Santa Ana Board of Education

Tuesday, April 23, 2024

1. CALL TO ORDER

Board President called the meeting to order at 5:08 p.m.

Other members present were Mr. Bustos, Ms. Brazer Aceves, and Dr. Rodriguez.

### 8. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez shared that the Public Schools Foundation recently awarded nearly \$40,000 in scholarships to 31 graduating SAUSD seniors. These awards will help our student recipients realize their dream of attending college with additional financial support. He thanked the Foundation for building this scholarship program to assist our students in their academic careers and for all the other work its members do to support our entire District. Mr. Almendarez announced that tomorrow is also National Administrative Professionals Day. He thanked all of the amazing administrative professionals in SAUSD. He shared that our administrative professionals are often the first point of contact between our schools and District offices and our community members. Their roles and responsibilities can vary considerably from day to day, but their value to our District is immeasurable. He encouraged everyone to take time tomorrow to thank an administrative professional who has provided support. This week is also Afterschool Professionals Appreciation Week. Afterschool professionals play an important role in supporting our schools and community with enrichment programs outside normal school hours. Throughout the week, our schools are finding fun and unique ways to honor our after-school staff. Our staff is collecting many messages of gratitude from District and site leadership, community partners, and families. These messages will be shared throughout the week on social media and directly with our staff to publicly acknowledge their dedication and impact. He thanked all our afterschool professionals for their dedication to our SAUSD community.

Superintendent Almendarez shared that he had the honor of participating in a ceremony to celebrate Adriana Huevo Ayala with Board Member Bustos last week, as she received the prestigious Arthur S. Marmaduke High School Counselor Award. Ms. Huevo Ayala serves as the higher education coordinator for Segerstrom High School. Over the last two decades, she has had a profound impact on the lives of countless students, ensuring

they find a path to college. Ms. Huezo Ayala has made the college admissions process clear and accessible. He added that she truly embodies the spirit of our District Graduate Profile and congratulated Ms. Huezo Ayala for everything she has done and continues to do for our community. Next, he congratulated Dr. Rebecca Pianta, SAUSD Coordinator of College and Career Readiness, and Dr. Atikah Osman, Assistant Principal at Saddleback High School, for being named Administrators of the Year by the Association of California School Administrators. Both Dr. Pianta and Dr. Osman were recognized for their exemplary work to improve learning outcomes for all students. These two individuals are renowned across the region for their professionalism, and their dedication to a more inclusive and equitable educational model that allows for all students to find paths to college and careers. He congratulated both of them for their commitment to our students, schools, and community. Mr. Almendarez congratulated 17 SAUSD students who recently excelled at the California High School Speech Association State Championships in Clovis, CA. Three students ranked in the Top 10 Statewide, with seven more ranking in the Top 25. Remarkably, all our students placed in the Top 55 in their events, underscoring our District's depth of talent. Santa Ana High senior Fernanda Meza claimed the #1 spot in Dramatic Interpretation. He congratulated all participants for their outstanding achievements.

Mr. Almendarez acknowledged and honored Cambodian Heritage Month, observed in April. This month, we celebrate Cambodia's rich cultural tapestry and the resilience of its people. From vibrant traditions to captivating arts and delicious cuisine, Cambodian heritage enriches our community in countless ways. Together, we embrace diversity and strengthen our inclusive community. Lastly, the Superintendent discussed the current round of negotiations, acknowledging the progress made in improving conditions for educators over the past five years. The District has offered highly competitive salary increases, ranking highest in aggregate salary increase among Orange County School Districts from 2019 to 2023, with a total increase of 17.75%. This achievement underscores the community's dedication to academic excellence and the value placed on educators. He emphasized the District's commitment to competitive compensation as a token of appreciation for all district employees.

15. BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez attended the Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation scholarship event where he encountered remarkable students and families. The focus was on recognizing difference-makers and the importance of student scholarships. The experience left you inspired and motivated, affirming the value of the work being done. He expressed gratitude to everyone involved in creating a space for celebration. Additionally, he posed the question around the vision for the promotion of neurodiversity and inclusion for all.

Ms. Brazer Aceves provided a summary of a recent event held on April 11th, which featured Supervisor Sarmiento and Council Member Thai Viet Phan at Valley High School. She expressed gratitude to Principal Berger, Assistant Principal Howell, and the FACE team for their contributions. The event drew over 800 attendees and they distributed over 500 food boxes, along with offering health and dental exams. Ms. Brazer Aceves highlighted the commitment of Director Ann Tran, a Saddleback High School alumnus, to assist families with medical enrollment and to expand the partnership. She also discussed metrics and emphasized the importance of addressing barriers to better serve the community. Ms. Brazer Aceves also mentioned resources brought from the PAC and SPED conferences, focusing on understanding neurodiversity, particularly autism. She concluded with a request to close the meeting in memory of Anthony Garcia whose memorial was held the previous week.

Mr. Bustos expressed gratitude towards public speakers, acknowledging their impactful contributions. He highlighted the recent Career Day events at Lowell, Pio Pico, and Jefferson Elementary Schools, thanking community members for sharing their career insights. Additionally, he extended invitations to the LGBTQ convening and the Pride Parade at Valley High School, emphasizing the celebration of resources and allies. Mr. Bustos also mentioned the ongoing ASB round table discussions aimed at building student skills, with appreciation for the team's efforts. He specifically recognized Adriana Huevo Ayala, for receiving the Arthur S. Marmaduke High School Counselor Award and for her invaluable support. Lastly, Mr. Bustos encouraged students to apply for Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation scholarships and congratulated Brandy Figueroa on her impressive college acceptances.

Dr. Alvarez highlighted his participation in the CSBA Coast2Coast Federal Advocacy Trip in Washington D.C., meeting with Delegates, visiting legislators, including the Deputy Secretary of Education and a former Principal from San Diego Cindy Marten. He emphasized the valuable speakers encountered during these interactions. Additionally, Dr. Alvarez mentioned the Willard Jazz Ensemble who performed at the 2024 Turnaround Arts Student Showcase in Washington D.C. on April 7, 2024, underscoring the importance of strengthening the connection between arts and education. He also shared that he attended the Carver Elementary School Open House, expressing admiration for the turnout of parents and students, and the impressive resources like 3D printers and lasers in classrooms. Furthermore, Dr. Alvarez acknowledged

attendance at the New Works Festival at Santa Ana High School, where students wrote, directed, and performed plays. Lastly, a shoutout was given to the Speech and Debate team, specifically highlighting Fernanda Meza's seven-year involvement in the program.


Ms. Torres began by acknowledging public speakers, particularly those from the community and staff members, whose comments resonated with her. She emphasized the importance of understanding the budgetary numbers and encouraged attendance at budget meetings for clarification. She also clarified that she was a substitute in Anaheim, Santa Ana, Garden Grove, and Long Beach Unified 15-20 years ago and is currently a teacher and a CTA member. Ms. Torres proposed changes to Board meeting time to 6:30 p.m. and asked for the Board recognition dates. She reiterated Board members' requests for updates on neurodiversity initiatives, the larger role for Medi-Cal in providing services, with specifics to be included in the B2B summary.



5 A Resolution Denouncing Hate Crimes and Bigotry Targeting Asian Americans and Pacific  
6 Islanders

7  
8 WHEREAS, The Asian Pacific Policy and Planning Council and Chinese for  
9 Affirmative Action launched a hate incident-reporting internet website, titled "Stop  
10 AAPI Hate," at the beginning of the COVID-19 outbreak in March of 2020, which  
11 documented over 2,800 hate incidents against Asian-American Pacific Islanders (AAPI)  
12 in 2020; and

13 WHEREAS, On January 30, 2021, 84-year-old Vicha Ratanapakdee, a nearly blind  
14 and gentle elderly Thai man, died from injuries resulting from an attack while he was  
15 walking in the City of San Francisco, in what is deemed as a hate crime; and

16 WHEREAS, On March 16, 2021, eight people (six being Asian, two white, all but  
17 one being women) were gunned down by a white man in Atlanta, Georgia;

18 WHEREAS, These reports depict a disturbing reality, especially for Asian women,  
19 who experienced violence nearly 2.5 times more than their male counterparts. However,  
20 the numbers do not tell the full story: They don't include many of the unreported and  
21 increasingly normalized incidents of violence; and

22 WHEREAS, Racism and anti-AAPI sentiments has been exacerbated by the COVID-19  
23 pandemic and politically charged and culturally insensitive rhetoric referring to  
24 COVID-19 as the "Chinese virus" or "kung flu" further encourages racism, prejudice,  
25 and hate crimes against AAPIs; and

26 WHEREAS, Racism toward AAPIs has always existed ever since AAPIs began  
27 immigrating to the United States, such as the 19th-century scapegoating of AAPIs,  
28 also known as the "Yellow Peril," as well as the 21st-century scapegoating of AAPIs

for the COVID-19 pandemic. These examples are painful, but they are also part of a larger, and often dismissed, history of violence. In addition to the Chinese Exclusion Act of 1882, the assaults against Filipino farmworkers in the 1930s by white mobs, and the Japanese internment camps of the 1940s, there's a longstanding history of racialized colonial wars that have shaped AAPI communities' histories before AAPIs even arrived in the United States; and

WHEREAS, The recent rise of violence against Asian Americans is part of a larger history of violence against communities of color, we must work together to create community centered solutions that stop the violence in all communities; and

WHEREAS, The model minority myth continues to divide communities of color, feed into racism, and contributes to the false notion that the AAPI community does not experience racial oppression or is impacted by white supremacy, which ignores the AAPI community's experience with islamophobia, anti-Arab racism, and anti-South Asian violence, especially post 9/11; and;

WHEREAS, The model minority myth also creates the stereotype that the AAPI community is a monolithic group, a stereotype that invisibilizes the economic, academic and social struggles of our diverse communities (i.e. Native Hawaiians, Pacific Islanders, Southeast Asians, Arab-Americans, mixed-race Asians/Hapas, undocumented Asians, Hmong students, etc.), which is why this resolution also forcefully condemns the ideology of the model minority myth and dispels it due to its role in hindering solidarity amongst communities of color; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education remains committed to an Ethnic Studies program that highlights AAPI histories (along with Black, Latinx/Chicanx and Native/Indigenous histories) so as to combat the anti-AAPI racism being experienced by many AAPIs in our state and county; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education stands with the Asian-American and Pacific Islander community and wishes to affirm its commitment to the safety and wellbeing of Asian American students, staff and community members

and ensure they know they are not alone and that they can speak out to help stop the spread of bigotry; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education calls on all residents and leaders to join us in condemning racist attacks against Asian Americans in all forms, and renewing our commitment to speak out against such attacks, defend and protect those targeted, and seek justice and accountability against those who commit hate crimes against AAPI members of our community; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education denounces hate crimes, hateful rhetoric, and hateful acts against Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders, and works to ensure that AAPI students feel safe and welcome, both during this COVID-19 pandemic and beyond.





WHEREAS, children, youth, and adults can recover from mental illness and lead full, productive lives in the community; and

prevention, mental wellness, and support prevention efforts; and

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


