they need. Lastly, he acknowledged Ramadan and gave a shout out to Edison Elementary School for reading books, talking about history and practices, and having a culture of inclusivity. He reminded administrators that some students are observing Ramadan and asked them to find creative spaces during lunch for those who are fasting. Mr. Bustos thanked everyone for a great meeting.

Dr. Alvarez thanked staff for the two presentations. One of the presentations was on the Second Interim, and he thanked staff for keeping track of the money and for making it easy for the community to follow. The second presentation was on Board priorities and metrics, which are important to see how we will succeed and continue to improve.

Ms. Torres expressed gratitude towards various individuals and initiatives, emphasizing the importance of incorporating the Dorothy Mulkey story into the curriculum for educational impact and encouraging everyone to go on walking tours. She acknowledged the contributions of the Vazquez and Castorena families and also recognized that staff members are also observing Ramadan. Ms. Torres highlighted the significance of mental health and ethnic studies in transformative education and encouraged staff to present at a conference. She gave a shout out to Lincoln Elementary School for having a lot of culturally relevant and justice oriented events. She reflected on the changing nature of education, emphasizing the need for innovative approaches, conversations, and reflective spaces for teachers and staff to adapt to these changes. Ms. Torres thanked the Board for their advocacy for equity and justice, with a commitment to support staff. Ms. Torres commemorated International Working Women's Day and concluded with a quote from Emma Tenayuca, "I never thought in terms of fear, I thought in terms of justice".

WHEREAS, Nationwide's contract value increased by Seventy-Two Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-Seven Dollars (\$72,827) due to added scope of work of the new administration building, bringing their revised contract value to Two Million Two Hundred and Ninety Thousand Six Hundred and Thirty-Four Dollars (\$2,132,427); and
