#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent addressed the incident that occurred at Santiago School. He assured our community that we have initiated a formal independent investigation to determine all the facts surrounding this incident and to take all appropriate action necessary. Because this incident involves student conduct matters, we are not able to disclose any specific details. Mr. Almendarez informed everyone that our entire district leadership team is taking this situation very seriously and made it clear that our district will always value our diversity, inclusivity, and will always do everything in our power to support the well-being of every student in our schools. He added that we will always encourage any student, staff member, or parent who believes they have been the target of harassment and discrimination of any kind to safely come forward through our Uniform Complaint Procedure. Information on this process is available on the website of every school and district department, including on <a href="https://www.sausd.us">www.sausd.us</a>.

Superintendent acknowledged International Women's Day which took place last week. This day serves as a reminder of the significant contributions that women have made throughout history and continue to make in all aspects of life. It is also a time to recognize the challenges that women still face in achieving gender equality and to reaffirm our commitment to promoting gender equity in our schools and communities. He added that as educators, it is our responsibility to create safe and inclusive learning environments that empower girls and young women to reach their full potential. International Women's Day offers an opportunity to celebrate the achievements of women and girls around the world. He encourages everyone to take the time to thank a mother, wife, daughter, coworker, community leader, or anyone else who has made a difference in your life.

Mr. Almendarez also recognized March as National School Social Worker Month. He thanked all our amazing SAUSD social workers and all social workers who are community partners serving our student for their valuable service. He shared that school social workers play an important role in our efforts to support our students' academic and social and emotional needs and are among the first to respond to crisis situations and often work to support some of our most vulnerable students.

Superintendent Almendarez shared that we held the first two town hall meetings last month regarding our district budget process. He thanked all the parents, community members, and staff who attended these sessions. A district and Board priority is to engage our community across various topics that involve our school district, and the budget process is one of these important issues. We had a lot of very insightful conversations and heard several questions and some concerns as they relate to our budget. Participants discussed academic achievement, public safety, mental health, staffing ratios, nutrition, and various other subjects as they relate to the budget. We continue to review all the information provided during these sessions, and will do the same as part of our next four town hall meetings in March and April. He invited everyone to take part in the future town hall meetings as we want to keep this important dialogue going. She also acknowledged Ramadan is starting next week and clarified that not all Arab Americans are Muslims and that not all Muslims are Arab American. She asked teachers to be aware that students may be fasting and to be considerate if there will be any celebrations.

#### BOARD REPORTS

Ms. Brazer Aceves thanked the staff for the report presented today. She also thanked the staff at McFadden Institute of Technology and Taft Elementary for inviting her to their Read Across America events. Ms. Brazer Aceves thanked the classified staff who invited her to visit the central kitchen and Josh Goddard, Director of Nutrition Services, for the tour of the facility. It was great to meet staff and to see all the thought and expertise that goes into the meals that are prepared for our students. Additionally, she thanked Eddie Leon and Larry Pita for inviting her to visit sites. She also thanked Ericka Pereira, Principals, administrators, teachers, and students who toured her around campus. Lastly, she recognized National Woman's Day and to all our students, woman who work in our district, grandmas, moms, care takers, and shared about the woman that helped raise her.

Mr. Bustos thanked school site staff who organized the site visits for Read Across America. He shared that he got to read to prekindergarten through eighth grade students. He had the opportunity to share his story and how proud he is to be a product of Santa Ana Unified School District. He was excited to spend International Woman's Day at Century High School during their lunch time at their woman in trades event where they highlight woman in trades. Later that day he was part of the Century Modernization Dedication Ceremony where he toured the campus, visited the spider lab, library, office and the ASB room. Mr. Bustos also shared that he will be joining the ASB leadership tomorrow and would like to check-in with staff who lead those conversations. He invited everyone to attend the next two Budget Town Hall meetings on Monday, March 27 from 9:00 to 10:30 a.m. and the second from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m.. It is a great opportunity for parents, students, and community to engage in conversation about the budget. Mr. Bustos requested a summary of the ESSER funds, how they have been used, and what the balances are on a B2B.

Dr. Alvarez thanked the staff that worked on the budget report. He encouraged everyone to attend the Budget Town Hall meetings on Monday, March 27 from 9:00 to 10:30 a.m. and the second from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. to hear the status of the budget and to give feedback. Dr. Alvarez commented on the parent who spoke on bullying and the emails received. He shared that we have several interventions in place but did ask if they are not working to review to see if there is a need to shift. The District currently works with Project Kinship and Neutral Ground and has been very effective with intermediate and high school students. Lastly, he made a commitment to the Speech and Debate program and asked that we continue to give them the support and resources that are needed to see the students thrive.

Ms. Torres shared that this past Saturday she spoke at Santa Ana College (SAC) Upward Bound with SAC, District students and parents in a really cool space. She emphasized the need for these important programs where students are affirmed and feel they have a purpose. Ms. Torres echoed Dr. Alvarez's comments on Speech and Debate coaches. Ms. Torres shared that we are reaching the Spring slump, when everyone is tired and we see more frustration and more fights. She asked that we all have grace and patience with each other, and that staff be ready to support sites that have issues. She thanked Board Members for visiting sites. Ms. Torres acknowledged the comment of bullying, racism, sexism, and the need to believe people when they say they are experiencing these things. She added that anti blackness exists in all institutions. In order to antiracist we need to acknowledge when it happens and commit to fighting it. Ms. Torres requested that staff ensures that the uniform complaint process is posted every so often. She also requested a B2B on site base protocols for administrators to use when a racialized or racial incident that occurs. She affirmed that these things happen and that we have to be committed to take action. She recognized International Woman's Day and highlighted that the District's Cabinet is comprised of mostly woman. In closing, Ms. Torres shared a quote by Tony Morrison, "When you get these jobs that you have been so brilliantly trained for, just remember that your real job is that if you are free, you need to free somebody else. If you have some power, then your job is to empower somebody else. This is not just a grab-bag candy game."
