SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Deputy Superintendent Perez provided the Superintendent's report in his absence. Dr. Perez announced that The Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation recently awarded \$52,000 in scholarships to forty-six graduating SAUSD seniors. She added that it was a beautiful event at Saddleback High School, thanked The Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation, and congratulated the students. Dr. Perez highlighted the budget town hall meetings. Last week, we hosted the final in a series of town hall meetings regarding our district budget process where many parents participated. She shared that there were more than three hundred questions from the community, and we are busily getting the answers to those questions. Staff will come back to share those answers with the community. Dr. Perez thanked the Board for giving the direction and to all the community for coming out to share their voice. Dr. Perez also shared that a couple of weeks ago we hosted an Ethnic Studies Conference which was well attended. 



5 A Resolution Denouncing Hate Crimes and Bigotry Targeting Asian Americans and Pacific
6 Islanders

7
8 WHEREAS, The Asian Pacific Policy and Planning Council and Chinese for
9 Affirmative Action launched a hate incident-reporting internet website, titled "Stop
10 AAPI Hate," at the beginning of the COVID-19 outbreak in March of 2020, which
11 documented over 2,800 hate incidents against Asian-American Pacific Islanders (AAPI)
12 in 2020; and

13 WHEREAS, On January 30, 2021, 84-year-old Vicha Ratanapakdee, a nearly-blind
14 and gentle elderly Thai man, died from injuries resulting from an attack while he was
15 walking in the City of San Francisco, in what is deemed as a hate crime; and

16 WHEREAS, On March 16, 2021, eight people (six being Asian, two white, all but
17 one being women) were gunned down by a white man in Atlanta, Georgia;

18 WHEREAS, These reports depict a disturbing reality, especially for Asian women,
19 who experienced violence nearly 2.5 times more than their male counterparts. However,
20 the numbers do not tell the full story: They don't include many of the unreported and
21 increasingly normalized incidents of violence; and

22 WHEREAS, Racism and anti-AAPI sentiments has been exacerbated by the COVID-19
23 pandemic and politically charged and culturally insensitive rhetoric referring to
24 COVID-19 as the "Chinese virus" or "kung flu" further encourages racism, prejudice,
25 and hate crimes against AAPIs; and

26 WHEREAS, Racism toward AAPIs has always existed ever since AAPIs began
27 immigrating to the United States, such as the 19th-century scapegoating of AAPIs,
28 also known as the "Yellow Peril," as well as the 21st-century scapegoating of AAPIs

29 for the COVID-19 pandemic. These examples are painful, but they are also part of a
30 larger, and often dismissed, history of violence. In addition to the Chinese Exclusion
31 Act of 1882, the assaults against Filipino farmworkers in the 1930s by white mobs,
32 and the Japanese internment camps of the 1940s, there's a longstanding history of
33 racialized colonial wars that have shaped AAPI communities' histories before AAPIs
34 even arrived to the United States; and

35 WHEREAS, The recent rise of violence against Asian Americans is part of a larger
36 history of violence against communities of color, we must work together to create
37 community centered solutions that stop the violence in all communities; and

38 WHEREAS, The model minority myth continues to divide communities of color, feed
39 into racism, and contributes to the false notion that the AAPI community does not
40 experience racial oppression or is impacted by white supremacy, which ignores the
41 AAPI community's experience with islamophobia, anti-Arab racism, and anti-South Asian
42 violence, especially post 9/11; and;

43 WHEREAS, The model minority myth also creates the stereotype that the AAPI
44 community is a monolithic group, a stereotype that invisibilizes the economic,
45 academic and social struggles of our diverse communities (i.e. Native Hawaiians,
46 Pacific Islanders, Southeast Asians, Arab-Americans, mixed-race Asians/Hapas,
47 undocumented Asians, Hmong students, etc.), which is why this resolution also
48 forcefully condemns the ideology of the model minority myth and dispels it due to its
49 role in hindering solidarity amongst communities of color; and

50 WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education remains
51 committed to an Ethnic Studies program that highlights AAPI histories (along with
52 Black, Latinx/Chicanx and Native/Indigenous histories) so as to combat the anti-AAPI
53 racism being experienced by many AAPIs in our state and county; and

54 WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education stands with
55 the Asian-American and Pacific Islander community and wishes to affirm its commitment
56 to the safety and wellbeing of Asian American students, staff and community members

and ensure they know they are not alone and that they can speak out to help stop the spread of bigotry; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education calls on all residents and leaders to join us in condemning racist attacks against Asian Americans in all forms, and renewing our commitment to speak out against such attacks, defend and protect those targeted, and seek justice and accountability against those who commit hate crimes against AAPI members of our community; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education denounces hate crimes, hateful rhetoric, and hateful acts against Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders, and works to ensure that AAPI students feel safe and welcome, both during this COVID-19 pandemic and beyond.



Resolution Granting Easement to the City of Santa Ana for Fire Access to the Water
Tower Located at 1415 French Street

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District ("District") is selling a portion of certain real property located at 1415 French Street, in Santa Ana, CA (APN: 398-151-01) ("Property") to the City of Santa Ana ("City") for the City's water system equipment ("Water Tower"). The City requires an approximately 1,151 square foot easement ("Proposed Easement") for fire access to the Water Tower, and is depicted in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17556, the District may grant an easement to the state or any political subdivision or municipal corporation thereof, for public street or highway purposes, pursuant to Education Code section 17556. Here, the Proposed Easement will allow public street access to the Water Tower, including for fire access and other public safety considerations; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2022, the Board adopted Resolution No. 22/23-3489 entitled "Resolution of Intention to Grant Easement to the City of Santa Ana for Fire Access to the Water Tower Located at 1415 French Street" ("Resolution of Intention"); and

WHEREAS, by April 14, 2023, staff gave public notice of the public hearing by posting signed copies of the Resolution of Intention in three public places in the District and on the District's website, and by publishing notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the District by April 20, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2023, the District held a public hearing regarding adopting this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Easement Agreement is attached as Exhibit "A" and may be subject to additional revisions recommended by the District's legal counsel that will not change the intent of the agreement or this Resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that based upon the whole record of proceedings, the Santa Unified School District Board of Education ("Board") hereby finds, determines and orders as follows:

A. That the above recitals are true and correct.

B. The grant of the Proposed Easement would be in the best interests of the District because it would assist the City with fire access to the Water Tower.

C. The Superintendent, or designee, is hereby further authorized to perform all actions and execute all documents necessary to carry out the intent of the Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was considered, passed, and adopted by the Board at the District's regular Board meeting of April 25, 2023.



EASEMENT DEED AND AGREEMENT

1405 French Street, in Santa Ana, CA ("Property"), APN: 398-151-01

FOR A VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged,

SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, a California public school district,
("Grantor"),

hereby **GRANTS AND CONVEYS** to the

CITY OF SANTA ANA, a charter city and municipal corporation organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the state of California (the "Grantee"), and its successors and assigns,

a non-exclusive easement and right-of-way to install, construct, reconstruct, remove and replace, inspect, and maintain a roadway, including without limitation adjacent tree abatement and removal where necessary in, on, along, and under the above-referenced real property situated in the City of Santa Ana, County of Orange, State of California (collectively, the "Easement Area"), and ingress to and egress from the Easement Area from the closest public right-of-way, all more particularly described in **Exhibit "A"** and shown in **Exhibit "B,"** which exhibits are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The term of this Easement shall continue for as long as Grantee operates the Easement Area for purposes of access to and from the City's water system equipment ("Water Tower") or general access to the Property. The rights being granted herein include without limitation the right to enter upon and to pass and repass over and along the Easement Area, by Grantee.

It is understood and agreed by Grantor and Grantee (collectively, the "Parties") and their successors and assigns that the rights granted herein are subject to and limited by the following:

Reservation: The easement and right-of-way granted herein are subject to the rights of Grantor, its successors, and assigns to use the surface of the land within the boundaries of the Easement Area in

any and all ways not inconsistent with the non-exclusive rights granted hereby; provided, however, that no improvements shall be constructed, placed, or permitted within, upon, under, or above the Easement Area until such construction and/or maintenance plans have first been approved in writing by Grantee and any applicable permits have been obtained from Grantee after payment of normal processing fees. Grantor agrees that it shall not grant any surface, subsurface, or aerial rights in the Easement Area as will unreasonably interfere with or prohibit the use by Grantee of the rights and Easement granted herein. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Easement Deed and Agreement, Grantee hereby accepts the Easement Area "as is" withal faults known and unknown, and Grantor makes no representation or warranty (either express or implied) as to the suitability of the Easement Area for Grantee's use.

Maintenance/Repairs: The Grantee shall, at its sole cost and expense, be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the Easement Area and shall maintain the Easement Area in a good state of repair.

Grantee accepts the Easement "AS IS" with no representation as to the condition of the Easement Area. Under no circumstances shall Grantor be liable for any conditions of the Easement Area, whether observable or not. Grantor makes no expressed or implied representation on the suitability of Easement Area for Grantee's purposes. Grantee is solely responsible for determining whether the conditions of the Easement Area are suitable for its purposes.

Grantor also grants to Grantee, its successors, and assigns, and its and their contractors, agents, and employees the right to trim such trees and other foliage and to cut such limbs and roots on said Property as may be necessary for the protection of said Easement Area upon written approval by the District, and the right to clear and keep the Easement Area free from explosives, buildings, equipment, brush, combustible material and any and all other obstructions of any kind which may endanger said Easement Area or any part thereof or interfere with the exercise of the rights herein granted.

Grantee hereby agrees to refrain from expanding, altering, replacing, or reconstructing the Easement Area in any way which would create an unreasonable risk to the Property or its occupants.

Compliance With Laws.

Grantor has complied with all Education Code requirements to convey the Easement to the Grantee and does not require the Easement for classroom purposes.

Grantee shall at Grantee's expense comply with all requirements of all governmental authorities, in force either now or in the future, affecting the Property, the Easement Area and Grantee's use thereof, and shall faithfully observe all laws, regulations and ordinances of these authorities, in force either now or in the future including, without limitation, all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations, and ordinances.

Indemnification.

Except to the extent the claims arise out of, pertain to, or relate to the gross negligence, recklessness, or willful misconduct of the Grantor, its agents, contractors or employees, Grantee agrees to defend, protect, indemnify, release, and forever hold harmless Grantor and its agents, employees, officers, trustees, members, directors, and all those acting on behalf of Grantor, to the

maximum extent possible under law, from and against any and all assessments, claims, counts, costs, damages, demands, expenses, fines, judgments, liabilities (legal, administrative, or otherwise), losses, notices, penalties, suits (legal or in equity), violations, and/or attorneys' and consultants' fees arising out of, or in connection with, Grantee's (including but not limited to its agents, contractors, consultants, employees, and all others acting on behalf of Grantee) entry upon or condition of the Easement Area or entitlement, use, design, construction, placement, operation, maintenance, repair, reconstruction, or replacement of the improvements on the Easement Area. The defense and indemnification, costs, damages to persons or property, penalties, obligations set forth herein shall survive the expiration, termination, or reversion of this Easement.

Insurance: The City represents that, as a charter city and municipal corporation, it is self-insured against damages, injury and other forms of liability.

Notices: Any notice, payment or instrument required or permitted to be given or delivered by this Easement may be given or delivered by personal delivery or by depositing the same in any United States mail depository, first class postage prepaid, and addressed as follows:

or such other person or address as either party may direct in writing to the other, provided, however, that such new or different person or address shall not become effective until acknowledged in writing by the party to whom directed. Except where service is by personal delivery or by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, service of any instrument or writing shall be deemed completed forty-eight (48) hours after deposit in a United States mail depository.

Warranty of Authority: Each officer of Grantor and Grantee affixing his or her signature to this Easement warrants and represents by such signature that he or she has the full legal authority to bind his or her respective party to all of the terms, conditions, and provisions therein, that his or her respective party has the full legal right, power, capacity, and authority to enter into this Easement and perform all of its provisions and obligations, and that no other approvals or consents are necessary in connection therewith.

Headings: The titles and headings of Sections and Paragraphs of this Easement, as herein set forth, have been inserted for the sake of convenience only, and are not to be taken, deemed or construed to be any part of the terms, covenants or conditions of this Easement, or to control, limit or modify any of the terms, covenants or conditions hereof.

Integration, Construction and Amendment: This Easement contains the entire understanding of the Parties and supersedes any and all other written or oral understandings as to those matters contained therein, and no prior oral or written understanding shall be of any force or effect with respect to those matters covered thereby. This Easement shall be construed and interpreted with and shall be governed and enforced in all respects according to, the laws of the State of California and as if drafted by both Grantor and Grantee. No amendment, change, or modification of this document shall be valid unless in writing, stating that it amends, changes or modifies this Easement, signed by all of the Parties.

Successors: This easement and the provisions contained herein shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of Grantor, Grantee, and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

Partial Invalidity: If any term, covenant, condition, or provision of this Easement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, illegal, or unenforceable, the remainder of the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way affect, impair, or invalidate any other terms, covenant, condition, or provision contained in this Easement.

Further Assurances: Each of the Parties shall execute and deliver any and all additional papers, documents, and other assurances and shall do any and all acts and things reasonably necessary in connection with the performance of their obligations hereunder and to carry out the intent of the Parties.

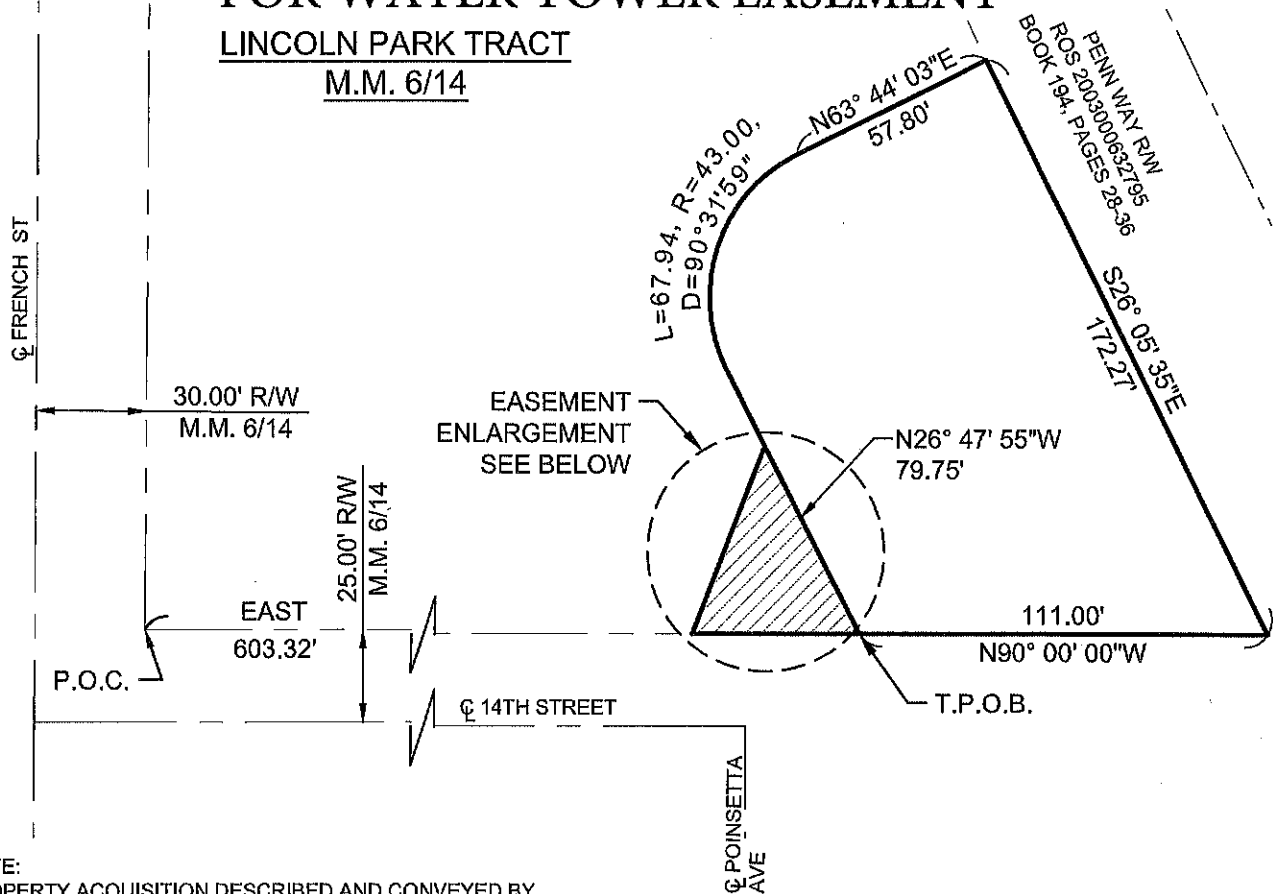

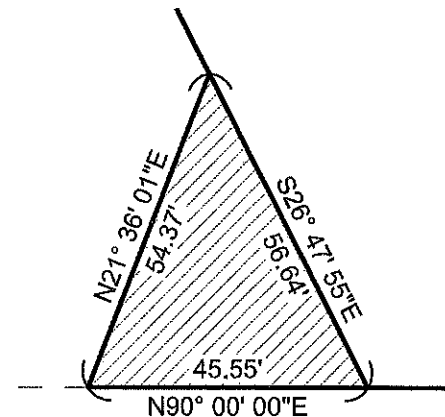
