#### **BOARD REPORTS**

Dr. Rodriguez shared that this past Friday he participated in the leadership development programs for parents as part of the Santa Ana Early Learning Initiative. These sessions bring programs together from 21 schools. He thanked Ms. Barquin, Ms. Solomon, Ms. Torres, Ms. Orlando, FACE liaisons, and many others. This is a great example of how the District is taking an active role in shaping the curriculum so parents understand the developmental stages at an early age and students are kinder ready. He also thanked Dr. Emily Wolk for providing data at the last session around language and cognitive development, communication, and general knowledge, which really resonated with parents. He acknowledged Ms. Solomon who led a fun activity with a song as well as Dr. Stephanie Soto Lara and Wendi Gomez. Dr. Rodriguez requested the review of Emergency Resolution No. 19/20-3343 - Delegating Authority to take necessary Action to Protect Students and Staff From the Spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19), adopted in March 13, 2020, giving the Superintendent emergency powers which will remain until they are rescinded. He would like to review if in fact we are past COVID and put that resolution to rest.

Ms. Brazer Aceves thanked Superintendent Almendarez for his dedication and leadership. She shared that last Tuesday, she had the opportunity to visit the Nicholas Academic Center (NAC) at Century High School. She thanked the staff members who invited her, Elizabeth, and Dr. Alvarez. It was nice to meet their staff, many have been former SAUSD and NAC students. Ms. Brazer Aceves added that she would love to learn more about it and asked if we can look into possibly expanding NAC throughout the District. She also shared that she attended California School Boards Association's Masters In Governance program and brought back the idea of possibly recognizing a student of the month.

Mr. Bustos recognized International Day of Visibility Friday, March 31. It is a celebration of transgender, non-binary people, their resilience, and an opportunity to raise awareness. He affirmed the existence of transgender and gender non-conforming people in our communities. He requested an update on the Joint School Collaboration Standing Subcommittee meetings between the City of Santa Ana and Santa Ana Unified School District. Mr. Bustos thanked the MacArthur Fundamental Intermediate School parents who spoke today and requested a B2B update on what is being done to support their requests. He shared that he had the opportunity to join the kindergarten students at Santa Ana College for KinderCaminata. It was a great opportunity to be with our students, teachers, and staff. It was also an opportunity to let students know that college is attainable and to hold ourselves accountable.

Dr. Alvarez shared the he attended the ceremony at the Nicholas Academic Center(NAC) to celebrate 66 students that got accepted to different universities. He also went to the NAC on 4th street where another 70 students were celebrated. It was great to see the places that they got accepted to like Cal States and Universities. Dr. Alvarez is also

interested on the possibility of expanding services to other students like the college trips. He also shared that this week was art filled as most of the schools had performances. He also attended Santa Ana High School's (SAHS) dance concert with over 100 students performing, to Valley High School's "Charlie Brown You Are A Good Man", and "Aladdin" at Madison Elementary School. Dr. Alvarez added that he went to SAHS to speak to an ethnic studies class and is in the process of setting up a meeting to discuss topics that were brought up during that meeting. He congratulated SAHS students who are traveling to New York to watch a performance and taking a class. Lastly, he thanked the MacArthur parents who spoke. He added that he has met with Superintendent to ensure students feel safe physically and mentally.

Ms. Torres announced the grade and step of the Associate Superintendent, Chief Business Official's salary as Grade 135 Step 7 at \$252,348 annually. She reiterated some of the Board members requests as follows: preliminary information on student of the month, update on Joint School Collaboration Standing Subcommittee meetings between the City of Santa Ana and Santa Ana Unified School District, and information on the possible expansion of Nicholas Academic Center. Ms. Torres thanked Board members for going to events she can't go to. She reminded the Superintendent and staff of the Boards request for SAUSD to initiate the process of an apology for segregating Mexican students. The anniversary of the court ruling is April 14 but we don't have a Regular Board meeting until the end of April. The goal is to have this done in April. She also reiterated the request for a resolution on banned books and censorship. Ms. Torres invited everyone to the Ethnic Studies Conference Saturday, April 15. She shared that the Land Acknowledgement Committee met and has worked on a draft of the acknowledgement, which will come to the Board soon and added that she is really proud of the work. She acknowledged Ramadan taking place through April 20th and asked everyone to be aware of students and staff fasting. Lastly, she ended her comments with a quote from Cornel West " Never forget that justice is what love looks like in public."

Having no further business come before the Board, President Torres adjourned the meeting at 8:37 p.m.

#### CONTRACT OF EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of March, 2023, the BOARD of EDUCATION of the Santa Ana Unified School District appointed RONALD HACKER, as ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT/CHIEF BUSINESS OFFICIAL ("CBO" or "ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT" or "MR. HACKER"); and

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF EDUCATION and the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT mutually desire to enter into this initial contract of employment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The term of employment shall be from the date of approval by the BOARD OF EDUCATION to and including June 30, 2026. Subject to continuous satisfactory performance, the BOARD OF EDUCATION may extend the term of this Contract of Employment an additional year.
- 2. During the term of employment, MR. HACKER shall satisfactorily perform duties pertaining to the position of ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT, as provided by the job description and as prescribed by the Superintendent.
- 3. Effective his first day of employment, and for the 2023-2024 school year, the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT shall pay ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT on grade 135, Step 7 (\$252,348 annually). Effective the 2024-2025 school year, the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT will be granted one (1) step advancement on the appropriate range of the Extended Management Schedule each July 1 contingent upon continuous satisfactory service within the District, until the maximum of a salary range is reached, and in accordance with AR 4351. Monthly installments shall be payable according to the classified payroll calendar, prorated for any partial service.
- 4. The salary specified in paragraph 3 above may be adjusted in the manner provided in Education Code section 35032. The stated salary may be increased at any time subject to the agreement of the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT and the BOARD OF EDUCATION, with such increase becoming effective from the date of authorization by the BOARD OF EDUCATION.
- 5. The SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT shall pay the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's membership dues in the Association of California

School Administrators (ACSA), the California Association of School Business Officials (CASBO), or a similar professional organization.

- 6. The SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT shall pay the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's membership dues in one Santa Ana-based service organization.
- 7. The ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT may earn and accrue up to 21 days of paid vacation per school year based on his days of service, as calculated by the payroll department of the District. If vacation is not used during the school year in which it was earned and accrued, such unused, earned and accrued vacation shall be carried over to the following school year. However, the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT may not earn or accrue more than 42 unused vacation days. Once this maximum is reached, ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT will cease to earn and accrue any additional vacation until earned and accrued vacation has been used and the number of unused earned and accrued paid vacation days is below the maximum amount.

In the event of termination of employment of the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT, either during the term of this Contract of Employment or at the expiration of the term of this Contract of Employment, he shall be entitled to compensation for any unused, earned and accrued vacation at the salary rate in effect at the termination or expiration of this Contract of Employment.

- 8. ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall earn one day of sick leave per month.
- 9. Consistent with Board Policy 3350, ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred performing authorized services for the District.
- 10. The services rendered by the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall be evaluated annually by the SUPERINTENDENT or designee during the term of this Contract of Employment, at which time the BOARD OF EDUCATION and the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT may mutually agree to extend the duration of this Contract of Employment. If the duration of this Contract of Employment is extended, the services rendered by the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall be annually evaluated

during the extended term of this Contract of Employment. The annual evaluation shall be completed on or about July 30.

11. The ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall be eligible for paid District medical, dental, vision, and life insurance as provided to other Cabinet members. In the event the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT elects not to participate in the District medical, dental, and vision benefit plans, he may elect to receive the annual cash value equal to the District contribution for medical (two-party tier rate), dental, and vision plans offered for which he is eligible. This option may continue in retirement through age 65 pursuant to applicable Board Policy and Administrative regulations. This compensation, if elected, shall be reviewed and changed each benefit year of the term of this Contract of Employment to reflect the then-current District contributions for the benefit plan year as the cost of the benefits adjust in the new benefit plan year.

These health and welfare benefits are subject to change or modification, and may be increased, reduced, or taken away, at the sole discretion of the BOARD OF EDUCATION, during the term of this Contract of Employment, so long as all other members of the Superintendent's Cabinet are subject to the same changes and/or modifications.

Upon termination or expiration of this Contract of Employment concurrently with retirement under the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS), the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall have the option to continue receiving then-current medical, dental, and vision pursuant to AR 4117.15.

12. The BOARD OF EDUCATION may, at any time, terminate this Contract of Employment at its sole discretion upon 90 days' written notice to the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT. If the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's employment is terminated pursuant to this subsection, and the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT is not in breach of this Contract of Employment, the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT may receive an amount not to exceed the monthly salary of the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT, multiplied by the number of months left on the unexpired term of this Contract of Employment or 12 months, whichever is less, as provided in Government Code section 53260. Except as provided in paragraph 11 hereof, any continuation of ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's health and welfare benefits following such termination may not exceed the number of months remaining on the unexpired term of this

Contract of Employment, up to a maximum of 12 months, or until ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT finds other employment, whichever occurs first.

- 13. Acceptance of the payment described in paragraph 12 of this Contract of Employment fully and forever releases the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT. its employees, officers, and agents, the BOARD OF EDUCATION, and each member of the BOARD OF EDUCATION from all claims, demands, causes of action, charges and grievances, of whatever kind or nature, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, which ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT now owns or holds or has at any time before this date owned or held against any of them, including, but not limited to, all claims, charges, demands and causes of action (a) which arise out of or are in any way connected with ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's employment or the termination of employment; (b) which are related to or concern discrimination under local, state or federal law (including but not limited to, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act), wrongful termination in violation of public policy, retaliation, intentional and negligent infliction of emotional distress, defamation and other torts; or (c) which arise out of or are in any way connected with any loss, damage or injury whatsoever resulting from any act committed or omission made prior to the date of this Contract of Employment.
- 14. This Contract of Employment may be terminated for cause at any time during the school year in accordance with Board Policy and/or statutory provisions that apply to any classified employee. For purposes of this Contract of Employment, "cause" includes any material breach of this Contract of Employment, any failure of the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT to perform the duties prescribed for the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT by the Superintendent or the BOARD OF EDUCATION, or any of the grounds enumerated in Administrative Regulation 4218. The BOARD OF EDUCATION shall not terminate this Contract of Employment under this subsection until a written statement of the grounds for termination has first been given to the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT by the Superintendent. The ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall then be entitled to an informal conference with the BOARD OF EDUCATION, in closed session, at which time the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall be given a reasonable opportunity to address the specific concerns and issues of the BOARD OF EDUCATION and the Superintendent. The ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall have

the right, at his own expense, to have a representative of his choice at the conference with the BOARD OF EDUCATION. If no resolution of these concerns and issues can be found, the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall be provided with a written statement of the BOARD OF EDUCATION's decision with respect to the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's termination. If this Contract of Employment is terminated pursuant to this subsection, the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT's employment with the District, and any compensation, benefits or allowances provided pursuant to this Contract of Employment, shall terminate with the effective date of the decision of the BOARD OF EDUCATION, and the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall not be entitled to any further compensation thereafter, regardless of the term then remaining under this Contract of Employment.

- 15. The ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT shall return all SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT property and equipment to the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT upon termination of this Contract of Employment.
- 16. The terms of this Contract of Employment are made for the benefit of each person or entity named in paragraph 13 above. It is the intention of the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT that this Contract of Employment shall be effective as a bar against each and every claim, demand, cause of action, charge or grievance described in paragraph 13 above. In furtherance of this intention, the ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT expressly waives any and all rights and benefits conferred upon him by the provisions of section 1542 of the California Civil Code, which states:

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of the executing the release, which if known by him or her must have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor."

This clause would prevent any other action in law or in equity against the District as a result of the Board's determination to terminate the contract without cause and pay the liquidated damages.

CONTRACT OF EMPLOYMENT – Page 6 Associate Superintendent/Chief Business Official (CBO)

Pursuant to Government Code section 53243.2, any funds received by the ASSOCIATE

SUPERINTENDENT from the District as a cash settlement resulting from the termination

of this Agreement or successor agreements shall be fully reimbursed to the District if the

ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT is convicted of a crime involving the abuse of his

office or position.

17. If any term or provision of this Contract of Employment is held to be invalid

or unenforceable, the remaining portions of this Contract of Employment shall continue to

be valid and shall be performed, construed and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by

law, and the invalid or unenforceable term shall be deemed amended and limited in

accordance with the intent of the parties, as determined from the face of this Contract of

Employment, to the extent necessary to permit the maximum enforceability or validation of

the term or provision.

18. This Contract of Employment may be amended or modified only pursuant to

a writing signed by both parties, unless otherwise stated in this Contract of Employment.

19. This Contract of Employment constitutes and contains the entire agreement

and understanding between the parties and supersedes and replaces all prior negotiations

and agreements proposed or otherwise, whether written or oral, concerning the subject

matter of this Contract of Employment. This is an integrated document.

20. This Contract of Employment is subject to, is governed by, and shall be

construed under all applicable laws of the State of California, rules and regulations of the

State Board of Education, and rules, regulations and policies of the Board, all of which are

made a part of the terms and conditions of this Contract of Employment as though set forth

herein.
