Santa Ana Board of Education

Tuesday, June 25, 2024

1. CALL TO ORDER

Board President called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m.

Other members present were Dr. Alvarez, Mr. Bustos, and Ms. Brazer Aceves.

Ms. Torres announced the closed session agenda items as follows: Conference with Labor Negotiator, Personnel Matters, Existing Litigation, Anticipated Litigation, and Conference with Real Property Negotiator. She asked if there was anyone wishing to address the Board related to closed session items. There was no one wishing to address the Board related to closed session items.

2. RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION

The Regular Board meeting recessed to closed session at 5:04 p.m.

Dr. Rodriguez joined the meeting at 5:22 p.m.

The Regular Board meeting reconvened at 7:00 p.m.

5. LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I want to recognize that our District and school campuses are located in the Village of Pasbenga. I want to acknowledge that this land we refer to as Orange County, is the unceded and traditional lands of the Gabrieleno Tongva Nation, and the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation. These lands were taken through a process of colonization, physical, and cultural genocide. I want to pay my respect to elders, both past and present, as well as the Tongva and Acjachemen youth who have attended and are currently attending our schools in neighboring districts.

14. BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez thanked the Godinez students who came to speak and for taking their education seriously and taking action, as well. He invited his fellow Board members to consider their proposal for potential future consideration. With the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) now approved, he emphasized the importance of aligning the (LCAP) with our Board Priorities, noting that he has not seen any table or plan showing this overlap. To address this, he requested submitting information via a B2B report detailing how we are tracking the overlap between LCAP and Board Priorities.

Ms. Brazer Aceves thanked the Godinez Fundamental High School students for coming and providing insightful information, expressing her appreciation and hope to follow up on the conversation as Dr. Rodriguez stated. She highlighted Board Agenda Item 9.3 from the Consent Calendar, which contained an agreement that was approved with the UCI School of Law, flagging to the community that this will provide 100 internships for our students. This is one of many District initiatives to deepen partnerships for career access for our students. She also mentioned the City of Santa Ana Youth program, which opened 120 spots that quickly filled up but still allows for online interest. She thanked SAUSD and Santa Ana Councilmember Jessie Lopez for sharing this opportunity, noting the strong interest and engagement which indicates a need and effort to make these experiences more robust, especially through CTE. Ms. Brazer Aceves thanked those involved in the national Speech and Debate event in Des Moines, Iowa, acknowledging the transformative experiences it provided. She also praised the Independent Studies Program and the Santa Ana Virtual Academy for its staff and support services, highlighting the powerful collaboration to meet the diverse needs of students. She expressed gratitude to City of Santa Ana's City Council, Jessie Lopez, Benjamin Vazquez, Johnathan Hernandez, Thai Viet Phan, and the housing division, and SAUSD, for their efforts in ensuring families remain housed and supported, especially in cases of just cause evictions. She looked forward to the Loteria event on Wednesday, June 26th at 5:30 p.m. with the FACE team and mentioned resources available on Instagram, including a new resource line (714-972-7660) to connect with the FACE team. As a District, she suggested highlighting recent updates on executive orders from President Biden regarding immigration, which offer new protections and opportunities for families to adjust status without leaving the country. She emphasized the importance of providing accurate information to families and indicated she would be looking into this directly. Finally, Ms. Brazer Aceves recognized the loss of a recent former student graduate in the community, expressing her condolences and noting how touching it was to see the community come together. She asked to take a moment to honor the life of our former student, and uplifting our students navigating grief.

Mr. Bustos thanked everyone for being present and highlighted the amazing work the FACE team is doing during the summer to bring the community together. He mentioned the Loteria cards being prepared for the upcoming event on Wednesday, June 26th and invited everyone to join if possible. He also spoke about the "Taller de Padres – Licuados" community parent workshop focused on healthy lifestyles at Madison Elementary School, (Wednesday, June 26th) Davis Elementary School (Thursday, June 27th), and Carver Elementary School (Friday, June 28th), and encouraged everyone to follow the FACE social media for more information. Mr. Bustos thanked the students who gave public comments today, noting he had a chance to converse with them beforehand and is in full support of their school name change proposal. He mentioned the existing Board Policy and requested adding it to the B2B report for review in the upcoming week, hoping they will be able to move forward on this. He acknowledged that many individuals, past and present, might be deserving of having a school named after them, referencing the Guzman family from Santa Ana in the Mendez v. Westminster case and Dorothy Mulkey, along with other families who have made significant contributions. He expressed support for this initiative,

particularly looking at Fremont Elementary School and potentially other schools for name changes. He gave a shout-out to the Engage 360 Program staff at Monte Vista Elementary School for their amazing garden and butterfly habitat, praising the learning experience it provides about different produce and its community benefits. He concluded by expressing his anticipation for the next School Board meeting in late July.

Dr. Alvarez gave a shout-out to the Speech and Debate program, noting his strong support and pride in all who competed. He mentioned attending the National Association of Latino Elected and Appointed Officials (NALEO) conference last week, where many elected officials inquired about the success of the program. He thanked the Godinez Fundamental High School students who came to speak and acknowledged the interest in changing the school's name. Dr. Alvarez shared that he attended Fremont Elementary School and grew up in the neighborhood where he remains deeply connected. He highlighted the upcoming "Movies at the Park" event on Friday, June 28th at Salvador Park as an opportunity to connect with the community. Dr. Alvarez also referenced the Board Policy on name changes and reviewed the petition provided by the Godinez students, expressing his support for their proposal.


Ms. Torres emphasized the importance of submitting a B2B report for tracking Board Priorities and the LCAP, as Dr. Rodriguez stated. She agreed with Ms. Brazer Aceves on the need to communicate important policies and rights through FACE, wellness centers, and community schools, ensuring the information is vetted through legal channels first. She suggested creating a routine for distributing this information so the community knows they can access it at our schools and requested Superintendent Almendarez be tasked with this. There was no opposition from the Board to this request. She thanked the students who came to the Board meeting and made public comments, expressing her support for a school name change. She shared that her family has a history at Fremont Elementary School, grandmother attended the school in the 1930's, referencing its segregation history, and is supportive of a new name change (i.e., Dorothy Mulkey). She requested the Superintendent submit the SAUSD renaming process in the B2B report and also loop in some student leaders in the process to approve and determine an actual name change.

Having no further business to come before the Board, Ms. Torres adjourned the meeting at 8:22 p.m.

THE POSITION

Santa Ana Unified School District (SAUSD) is seeking a dynamic and visionary leader to serve as Elementary School Principal. SAUSD is committed to fostering a diverse and inclusive educational environment that celebrates cultural differences and values every student's unique background, culture, and language. The ideal candidate will embody our district's mission and vision, demonstrating a passion for excellence in education and a deep belief in the potential of all students to succeed. The Principal serves as the site administrator and instructional leader under the direction of the Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning, or designee.

The position of Principal requires subject matter expertise in educational programs, curriculum, and instructional strategies. Directly related administrative experience is necessary to assure success in an elementary school leadership role. The position requires the ability to analyze and offer solutions regarding curriculum, guidance, and business-related functions. Decisions made by the Principal have a critical impact on the goals, organization, and administration of education programs and services of the organization. The Principal has supervisory responsibility for planning, assigning, reviewing, and evaluating the quality and quantity of work of certificated and classified employees and meets with teachers, ancillary personnel, parents, community members, and other education personnel to influence, motivate, and monitor result objectives of the school operations.

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Establish Education Protection Account
for Santa Ana Unified School District

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WHEREAS, the voters approved Proposition 30 on November 6, 2012;

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WHEREAS, Proposition 30 added Article XIII, Section 36 to the California Constitution effective November 7, 2012;

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WHEREAS, the voters approved Proposition 55 on November 8, 2016, which extended the Proposition 30 temporary income tax increase on high income earners by twelve years through 2030;

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WHEREAS, the provisions of Article XIII, Section 36(e) create in the state General Fund an Education Protection Account to receive and disburse the revenues derived from the incremental increases in taxes imposed by Article XIII, Section 36(f);

WHEREAS, before June 30th of each year, the Director of Finance shall estimate the total amount of additional revenues, less refunds that will be derived from the incremental increases in tax rates made pursuant to Article XIII, Section 36(f) that will be available for transfer into the Education Protection Account during the next fiscal year;

WHEREAS, if the sum determined by the State Controller is positive, the State Controller shall transfer the amount calculated into the Education Protection Account within ten days preceding the end of the fiscal year;

WHEREAS, all monies in the Education Protection Account are hereby continuously appropriated for the support of school districts, county offices of education, charter schools and community college districts;

38 WHEREAS, monies deposited in the Education Protection Account shall not be
39 used to pay any costs incurred by the Legislature, the Governor or any agency of
40 state government;

41
42 WHEREAS, a community college district, county office of education, school
43 district, or charter school shall have the sole authority to determine how the
44 monies received from the Education Protection Account are spent in the school or
45 schools within its jurisdiction;

47 WHEREAS, the governing board of the district shall make the spending
48 determinations with respect to monies received from the Education Protection
49 Account in open session of a public meeting of the governing board;

51 WHEREAS, the monies received from the Education Protection Account shall not
52 be used for salaries or benefits for administrators or any other administrative

55 WHEREAS, each community college district, county office of education, school
56 district and charter school shall annually publish on its Internet website an
57 accounting of how much money was received from the Education Protection Account
58 and how that money was spent;

60 WHEREAS, the annual independent financial and compliance audit required of

62 charter schools shall ascertain and verify whether the funds provided from the



20 General Fund an Education Protection Account to receive and disburse the revenues
21 derived from the incremental increases in taxes imposed by Article XIII, Section
22 36(f);

23
24 WHEREAS, before June 30th of each year, the Director of Finance shall
25 estimate the total amount of additional revenues, less refunds that will be
26 derived from the incremental increases in tax rates made pursuant to Article
27 XIII, Section 36(f) that will be available for transfer into the Education
28 Protection Account during the next fiscal year;

29
30 WHEREAS, if the sum determined by the State Controller is positive, the
31 State Controller shall transfer the amount calculated into the Education
32 Protection Account within ten days preceding the end of the fiscal year;

33
34 WHEREAS, all monies in the Education Protection Account are hereby
35 continuously appropriated for the support of school districts, county offices of
36 education, charter schools and community college districts;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:


1. The monies received from the Education Protection Account shall be spent as required by Article XIII, Section 36 and the spending determinations on how the money will be spent shall be made in open session of a public meeting of the governing board of Santa Ana Unified School District;

2. In compliance with Article XIII, Section 36(e), with the California Constitution, the governing board of the Santa Ana Unified School District has determined to spend the monies received from the Education Protection Act as attached.





48 determinations with respect to monies received from the Education Protection
49 Account in open session of a public meeting of the governing board;

51 WHEREAS, the monies received from the Education Protection Account shall not
52 be used for salaries or benefits for administrators or any other administrative
53 cost;

55 WHEREAS, each community college district, county office of education, school
56 district and charter school shall annually publish on its Internet website an
57 accounting of how much money was received from the Education Protection Account
58 and how that money was spent;

59
60 WHEREAS, the annual independent financial and compliance audit required of
61 community college districts, county offices of education, school districts and
62 charter schools shall ascertain and verify whether the funds provided from the
63 Education Protection Account have been properly disbursed and expended as
64 required by Article XIII, Section 36 of the California Constitution;

65
66 WHEREAS, expenses incurred by community college districts, county offices of
67 education, school districts and charter schools to comply with the additional
68 audit requirements of Article XIII, Section 36 may be paid with funding from the
69 Education Protection Act and shall not be considered administrative costs for
70 purposes of Article XIII, Section 36.



11 WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District (the "District")
12 previously established Community Facilities District No. 2004-1 of the Santa
13 Ana Unified School District (Central Park Project) ("CFD No. 2004-1") all
14 pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Mello-Roos Community Facilities
15 Act of 1982, as amended, commencing with Government Code Section 53111 (the
16 "Act"); and

17 WHEREAS, CFD No. 2004-1 issued its 2015 Special Tax Refunding Bonds in
18 the original principal amount of \$7,735,000 pursuant to Resolution No.
19 14/15-3067, adopted by the Board of Education of the District acting as
20 legislative body of CFD No. 20014-1 on June 23, 2015 (the "Bonds") to refund
21 the 2005 Special Tax Bonds in the original principal amount of \$11,785,000
22 issued pursuant to Resolution No. 05/06-2615, adopted by the Board of
23 Education of the District acting as the legislative body of CFD No. 2004-1
24 on July 26, 2006 (the "Prior Bonds"); and

25 WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the District acting as the
26 legislative body of CFD No. 2004-1 is authorized pursuant to Resolution Nos.
27 04/05-2576 and 04/05-2575 approved on August 24, 2004 (collectively, the
28 "Resolutions of Intention"), Resolution No. 04/05-2580 approved on September
29 28, 2004 (the "Resolution of Formation") and the Ordinance Authorizing the
30 Levy of Special Taxes, approved on October 8, 2004 (the "Ordinance") to levy
31 a special tax on property in CFD No. 2004-1 to pay principal, interest and
32 administrative expenses with respect to all bonds of CFD No. 2004-1, which
33 include the Bonds, to pay for the construction, acquisition and
34 rehabilitation of certain public facilities authorized to be financed by the
35 levy of special taxes of CFD No. 2004-1 pursuant to the Resolutions of

36 Formation and to pay all expenses incidental thereto; and

37 WHEREAS, it is now necessary and appropriate that this Board levy and
38 collect the special taxes for Fiscal Year 2024-25 for the purpose specified
39 in the Ordinance, by the adoption of a resolution as specified by the Act
40 and the Ordinance; and

41 WHEREAS, the special taxes being levied hereunder are at the same rate
42 or at a lower rate than provided by the Ordinance; and

43 NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL
44 DISTRICT, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF COMMUNITY
45 FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2004-1, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS
46 FOLLOWS:

47 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct.

48 Section 2. The special tax ("Special Tax") is imposed without regard to
49 property valuation and is levied in compliance with the Act and the
50 Ordinance.

51 Section 3. In accordance with the Act and the Ordinance, there is
52 hereby levied upon the parcels within the District which are not otherwise
53 exempt from taxation under the Act or the Ordinance the special taxes for
54 Fiscal Year 2024-25 at the tax rates set forth in the report prepared by
55 Woolpert for CFD No. 2004-1 entitled "Administration Report Fiscal Year
56 2024-25" (the "Report") submitted herewith, which rates do not exceed the
57 maximum rates set forth in the Ordinance. After adoption of this Resolution,
58 the Assistant Superintendent, Facilities and Governmental Relations, of the
59 District, or his designee, may make any necessary modifications to these
60 special taxes to correct any errors, omissions or inconsistencies in the
61 listing or categorization of parcels to be taxed or in the amount to be
62 charged to any category of parcels; provided, however, that any such
63 modifications shall not result in an increase in the tax applicable to any
64 category of parcels and can only be made prior to the submission of the tax
65 rolls to the Orange County Auditor.

66 Section 4. All of the collections of the special tax shall be used
67 only as provided for in the Act and Resolutions of Formation. The special
68 tax shall be levied only so long as needed to accomplish the purposes
69 described in Resolutions of Formation.

70 Section 5. The special tax shall be collected in the same manner as

71 ordinary *ad valorem* taxes are collected and shall be subject to the same
72 penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as
73 provided for *ad valorem* taxes as such procedure may be modified by law or
74 this Board from time to time.

75 Section 6. As a cumulative remedy, if any amount levied as a special
76 tax for payment of bond interest or principal, together with any penalties
77 and other charges accruing under this Resolution, are not paid when due, the
78 Board of Education may, not later than four years after the due date of the
79 last installment of principal on the Bonds, order that the same be collected
80 by an action brought in the superior court to foreclose the lien of such
81 special tax.

82 Section 7. The actions of District staff heretofore taken in order to
83 obtain consent from the Orange County Auditor to a later filing date are
84 hereby ratified and the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to transmit
85 a certified copy of this Resolution and the Report to the Orange County
86 Auditor, together with other supporting documentation as may be required to
87 place said special taxes on the secured property tax roll for Fiscal Year
88 2024-25 on or before August 10, 2024, or such later date as may be consented
89 to by the Orange County Assessor, and to perform all other acts which are
90 required by the Act, the Ordinance, or by law in order to accomplish the
91 purpose of this Resolution.


