SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent took the opportunity to acknowledge the wonderful SAUSD moms as part of Mother's Day. He expressed his gratitude for all the mothers who help in our schools and who also create a supportive learning environment at home for our students. Mr. Almendarez announced that the month of May is designated as the recognition month for several school employee groups. Last week was teacher and certificated support staff appreciation week. He thanked all teachers who continue to show up daily to educate our students despite the unprecedented challenges we continue to see. Our teachers ensure at the ground level that our students receive both academic and social-emotional support. Teaching is not only a career for our educators, but they show time, and time again that it is also their passion. He also thanked other certificated support staff, who offer other invaluable services such as counseling, speech and language services, administrative leadership, and play many other vital roles and added that last week was also Principal's Recognition Day. Principals work countless hours often filling in across various roles at their schools. They guide our teachers and staff, creating productive learning environments for our children. Whether they lead an elementary, middle, or high school, our principals often serve as ambassadors for our communities.

Superintendent also announced that this week is National School Nurses Week. The role of our school nurses has never been as prominent as it has been the last two years during this pandemic. SAUSD school nurses and licensed vocational nurses (LVNs) serve as a frontline safety net for the most vulnerable students, many of whom may not have access to health care. School nurses and LVNs identify vision, hearing, and other health issues in students that often impede school performance. Mr. Almendarez shared that SAUSD is also observing National Police Week from May 11 to May 17. He recognized Santa Ana School Police officers for their work to keep our students, staff, and community safe. Additionally, officers work in partnership with schools to support awareness campaigns targeting drug and alcohol, bullying and cyberbullying, and vaping prevention. School police contribute to safe and nurturing learning environments at our campuses. He continued by announcing that next week is also Classified School Employee Week.

Over the last two years of this pandemic, classified employees have served as essential workers across the community. They have ensured our students receive nutritious meals every day, kept our campuses and other district sites healthy and safe, supported instruction by assisting in providing technology, supporting teachers in classrooms, and helping schools connect with the community.

Finally, Superintendent thanked all school employee groups for everything they do to keep schools open, to support learning, and to help meet the diverse needs of the SAUSD community. He encouraged everyone to reach out to any school employee this month to offer gratitude for their ongoing commitment to education.

BOARD REPORTS

Mrs. Amezcua thanked the parents that attended the meeting to talk about GRIP and also thanked the students for speaking on their leadership camp and asked that we take care of funding for that. She commented on the GRIP MOU and referenced other MOUs approved for money at the request of a member of the public. She thanked Josh Goddard Orin Williams for looking into the ADA accommodations at MacArthur Fundamental Intermediate School and shared that they will both be at the school site tomorrow. Mrs. Amezcua requested that Superintendent share the plan with the community on how we are going to address declining enrollment and asked Superintendent if community meetings will be held. Superintendent Almendarez stated that there would be community meetings and that he is also planning a facilities meeting. Mrs. Amezcua went on to thank everyone who attended Difference Makers luncheon and congratulated all the students that received scholarships. She also thanked staff for scheduling the Rob Richardson event next week and asked that we make sure to invite Mr. Richardsons's wife. She addressed a bathroom incident involving a hard hearing student and reminded everyone that we are mandated reporters. Mrs. Amezcua asked if the incident was reported to the police department, social services and if anyone spoke with the parents. She also thanked everyone for the presentation and looks forward to future conversations about issues.

Mr. Palacio addressed enrollment data and asked how many students we are estimating loosing next year. He requested a discussion regarding the fencing of Middle College High School. He recalled the Board had said no and asked for clarification and added that he will be meeting with each Santa Ana College trustee. Superintendent stated that he would provide answers to Mr. Palacio's questions in a B2B. Dr. Rodriguez deferred to Superintendent's conversation with legal counsel on whether this discussion belongs in open session or in closed session. Mr. Palacio shared that he went to Middle College for Senior Day and attended the football camp at Segerstrom High School by Shermon Cocroft, former NFL player. He announced that Segerstrom softball and baseball teams won last week. Mr. Palacio also announced that this Saturday Saddleback High School will be playing Division 6 CIF volley ball championship at Monrovia High School. Mr. Palacio acknowledged Rebecca Cavesas, Segerstrom High School student, for playing in the All Star softball team and also congratulated Bruno Banuelos and Zander Bretza. He shared that he attended the Middle College High School exit interviews. He requested that the District reimburse students that have been paying out of their pocket for sports and all notices are to be sent to the Superintendent's Office. Lastly, he addressed the donation of hand sanitizers and asked if they can be donated to parents.

Dr. Alvarez thanked the public speakers that spoke at the meeting. He shared that he attended exit interviews for Middle College High School. The kids showed us how resilient they are. Lastly he acknowledged Mother's Day and wished all mothers a Happy Mother's Day.

Ms. Torres thanked public speakers and asked Principals to clarify what happened during the meeting tonight regarding the funding of a GRIP employee. She also thanked students, staff, and parents as we reach the home stretch to the end of the school year and asked that everyone have patience, grace, and enjoy time with students.

He thanked district staff for the presentation and stated he would be sending his questions along and is looking forward to the next conversation. Lastly, he wished all moms a Happy Mother's Day.
