SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez shared that we recently held our graduation ceremonies for all our high schools. It was so inspiring and heartwarming to hear our students share their emotional journeys. He congratulated the Class of 2023 and wished them all the best in the years ahead. He also congratulated all those who promoted from middle and elementary schools. Mr. Almendarez thanked all SAUSD staff who helped pull all these ceremonies together. He thanked high school principals, their teams, Educational Services team for hosting each of these ceremonies, to those helping with setting up and breaking down stages, clean up, safety, media support, food service, and many more behind the scenes duties. Next, he shared that yesterday SAUSD was honored to host at Valley High School a delegation from the Korean Educational Development Institute. Students and staff had an opportunity to showcase various programs aimed at preparing all graduates to compete globally. The delegation learned about programs that include ethnic studies, visual and performing arts, International Baccalaureate, dual enrollment, athletics, and many more. NEW AND REVISION OF EXISTING BOARD POLICIES - FIRST READING/NO ACTION REQUIRED

12.1 Board Policy 6158 - Independent Study Program (Revised: First Reading)

BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez congratulated the class of 2023. He requested an update on the REACH night program and where we are going with that. Dr. Rodriguez thanked Dr. Llamas for her service and shared we now have an ally and champion at the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE). He added that there has not been a time when he has reached out about a student or a parent that she did not call him back on. He has witnessed how big her heart is for students and families and thanked her for that. Dr. Rodriguez requested an update on the CTE CARE class to ensure we are offering a career path into behavioral health and social work area.

Ms. Brazer Aceves wished everyone Happy Pride Month. She thanked Dr. Llamas for her work over the years and congratulated her on her new position. Ms. Brazer Aceves congratulated the class of 2023 and invited alumni to come back to share their stories. She highlighted that many students shared their experiences, sacrifices, love, and support. She gave a shout out to the staff who invited Board members to different events. She shared that she joined Santa Ana High School for their band banquet. It was a beautiful event in which the director highlighted students with an award. Ms. Brazer Aceves also thanked the counseling team at Carr Intermediate School for inviting her to their advisory committee meeting. It was a great space to hear firsthand of their work. She also had the opportunity to attend the very first ASL Speech and Debate competition at Taft Elementary School and is wearing the shirt that they gave her that day. Ms. Brazer Aceves added that she was able to attend the Santa Ana Youth Leadership Summit which was hosted by Youth and Government along with Dr. Alvarez. She shared that she was able to attend the Valley, Segerstrom, Saddleback, and Godinez High School graduations and thanked staff, the Superintendent and his team, administrators, educators, nutrition services, building and maintenance services, District safety officers, media, communications, and tech staff. Lastly, she added that she attended the Nicholas Academic Center graduation, and she shared that Executive Director Rosa Diaz is moving on and thanked her for her very intentional work.

Mr. Bustos wished Happy Pride Month to the LGBTQ community. He provided historical background on how Pride got started. He added that June 28, 1969, was the first night transgenders and non-conforming transgenders did not tolerate to be told what they could wear. He added that celebrations such as these and raising the pride flag are a reminder of their existence and the adversity the community has faced over the past decades. This year is significant because there is an inflex on anti LGBTQ legislation across the country. Mr. Bustos invited everyone to the Orange County LGBTQ Pride Festival and Parade that is happening Saturday, June 24th in Downtown Santa Ana. He thanked

Mayor Pro Tem Jessie Lopez for inviting him to the City's Pride Flag Raising Ceremony June 1, 2023, at 4:00 p.m. in front of City Hall. He acknowledged all those wearing pride lanyards, safe zone posters around classrooms, and Ms. Brazer Aceves' rainbow concha earrings. Small things make a difference in a young person's interactions with adults. He suggested we order more safe zone posters if possible. Mr. Bustos proposed to have alumni recognitions during Board meetings to highlight the work and outcomes of SAUSD graduates. He addressed a public speaker, Mr. Granado's comment, on the significance of handball courts and how we can work together to create more courts. He mentioned that they have funding and are willing to find it. He also addressed Mr. Nati Alvarado's comment on his organization's contract. Mr. Bustos requested an update on where we are with organizations on intervention and prevention. He thanked Dr. Llamas for her service and for affirming his experiences even before becoming a Board member. He added that we need more educators like her. Lastly, he wished all a Happy Father's Day.

Dr. Alvarez acknowledged and thanked Dr. Llamas and for her social work and mental health work. He congratulated her on her new position. Dr. Alvarez announced that SUASD's Speech & Debate students are in Phoenix, Arizona competing in a national competition. Six of our students passed to the next round and will be competing tomorrow. He wished them all good luck. Dr. Alvarez shared that he attended the Taft 50th anniversary celebration and thanked all the alumni that were there. He also thanked the staff, parents, and students. He requested information on what schools offer restorative justice and asked that we re-evaluate the need of the programs to know if we need to maintain the current levels of programming or if there is a need to increase and to take a look at the no-cost community partnerships.

Ms. Torres reiterated the requests she heard as follows: REACH update, CTE CARE Class update, alumni highlighting, and a restorative program update and its connection to instruction. Ms. Torres announced the City's Juneteenth celebration on June 17, 2023, at Centennial Park from 11:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. and added that SAUSD was not on the sponsors list. She asked to see where the communication breakdown is, as the District should be part of cultural significant events. She added that there is a Chicano Festival in August and would like to know what is happening with that. Ms. Torres shared that she attended the City's Pride Flag Raising Ceremony and was happy Mayor Pro Tem Jessie Lopez invited the Board. She addressed the importance of the visibility of the Pride flag and encouraged everyone to make it visible. She echoed the comments on handball courts and asked that staff look at possibly adding them to Facilitron. The City took down the ones at Santa Anita Park and Chepa's Park in the last two years. People will be looking at the District to have handball as it has been a big part of Santa Ana's culture. We need to think of accessibility. Ms. Torres thanked Dr. Llamas for her service. It is bittersweet and happy to see her get her new position, but sad that she is leaving the District. She also thanked her fellow Board members for their attendance at different events.

SCOPE:

The Governing Board recognizes the impact that civility has on the effective operation of the district, including its role in creating a safe and positive school climate and enabling a focus on student well-being, learning, and achievement. The Board believes that each person should be treated with dignity and respect in their interactions within the school community.

The Board understands that the First Amendment provides strong protection for speech. However, the Board expects that all speech and expression will comport with norms of civil behavior on district grounds, in district facilities, during district activities or events, and in the use of district electronic/digital systems and platforms.

POLICY:

Civil behavior is polite, courteous, and reasonable behavior which is respectful to others and includes integrity, honesty, acceptance, timeliness, dependability, observance of laws and rules, and effective communication.

The Board and district staff shall model civil behavior as an example of behavior that is expected throughout the district. Practices that promote civil behavior include actively listening, giving full attention to the speaker, and refraining from interruptions; welcoming and encouraging participation, input, and feedback through stakeholder engagement; promptly responding to concerns; and embracing varying and diverse viewpoints. Such practices may be incorporated into governance standards adopted by the Board or Superintendent and/or professional standards or codes of conduct for employees as specified in district policies and regulations.

Students, staff, parents/guardians, and community members should be educated in the recognition, development, and demonstration of civil behavior. The Superintendent or designee may incorporate related concepts in the curriculum, provide staff development activities, and/or communicate this policy to the school community.

Students, staff, parents/guardians, and community members shall not communicate or behave in a manner that causes disruption; hinders the orderly conduct of district operations, the educational program, or any other district program or activity; or creates an unsafe learning or working environment. The Superintendent or designee may respond to disruptive, violent, or threatening behavior in accordance with law and as specified in BP/AR 3515.2 - Disruptions.

DESIRED OUTCOME:

Behavior by students or staff that is discriminatory, harassing, or intimidating, including sexual harassment, bullying, and/or hate violence, or behavior that is in any other way unlawful, is prohibited and is subject to discipline in accordance with law and as specified in district policy and regulations.
