SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent shared that graduation ceremonies recently took place for all of the high schools and programs. For seniors and their families, these ceremonies were a celebration of years of hard work and dedication. He added

that it was so inspiring and heartwarming to hear students share their emotional journeys, and loved hearing about their passion to have a positive impact on the world. He congratulated the Class of 2022 and wished them all the best in the years ahead. A two-minute video that captured some of the special moments from the commencement celebrations was shared. Superintendent thanked building services, custodial teams, school police and district safety officers, nutrition services department, Principals and their leadership staff, teachers, and teams, the media and support teams, and every other SAUSD staff member who contributed to ensuring we provided an amazing send-off to the graduates. Families streamed the ceremonies from places including Vietnam, Mexico, Colombia, Egypt and Taiwan.

Mr. Almendarez thanked the Nicholas Academic Centers for the graduation celebration this past Friday. More than 180 graduating SAUSD seniors were honored during a gala ceremony. The Nicholas Academic Centers help provide a direct path to colleges and universities for hundreds of students annually, with support with college prep coursework, scholarships, applications, financial aid and other resources. To date, \$11.4 million dollars has gone directly to students in the forms of scholarship stipends for college tuition, room and board, and educational resources like laptops and books. SAUSD is honored to have Nicholas Academic Centers serve as a valued partner, providing invaluable resources for our students.

He also thanked co-founder Dr. Henry T. Nicholas III, Executive Director Rosa Diaz, and all the staff at the Nicholas Academic Centers for their ongoing support of SAUSD.

Superintendent stated that as we close out the school year next week, he would like to thank all SAUSD staff for the work they did to ensure our schools remained open, safe and healthy places for learning through the entire school year. He added that he looks forward to what the upcoming year will bring and hopes everyone can take some well-deserved vacation in the meantime.

Mr. Almendarez addressed school safety, as it has been an issue of concern for all schools locally, and across the country following the incident in Texas a few weeks ago, and the incident at one of our campuses involving a trespasser. He assured the SAUSD community, that the safety of students and staff remains the top priority, and will continue to work to identify how to improve our safety and security across every school. He announced that two town hall meetings will be held on June 27 and July 18 at the newly dedicated Rob Richardson Welcoming Resource Center. A goal for these meetings is to provide our community with updates on how we are working to improve security measures at all schools, and what we are doing to support student wellness. Additionally, we want to make ourselves available to answer questions and address any concerns from our community. Ensuring we maintain safe and nurturing schools involves collaboration with our entire community. He invited everyone to attend. More information on these meetings is available on the district website www.sausd.us and through social media channels.

Lastly, he reminded the community that weekly COVID-19 testing for students, staff at school sites has ended, however, the District's, and Board of Education's priority remains to make testing available free to any student, staff, and community member who wants this service. Through the summer, free daily testing will be provided between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. at four sites: Santa Ana High School, Mendez Fundamental Intermediate, Santa Ana Valley High School, and here at our District office. He invited everyone to visit the district website or follow on social media for more information on COVID testing, as well as other resources.
