7. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent addressed comments and concerns being shared regarding our newly adopted Ethnic Studies curriculum. He stated that the District recognizes that this complex content requires careful consideration and should be viewed from multiple perspectives. He added that the District has no intention of removing any narrative from the curriculum that will be developed in the future. The intent is to hear from all sides, to learn from all sides, and to approach this in a balanced manner. Superintendent announced that our high school graduations begin next week. 14. BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez congratulated all the graduates. He thanked all those that came to this meeting and to the past couple of sessions to provide public comments around the curriculum. He assured the public that Board members take the comments seriously and will follow up with Superintendent to see how he can assist. He also addressed the topic of nutrition, safety, sexual harassment, crossing quards, air quality, and water policy. He proposed that we activate the Student Wellness Committee, as per Board Policy (BP) 5030. That BP reads, "The Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning will utilize the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child model to support and reinforce a healthy school environment through health education, physical education and physical activity, health services, nutrition environment and services, counseling, psychological and social services, social emotional climate, physical environment, employee wellness, family engagement, and community involvement. The Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning will coordinate a wellness committee comprised of key stake holders including, Board Members, District and school administrators, physical education teachers, school health professionals, parents/quardians, community agencies, students, and partners to participate in the development, implementation, review, and update of the district's student wellness policy. The Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning will report to the Board at least every two years on the implementation and success of this policy and any other Board policies related to nutrition and physical activity." As we talk about Board Priorities of Wellness, which has focused on social emotional, but wellness goes beyond that. He would really like to activate that committee and consider combining it with the School Climate Committee.

Ms. Brazer Aceves acknowledged and thanked everyone who came out to speak tonight and appreciates them for sharing. She addressed the topic of sexual harassment that students shared and requested additional information about the project and what their goals are so that she can support. Ms. Brazer Aceves shared that she got to tour the Central Kitchen a few months ago with CSEA and met a lot of our amazing staff. During that tour she did see some concerns around spacing and time spent on certain things. She thanked all the employees who were recognized earlier tonight and all those for all their efforts to make sure the end of the year events happen ensuring families feel celebrated. Ms. Brazer Aceves added that she is looking forward to the graduation ceremonies. Lastly, she congratulated all the retirees for their tireless years of service and to all the artists of the year.

Mr. Bustos congratulated the class of 2023 and all the eighth graders who are promoting to high school. He shared that he will be celebrating one of his nephews who is graduating from high school and a niece that is promoting from intermediate. Mr. Bustos also shared that he had the opportunity to attend Santa Ana High School's Arts on the Lawn event and gave a shout out to all the art, music, and theatre teachers. Mr. Bustos congratulated all the retirees and thanked them for their service. He announced that next Saturday, May 27, 2023, the Taft Deaf Hard of Hearing program is celebrating their 50th year anniversary and is excited to be in community with parents and students at Taft. Mr. Bustos took time to thank our ASL interpreters who are here for every school Board meeting. He shared that last weekend was the LGBTQ Youth Convening that was held at Segerstrom High School. It was successful and it was amazing seeing our students leading. He announced that next week is June 1st which means it is Pride Month, a time to celebrate the liberation of the queer community and is an opportunity to reflect on our contributions and what we need to continue to do to meet the needs of this community. He requested that language be added to Resolution No. 2022-23-3482 - Proclaiming October 2022 as LGBTQ+ History Month, about raising the pride flag at the District office. He also requested an update on the LGBTQ committee previously requested.

Dr. Alvarez acknowledged Zoey Velez, SAUSD graduate from Segerstrom High School, who is now graduating from the naval academy and receiving her naval commission. There were also another four students from 2017 that were accepted to military academies and will follow up with them. Dr. Alvarez shared that he had the opportunity to travel last week. He attended an educational conference sponsored by the National Association of Latino Elected Officials, focusing on data driven decision making, mental health, and adverse conditions of children. Dr. Alvarez shared that he participated in the senior exit interview at Santa Ana High School and heard their stories on how they went through COVID and how grateful they were for the staff for their support. He congratulated the top one hundred students. Lastly, Dr. Alvarez addressed public safety. He shared that over the last two months he has been getting phone calls and emails regarding public safety. The students at Santa Ana High School invited him to do a walk-through on campus and they talked about public safety, including Activity Monitors and District Safety Officers. Dr. Alvarez stated that as we end the school year and prepare for the new school year, he would like to ensure that we are prepared with not only teachers but with enough safety staff. Lastly, he asked that we consider having another public safety town hall meeting to keep people updated on where we are at with all the items that were brought up during last year's town halls.

Motioned by Mr. Bustos, seconded by Ms. Torres, to extend the meeting to 10:45 p.m., with no opposition.

Ms. Torres addressed the action taken during the last Board meeting to strip the Superintendent's emergency powers for COVID. She shared that they were supposed to remove the virtual/telephone public comments, however because we did not give people enough notice, it was decided to continue to take them for tonight but will no longer be taking them for future meetings. She thanked the Ethnic Studies students from Segerstrom High School who came out to speak. She suggested that staff members follow up with students to get their policy suggestions. She thanked the Superintendent for meeting with the Jewish Federation, Palestinian, Arab, and/or Muslim groups to discuss Ethnic Studies. It is important that we have a robust professional learning plan for our teachers, not just in content knowledge, but in pedagogy. She emphasized that it is so important that we create the conditions for teachers to get trained. She also addressed behavior in relation to what Dr. Alvarez shared about behavior expressing a need and how important it is to shift to that pedagogical lens. She also addressed the safety concerns. Ms. Torres asked Superintendent to have conversations with Board members on how to start the committees that have been brought up to be ready for the upcoming school year.

Having no further business to come before the Board, Ms. Torres adjourned the meeting at 10:47 p.m.

1 RESOLUTION NO. 22/23-3521 2 BOARD OF EDUCATION 3 SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT 4 ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA 5 6 Proclamation Protecting the Freedom to Read 7 8 WHEREAS, the freedom to read is an essential component of a democratic 9 society, and access to diverse ideas and perspectives is critical to the 10 development of an informed community; 11 WHEREAS, censorship and the banning of books restricts the free flow of 12 ideas, stifle creativity and critical thinking, and limit academic freedom; 13 WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education ("Board") 14 recognizes the importance of providing students with access to a wide variety of 15 literature, including materials that may be considered controversial, challenging, 16 or uncomfortable; 17 WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges that the decision to read a particular book 18 should be left to the individual student and their parent or quardian; 19 WHEREAS, the Board supports the principles of the First Amendment of the 20 United States Constitution, which protects the right to free speech and expression; 21 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby prohibits the banning of 22 books within the school district and directs all school staff to uphold and defend the principles of intellectual freedom and the First Amendment. 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board encourages all members of the 25 community to engage in open and constructive dialogue regarding any concerns about 26 particular books or other educational materials, and to work collaboratively with 27 school staff to find appropriate ways to address those concerns. 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board directs all school staff to inform 29 students and their parents or guardians of their right to request an alternative 30 reading assignment if they object to a particular book, and to provide such 31 alternative assignments in a timely and respectful manner.

32	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board directs all school staff to ensure
33	that any decisions regarding the selection and use of educational materials are
34	based on sound educational principles and the needs and interests of the students
35	they serve.
36	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board directs all school staff to report any
37	attempts to ban or censor books to the superintendent and the School Board, and to
38	take appropriate steps to defend the right to read and access to diverse ideas and
39	perspectives.
