SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez shared that SAUSD has reached an important milestone in efforts to return to normalcy after two years of this pandemic. Beginning next Monday, March 14, the masking policy in SAUSD will shift from required to highly recommended. This will align SAUSD with the latest guidance from the California Department of Public Health and with the other districts across Orange County. This decision was made in consultation with local health care experts, and after reviewing the latest data that shows COVID positivity rates significantly falling in our community for several consecutive weeks. It is important to note that families and staff may choose to continue to mask as recommended by the state, and all SAUSD sites will continue providing masks upon request. Also, SAUSD will continue providing weekly testing for all students and staff at every site. The district will also continue to offer free community testing opportunities Monday through Saturday at various locations. Please visit www.sausd.us for more information on community testing clinics.

Mr. Almendarez shared that this past Saturday, he had the opportunity to participate in the annual Boca de Oro festival in Downtown Santa Ana. It was incredibly inspiring to see SAUSD student artists, dancers, singers, poets, and other talented performers. He thanked all of the students for their hard work and dedication in preparation for this event. He also thanked staff members who worked countless hours to support student artists and performers. In addition, he thanked Robyn MacNair, SAUSD's Visual and Performing Arts Coordinator and her team for helping co-organize this amazing event each year. Superintendent announced that March is National Women's History Month, and today March 8, is International Women's Day. SAUSD is proud to honor and recognize all women who fought, and continue to fight, for equality among all races and genders. The District is represented by countless of these women now and across our rich history. Today's women and girls can stand on the shoulders of the heroines who came before them to continue the mission of ensuring our daughters have the same opportunities as our sons. He encouraged everyone to take time this month and reflect on a woman who has impacted your life, or has served as an inspiration to you. He added that this week March 6 through the 12, is also National School Social Worker Week. He thanked all SAUSD social workers and social workers who are community partners serving our students, for their valuable service. School social workers play an important role in our efforts to support students' academic and social and emotional needs. Social workers are among the first to respond to crisis situations and often work to support some of our most vulnerable students. Lastly, Superintendent announced that the Native American Indian Parent Advisory Committee will be holding their first meeting on Thursday, March 10, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

BOARD REPORTS

Mr. Palacio shared that last week he went to Fremont Elementary to read to a 2nd grade class and that a 5th grade class read *The Wild Robot* to him. He also went to Franklin Elementary and added that kids love story time and that he enjoyed conversing with them. Mr. Palacio shared that the Santa Ana Lions Club worked with the Tustin Lions Club during the weekend and served approximately 400 families with glasses. It takes about an hour and a half to serve each student. He shared the experience of a kindergarten student that was thankful for his glasses. The Lions Club work under the leadership the President Cesar Vargas, has been tremendous and thanked him for it. Mr. Palacio also shared that he got to see a play at Santiago "Frozen" along with Mrs. Amezcua and Dr. Rodriguez. It was very special not just because of the students in the play but all the studio work, background, and stage set up. It was done by students. It was very well attended with an approximately 1200 in attendance.

Ms. Torres commented on the mask changes and shared her concern as she will also be returning to a class where masking will be optional. Ms. Torres hopes that the District is ready to respond for a spike in cases. In honor of International Woman's Day, Ms. Torres shared quotes by Audre Lorde, an American writer, who was a self-described black, feminist, lesbian, librarian, and civil rights activist. She also recognized the Executive Cabinet members who are mostly woman and thanked them for their hard work. She added that as we honor woman for the work they have done, it cannot be done without trying to change the systems that make it so difficult like housing, healthcare, childcare and environmental issues and shared a personal experience.


Dr. Rodriguez shared that he also read the book *The Wild Robot and is* so glad that the district is promoting a culture of reading. He added that kindergartners are his favorite group. He also shared that he went to see Frozen with Board members Palacio and Amezcua. There is another show in six weeks with the middle school students. The students were literally on Broadway, it was so powerful just like with Boca de Oro. When you see the affect that art has on students, we have to look at the graduate profile around is very interested in the early childcare and education component. Lastly, he commented the invasion on Ukrain.


