SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez shared that last Friday, May 20, 2022, the CDC, FDA, and other health agencies approved the use of a single booster dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines for children ages 5 to 11. SAUSD encourages all eligible populations to receive authorized vaccines and boosters to ensure our community remains protected during this ongoing pandemic. The district continues to work with community partners to hold weekly vaccination clinics across the district and invited everyone to follow the district on social media for information on the latest clinics. The district is also working to provide four testing hub locations this summer for students, staff, and the community members. More information will be provided soon. Mr. Almendarez announced that our high school graduations begin next week. He congratulated the class of 2022 for finishing despite challenges and wished them the best whether they are going to college, serving in the military, or joining the workforce. He also shared that all ceremonies will all be streamed online. The links, times and dates are posted on the district website. Superintendent shared that last week a celebration for the district's top seniors was held at Guaranty Chevrolet. He congratulated the seniors and thanked Bruce Hamlin, owner of Guarantee Chevrolet, for allowing the district to use his dealership. He highlighted the Special Education Resources Fair at Saddleback High School with community partners and county resources. He thanked Alma Ulloa and all the special education staff and parents that participated. Lastly, Superintendent addressed the incident that occurred at Taft Elementary on Monday involving a trespasser on campus who struck three of our students walking to school as he drove away from the school. He reported that the students are currently in recovery and expressed that our thoughts remain with these students and their families. He thanked the staff at Taft for their quick response following the incident to ensure that all students on campus remained safe during the day. He also thanked the Santa Ana School Police Officers and other law enforcement for their prompt response to support our school. The district worked to provide the most relevant information to staff and families as soon as it was received from law enforcement as this situation unfolded throughout the day. A district crisis response team will remain at the campus this week to support any students or staff with any social and emotional needs.

PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Public speakers addressed the Taft incident that occurred Monday, May 23, 2022; phase 2 of music education; parent's gratitude for daughter's graduation; LGBTQ education and queer representation on campus; Special Education Resource Fair; parent involvement at school, and parent access to children's classrooms.

Ms. Torres addressed the Taft public speakers. She asked Superintendent and Cabinet to have a plan for safety and apologized to staff, students, and parents.

Mr. Palacio addressed public speakers regarding the Taft incident. He added that staff needs training often and apologized that the news of the Taft incident first came from the media. He apologized to all and emphasized the need to prioritize the needs of our special education students. He expressed the need for better security and he invited everyone to continue to speak at Board meetings.

Mrs. Amezcua addressed public speakers for attending the Board meeting. She invited everyone to come back to Board meetings to ask where the money is going. She addressed the incident at Taft and thanked the community for notifying Board members. Mrs. Amezcua provided data on current officers and the need for District Safety Officers. She invited the Taft community to come out and demand safety. She apologized to staff and students, addressed accountability and the need for safety training. Mrs. Amezcua thanked the Santa Ana Unified School Police Department, Santa Ana Police Department, and the Orange County Sheriffs Department for helping out. She requested a plan of action with timelines on what is going to be done with Taft.

Dr. Alvarez thanked all speakers for their opinion. He requested an update on the safety plan, look at ratios, single point of entries, single point of exits, and cameras. Ensure that school site leadership is able and capable to lead staff.

Ms. Torres thanked everyone and Mrs. Amezcua.
